RIDERS FALL TO HOOKS IN GAME THREE:

The Frisco RoughRiders were topped by the Corpus Christi Hooks 4-2 on Thursday night from Riders Field. Frisco (21-15) tacked on the first two runs when **Abimelec Ortiz** scored on a wild pitch in the bottom of the first and **Cam Cauley** crashed an RBI double to put the Riders up 2-0. Corpus Christi (11-25) cut the lead when Pascanel Ferreras served an RBI single in the top of the fifth and Ryan Wrobleski hit a two-run homer in the top of the sixth to grab a 3-2 lead. Wrobleski then struck again in the top of the eighth, lining an RBI single to give the Hooks a 4-2 lead. After scoring seven runs in the bottom of the ninth on Wednesday, the Riders tried for more ninth-inning magic. **Luis Mieses** hit a two-out double, but Hooks reliever Michael Knorr struck out **Frainyer Chavez** to earn his first save of the season. Corpus Christi starter Jackson Nezuh (1-5) garnered the win, allowing two runs on four hits across 5.2 innings. RoughRiders reliever **Larson Kindreich** (0-1) took the loss, fanning four but allowing his first two runs of the season on the Wrobleski homer. **Josh Stephan** turned in a strong start for Frisco, allowing just one run while striking out seven across five innings.

HISTORIC OFFENSIVE DAYS:

When the RoughRiders fell to the Hooks 20-14 on Tuesday, they allowed 20 or more runs for the fourth time in franchise history and the first time since 5/1/18 vs. San Antonio (20-4 loss). In that game, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, **Josh Naylor** and **Ty France** all homered for the Missions. The 34 runs were the most combined runs in franchise history and their second time losing while scoring 14 or more runs. It was their first time since 5/16/15 versus Corpus Christi (15-14 loss). The first two games of the series combined for 55 runs.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While on a seven-game hitting streak, Ortiz is hitting .483 (14-for-29)/.531/.828/1.359 with four doubles, two home runs and 10 RBIs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (**Josh Stowers**). He is seventh in the Texas League in May average (.364) and OPS (1.076).

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 11 this month, which is fifth in the league and have allowed 15, which is tied for the most. Corpus Christi has both hit the most (16) and allowed the most (15) in the Texas League this month.

NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .356 (21-for-59)/.480/.610/1.090 over his last 18 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (28) and OBP (.444) while leading the league in walk rate (23.9 percent), a mark which also ranks fourth in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 PA). He is currently on a 10-game hitting streak, batting .457 (16-for-35)/.568/.714/1.282 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and nine walks. That is the fourth-best active streak in the Texas League. In May, he is hitting .410/.521/.641/1.162, ranking first in average and third in OPS in the Texas League.

HOOKIN CORPUS

5.2 runs per game with a .719 OPS. **Sebastian Walcott** (3), **Josh Hatcher** (2), **Luis Mieses** (2) and **Abimelec Ortiz** (2) and have all hit multiple home runs against the Hooks this season. Walcott is now hitting .304 (14-for-46)/.418/.543/.961 against the Hooks.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first six starts, his 1.99 ERA is fifth in the Texas League. It is also the second-best start to a season through the team's first 32 games (min. six games start) recorded franchise history, only trailing Justin Grimm in 2012, who had a 1.60 ERA through seven starts. His 3.9 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.80 K/BB is also first.

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.X.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1stTeam All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
