YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels tied the Rumble Ponies, 4-4. Binghamton took a 1-0 lead in the first inning on a single by Nick Lorusso. In the third. Diego Velasquez stole second and on the throw Justin Wishkoski stole home to even the score. William Lugo gave Binghamton a 3-1 lead in the sixth with a solo homer. In the bottom of the seventh, Jairo Pomares scored on an error and Adrian Sugastey brought in a run with a sac fly to tie the score, 3-3. The Rumble Ponies took a 4-3 lead in the top of the eighth on a double by Matt O'Neill. Cal Mitchell scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the ninth to tie the game. After a scoreless 10th inning, the game was halted for a thunderstorm. It was eventually called official as a tie.

A TIE FOR FATHER'S DAY: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels are Rumble Ponies had their game called official in a 4-4 tie after 10 innings. All stats from the game will count. It was the second official tie in Flying Squirrels history. Sunday's game was the final scheduled meeting between the two clubs this season. Binghamton had already clinched the Northeast Division title for the first half and Richmond was already eliminated from contention in the Southwest. On August 12, 2018, the Flying Squirrels and New Hampshire Fisher Cats were tied 1-1 when heavy rain hit The Diamond after nine innings in their final scheduled meeting of the year. The game was initially suspended and set to be continued only if it was necessary for postseason implications. That year, the Flying Squirrels finished 62-76 and last in the Western Division. New Hampshire finished 10.5 games ahead of Hartford to win the Wild Card before winning the league title.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The series marks the first meetings between these two teams this year. The Curve come to Richmond for a six-game series from August 12-17. The Flying Squirrels return to Altoona from September 2-7. The Flying Squirrels are 1-10 in series openers and 2-7 in games on Wednesdays. Tuesday's game was rained out and will be made up on Thursday.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,747 fans per home game, which ranks fourth among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 6-18-1 in their last 25 games. They had lost three straight games prior to Sunday's tie. Richmond went 1-4-1 in last week's series against Binghamton. Of Richmond's 43 losses this season, 23 of them have been by two runs or less (15 by one, eight by two). The Richmond offense is 11th in the Eastern League in runs scored (205). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.86 ERA.

THE CURVE have won three-of-four since Thursday. They split last week's six-game series against the SeaWolves. Altoona's roster features five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including 2B Termarr Johnson (No. 5), OF/INF Mitch Jebb (No. 12), SS Jack Brannigan (No. 14 - on IL), RHP Wilber Dotel (No. 16) and RHP Alessandro Ercolani (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects lists features three Altoona players, including Johnson (No. 4), Brannigan (No. 11 - on IL) and Jebb (No. 13).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Manuel Mercedes makes his 12th Double-A start and his first against the Curve. He faced the Rumble Ponies in his last start on Wednesday and allowed two runs over six innings with four strikeouts, picking up his team-leading third win of the season. Mercedes spent all of last season with High-A Eugene, going 4-9 with a 5.28 ERA. He was tied for second in the Northwest League in games started (25) and ranked fifth in innings pitched (116.0). Mercedes spent the prior two seasons with Low-A San Jose. In 2023, he went 3-6 with a 3.64 ERA in 25 outings (21 starts). He signed with the Giants in their 2019 international class. FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Wilber Dotel makes his 13th start of the season and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Wednesday against the SeaWolves and threw 5.1 innings, allowing four runs with three walks and four strikeouts. Dotel signed with the Pirates as an international free agent in 2020. He is in his first Double-A season. With High-A Greensboro last year, he went 9-5 with a 5.33 ERA in 25 starts

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey**, **Zach Morgan** and **Onil Perez** have combined to catch 34 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 22 runners caught stealing. Morgan, now with Triple-A Sacramento, is tied for fourth in the Eastern League with 12.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on June 3. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 26 times, which is the eighth-most in franchise history, one behind a four-way tie for fourth place (**Devin Harris, Sean Roby, Shane Matheny** and **Will Wilson**).

TAKING THE JAIRO: Jairo Pomares has picked up at least one hit in 10-of-his-last-13 games dating back to May 29, batting .362 (17-for-47) with two homers, two doubles, seven RBIs and four walks, raising his season batting average from .185 to .225. That stretch includes five multi-hit games. He hit a solo homer on June 11 at Erie, his first since May 2, snapping a 25-game homerless streak. He went deep again June 8. Pomares is tied for the team lead with 22 RBIs this season.

YO ADRIAN: Adrian Sugastey has picked up eight RBIs over his last six games dating back to June 8 In the series finale at Erie last Sunday afternoon, he went 3-for-5 with a homer, two doubles and a career-best five RBIs. Last Tuesday, he drove in the Flying Squirrels' only run with a single. In last Wednesday's win, he belted his sixth homer of the year, a solo shot in the fourth, to set a new single-season career high.

NIGHT AT THE ROXBY: Reliever **Braxton Roxby** closed his second save of the season last Wednesday night, recording two outs in the eighth to strand two inherited baserunners before a 1-2-3 ninth. He followed with two scoreless relief innings in the ninth and 10th on Sunday afternoon before play was stopped. Dating back to April 29, Roxby has pitched 12 consecutive games without allowing an earned run, spanning 17 innings with 22 strikeouts and four walks. The only two runs he has surrendered in that stretch were a pair of unearned runs in the 10th inning on May 27 against the Senators.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for fourth in hits (61), ninth in OBP (.387) and 10th in batting average (.284). **Seth Lonsway** is sixth in innings pitched (61.0) and 10th in ERA (3.25). **Jack Choate** is fifth in strikeouts (65). **John Michael Bertrand** is first in innings pitched (66.0).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 221 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Joe Whitman (No. 5), Diego Velasquez (No. 10), Sabin Ceballos (No. 21) and Jack Choate (No. 26). John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. Adrian Sugastey is ranked as the top defensive catcher. Aeverson Arteaga is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1957: The Richmond Virginians beat the Buffalo Bisons, 7-4, at Parker Field. Richmond trailed 4-0 after the top of the sixth inning before scoring twice in the bottom of the sixth, one run in the seventh and four in the eighth. Luke Easter gave Buffalo a 2-0 lead with a homer early. It was only the second ball hit over the center field fence at Parker Field. Easter also hit the first in 1954 against Monte Kennedy. Johnny Jaciuk (YUH-chick) drove in two runs to start the Richmond rally in the sixth. Jerry Lumpe brought in a run in the seventh to close the deficit to one. Bob Kline drove in the go-ahead runs in the eighth. 1959: The Richmond Virginians beat the Rochester Red Wings, 3-2, at Parker Field. Pinch hitting in the ninth, Bill Shantz singled home Mike Baxes to win the game. 1985: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-1, at The Diamond. Joe Johnson struck out eight over eight innings. Juan Eichelberger threw the ninth. Milt Thompson made a game-saving catch in the eighth inning, making a sliding grab on a sinking line drive hit by Mike Hart to center with two runs on and two outs. Richmond took a 2-0 lead in the third against Mark Portugal. Lee Graham hit an RBI single and Thompson drove in a run with a sacrifice fly. John Lickert drove in the third run in the fourth inning with a two-out single. 2017: The Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators, 5-3, at FNB Field. Miguel Gomez opened the scoring with a solo homer in the top of the first inning, one of his three hits in the game. Tyler Horan hit a three-run double in the third to open a 5-1 lead. Starter Jose Flores allowed two runs in 5-1 innings and also hit an RBI single for the Flying Squirrels.
