#### **LOONS END SKY CARP STREAK AT SEVEN**

The Sky Carp fell 7-4 to the Great Lake Loons on Tuesday night to open the six-game series between the two teams. The Carp rallied from a 3-0 deficit to tie the game, but the Loons pulled away to record the win. Eric Rataczak crunched his sixth home run, while Yiddi Cappe had a pair of hits and three stolen bases. Wilfredo Lara stayed hot with a three-hit game, including a triple and an RBI. All four Sky Carp pitchers surrendered at least one, but the four combined to strike out 10 Loons.

#### **CRUISIN' CARP**

The Sky Carp are first in all of Minor League Baseball with 240 steals in 90 games (2.7 per game) after stealing five bases Tuesday. They've been caught just 57 times, good for an 81 percent clip. Fellow Marlins affiliate Jacksonville (seventh place) is also in the top 10, while Jupiter is 15th. South Bend is second in the Midwest League with 170.

#### **LEAGUE LEADERS**

The Sky Carp have several players among the Midwest League leaders. Colby Shade is fourth in the Midwest League in steals with 39, while Emaarion Boyd is seventh with 32. Shade and Wilfredo Lara are tied for eighth in triples with four. Jake Brooks and Holt Jones are tied for the Midwest League in wins with six. Brooks is eighth in WHIP with a 1.22.

#### **WE'RE GOING STREAKING!**

The Sky Carp won seven games in a row, largely on the strength of their incredible pitching before last night's loss. They threw 61 innings and allowed just 13 innings, good for a 1.92 ERA. They struck out 66 batters while walking just 23. Sky Carp hitters scored 30 runs [4.3 per game] hit .247 during that time and stole 18 bases.

#### WHO'S HOT

There are several Sky Carp players that have performed well in July . Connor Caskenette has a .364 average with a .907 OPS. Wilfredo Lara is batting an even .300 with an .810 OPS. Micah McDowell has gone 6-for-13. Colby Shade is hitting .275 with 13 steals in 15 attempts.

On the pitching side, the team has carried a 2.82 ERA to go along with their 10-4 record. Will Schomberg has a 2-0 record with a 1.20 ERA in three starts. Brandon White is also 2-0 with a 2.25 ERA in 16 innings. Xavier Meachem has thrown 4.2 scoreless frames, while Brayan Mendoza has allowed just two runs in nine innings with 11 strikeouts.
