**LAST TIME OUT:** Kyler Fedko smashed two homers in a four-hit, 12 total bases effort to lead the way as the St. Paul Saints ran away with a 14-4 win over Omaha on Wednesday night at CHS Field. Fedko opened the scoring in the second by drilling a first pitch hanger out to left, a one out solo fly. In the third, a two-out walk turned into a run when Hendry Mendez and Gabby Gonzalez followed with back-to-back singles, notching a second run on the board. In the fourth, Fedko cracked another breaking ball out, a leadoff fly to push the Saints out to a 3-0 lead. The Storm Chasers got on the board in the fifth, but St. Paul erased the marker in the bottom half on a leadoff homer from David Bañuelos, his second, making it 4-1. The floodgates opened in the sixth when 13 men came to bat and eight scored. Aaron Sabato led off the inning with a double and hit a 3-run homer that made it 14-1 later in the frame. After a K in the fifth, Fedko notched doubles in his final two at-bats for his second four XBH game this year.

**FEDKO, DON'T YA KNOW:** Saints outfielder Kyler Fedko produced his second four extra-base hit game this year on Wednesday, going 4-for-5 with two homers, two doubles and four RBI. It marks Fedko's first game with four or more extra bases since his 3-homer, triple game on April 12 @Toledo, a performance in which Fedko tied the Saints' franchise record by notching 15 total bases in a single contest. Fedko is now one of two players in either MLB or MiLB with multiple games of 4+ XBH this season (there have been a total of 16 such performances, including none so far in MLB). Fedko currently ranks 3rd in the International League in slugging% (.608) and 9th in OPS (.980) on the season. Starting with his three-homer game in Toledo, the Pittsburgh-area native is slashing, .343/.432/.735, ranking third in the IL in OPS (1.177) in 27 games over that stretch (min 30 PA).

**HOMEGROWN SAINTS:** Thursday will mark just the second time in Saints franchise history that two Minnesota-born starters throw for St. Paul on consecutive days, and the first since Aaron Rozek (Burnsville) and Louis Varland (St. Paul) threw on back-to-back games on August 20 & August 21, 2024 against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**DOMO ARIGATO, MR. SABATO:** First baseman Aaron Sabato has now homered three times in the last four games and eight times in his previous 13 games (he is tied for the MiLB lead in homers since May 5, matched only by Wilmington's Devin Fitz-Gerald with 8 apiece). After riding the bench in 12 of the first 16 games of the season for St. Paul, Sabato has started 25 of 30 games since April 16. In that stretch, the former UNC Tarheel is hitting .333 (29-for-87) with all ten of his homers this year and is producing an 1.213 OPS that ranks 2nd among all Triple-A hitters with at least 50 PA in that run (trails only H. Bolte, 1.244). Sabato currently leads all IL hitters with at least 80 PA in slugging% (.710) and ranks 3rd in OPS (1.076).

**GABBY'S GOT A BRAND NEW BAG:** Gabriel Gonzalez brings a six-game hit streak into Thursday, a stretch where the 21-year-old is 11-for-21 with 2 XBH and five walks. Gonzalez had entered play Friday mired in a slump where he was 5-last-54 (.093), including an 0-for-25 skid in the middle. The Twins' No. 7 prospect raised his average has raised his average 42 points the last six games (.174 > .216). Gonzalez is a year removed from leading the Twins system with a .329 average between three levels.

**SAINTLY SLUGGERS:** After blasting a ridiculous 24 home runs in a seven-game span from May 2-9, the Saints have hit 10 round-trippers in their last nine games since. Over their last 15 contests (circa May 2), the Saints rank 3rd in MLB/MiLB in homers (34), lead all of baseball in team OPS (1.008), rank 2nd in SLG% (.586), and are 2nd in runs scored (132, 8.8/gm). The Saints have homered in 26 of their past 33 games and have not gone back-to-back games without a homer since April 10-11 in Toledo. The Saints currently tout eight hitters with at least five homers on the season, but only yesterday saw their first two hitters (Fedko & Sabato) reached double-digits (there are currently 30 hitters with at least 10 homers in MiLB entering play on Thursday).

**YOU'RE HOT & YOU'RE COLD...:** The Saints snapped a three-game losing streak on Wednesday, avoiding matching their longest skid since losing four straight from April 21-24 in Indianapolis. Despite the recent cold snap, St. Paul are still 15-7 over their past 22 games since April 25, tied for the 2nd best record in Triple-A in that span (Nashville are 16-7). During the run, the Saints have outscored their opponents 160-107 (+53) after they were a -38 (112-150) over their first 24 games to start the season in which they went 9-15. Over their last 22 games, St. Paul rank 2nd in the Int'l League in team AVG, OPS, and runs scored (all trailing Charlotte). Their ERA in that run that ranks 1-5th and their SO:BB ratio of 2.45 is 4th in the Int'l League.

**LOWERTOWN LAUNCH PAD:** Entering play Thursday, CHS Field ranks 2nd among all full-season MiLB parks in combined OPS this season (.904 between the Saints and their opponents). The 96 homers featured in St. Paul already are the 2nd-most at an MiLB venue this year, trailing only Truist Field in Charlotte (110). Over the previous five years (2021-25), the Saints' home ranked 3rd (.795) among IL ballparks in combined OPS, behind only Truist Field (CLT) & Werner Park (OMA) and 5th in the league in home runs (966), trailing Syracuse, Omaha, Durham, & Charlotte's parks.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Pitched in relief Sunday against Columbus and went 3.0 scoreless innings while facing one over the minimum with a walk...retired eight in-a-row to finish his outing...threw 19 four-seamers (54%), 11 changeups (31%), and 5 curveballs (14%)...generated three swings-and-misses...

**ONE OF US:** Klein became the sixth Minnesota-born player to suit up for the Triple-A iteration of the St. Paul Saints when he made his Triple-A debut, joining RHP Jake Petricka (2022, Northfield), LHP Caleb Thielbar (2022-24, Northfield), RHP Louis Varland (2022-24, Maplewood/St. Paul), OF Matt Wallner (2022-24, Forest Lake), and LHP Aaron Rozek (2024-25, Burnsville). Thielbar is the only Minnesotan to have pitched for both the Saints independent and Triple-A franchise eras.

**THIS PLACE SEEMS FAMILIAR:** A graduate of Osseo HS, Klein pitched several times at CHS Field before going pro. Most recently, he participated in the "Senior Salute Tournament" in July/August of 2020. The showcase event gave a chase for recently graduated seniors to play for their communities one last time after missing out on their senior year of high school baseball due to the COVID-19 pandemic. A total of 24 teams turned up for the tournament and since schools sent only their 2020 graduates, most teams consisted of an alliance between two or three schools. After finishing atop their group in the pool play round, Osseo/Totino-Grace defeated Woodbury/Stillwater 4-3 in the championship quarterfinals on July 31 before seeing its run ended in the semifinals the following day in a 4-2 loss to St. Michael-Albertville/Orono. As a sophomore and junior, Klein's Osseo Orioles played in a Section Final at the home of the Saints, coming up a win shy of reaching the State Tournament each time, losing 7-0 to Champlin Park in '18 and 5-0 to Mounds View in '19
