LAST GAME OUT

(Sun, March 31) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped 4-3 to the Buffalo Bisons on Easter Sunday. The RailRiders could not hold on to a late lead and finish the series up 2-1.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre got on the board first in the second inning. Jeter Downs and Josh Breaux notched back-to-back singles to reach. Brandon Lockridge came up with a run-scoring double for a 1-0 advantage.

Peyton Henry smashed a solo shot to leading off the fourth to tie things up.

The RailRiders rallied back in the next frame. Lockridge singled and raced home on a triple from Luis Gonzalez. Caleb Durbin knocked in a team-high fourth RBI for a 3-1 lead.

Buffalo got within one in the sixth inning. Orelvis Martinez reached on an error and moved to second on a groundout. He moved to third and then home on wild pitches. In the eighth inning, the Bisons got back on top. Spencer Horwitz worked a two-run single to take over 4-3.

Cody Morris got the open, tossing two shutout innings on 43 pitches. Oddanier Mosqueda recorded two outs in the third but walked two. Yorlin Calderon stranded them picking up a strike out in his Triple-A debut. Calderon finished with three and a third frames allowing two runs, just one earned. Clayton Andrews (L, 0-1) tossed a clean seventh. He left with a runner on, two outs, and 3-2 count to the batter in the eighth. Dennis Santana allowed both to score while finishing out the frame.

Chad Dallas got the start going five innings of work. He allowed three runs on seven hits. Paxton Schultz and Hagen Danner (W, 1-0) had quiet appearances. Connor Cooke (S, 1) put up a zero in the ninth.

NEWS & NOTES

STEALING SWIPES - The RailRiders recorded a pair of steal in Sunday's contest, thanks to Brandon Lockridge and Caleb Durbin. Lockridge recorded four in the series which is both a team and an International League high. SWB is in third in Triple-A with Gwinnett having 13. The RailRiders stole a season high 174 bases last summer.

DURBIN'S DEBUT - Caleb Durbin was electric in Triple-A debut this weekend at Buffalo. on He was hit by a pitch in his first at-bat and immediately stole second base. Durbin totaled four hits, including a pair of doubles. He drove in a team-high four runs while scoring one of his own. Durbin also stole two bags in the three games he played. The 24-year-old played both second and third base. Durbin was originally drafted by Atlanta in 2021 but was traded to New York along with Indigo Diaz for LHP Lucas Luetge.

EXTRA EXTRA - In the three game series, the RailRiders recorded twelve extra base hits. The team had eight doubles including two each from Durbin and Lockridge. Luis Gonzalez had the team's first triple in a hard line drive to deep center field. SWB also had three homers in the contest on Friday, but not in the two games that followed. Greg Allen led off the game with his, while Jose Rojas and Everson Pereira each notched one of their own.

DRY SPELL - The RailRiders came out swinging on Opening Day in Buffalo racking up three home runs, including one on the first pitch of the game. Greg Allen, Jose Rojas, and Everson Pereira all went yard. However, in the next two contests SWB did not record a long ball. The Norfolk Tides lead Triple-A with a dozen homers while both Columbus and Toledo each only have one.

DEFENSE - After opening weekend only two teams have a perfect fielding percentage. Iowa and St. Paul made no errors in the field thus far. Both the RailRiders and the Mets made three in the first few contests.

RAINED OUT - SWB had its first and second rain out of the season this week at PNC Field. Lehigh Valley and Rochester have also not been able to play their series due to inclement weather. Last season, the team had six postponements of games and two full cancellations. Five of the six postponed came in Moosic, Pennsylvania.

FOR THE TEAM - SWB has recorded three sacrifice hits through their first three games of the season. Jeter Downs had a perfect sacrifice bunt to move a runner to third base. Both Carlos Narvaez and Luis González had sacrifice fly ball to score a run. Last season the team had just four sac bunts and 34 sac flies.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top outfielding prospect Everson Pereira (#6 per MLB Pipeline) alongside starting pitchers Will Warren (#8), Clayton Beeter (#14), and Yoendrys Gómez (#18).
