LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats did not get out of the first inning smoothly in a 3-2 defeat to the Somerset Patriots on Friday night at Delta Dental Stadium. Somerset scored all three of its runs in the first inning with two outs against starting left-hander Ricky Tiedemann. Yankees top prospect Spencer Jones went deep for a two-run homer and Eduardo Torrealba singled in a run to give Somerset a 3-0 lead after the first. New Hampshire scored its first run of the game in the fifth on an RBI fielder's choice by Victor Arias. Right-hander Davis Feldman threw four scoreless and hitless innings in relief from the third through the sixth with four strikeouts in his home debut. In the bottom of the ninth, Devonte Brown inched the Fisher Cats closer with a solo homer to right-center. After Phil Clarke doubled, Michael Turconi had a chance to either tie or win the game but he flew out to center to end the night.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?: OF Devonte Brown homered last night for his 14th Double-A hit since earning promotion on August 30. Brown's slugging percentage is at a whopping .534 at Double-A as nine of his 14 hits have gone for extra bases (five doubles and four homers). The 24-year-old undrafted free agent has hit 18 homers this season between High-A Vancouver and Double-A New Hampshire.

GET SCHWECKED: UTL Trevor Schwecke is tied with Richmond's Brady Whalen and Harrisburg's James Wood for the league-lead in hits this month with 16 after homering on Thursday, his seventh of the season. The 25-year-old is batting .305 in the second half and is hitting .372 (16-for-43) in the month of September.

GETTING TIROTTA IN HERE: IF Riley Tirotta is batting .349 (15-for-43) in the month of September with six extra base hits, three home runs and 11 RBI. The 25-year-old is tied for third in the league in RBI this month and tied for fourth in hits this month.

ARIAS ADAPTS: OF Victor Arias made his Double-A debut last night and did not disappoint, collecting his first hit and RBI. The 20-year-old Venezuelan was brought up from Single-A Dunedin on Wednesday. This season, 12 of 14 Fisher Cats recorded their first Double-A hits in their Double-A debuts, including Arias. The list also includes Alan Roden, Leo Jimenez, Miguel Hiraldo, Damiano Palmegiani, Devonte Brown, Rainer Nunez, Riley Tirotta, Dylan Rock, PK Morris, Jeffrey Wehler and Bryce Arnold.

ALL IT TAKES IS ONE: New Hampshire and Somerset have played 16 total times this season. Eight of the 16 games have been decided by just one run. The Fisher Cats are 4-4 in these one-run games to the Patriots. This season, New Hampshire is 13-21 in one-run games.

BUILT BULLPEN TOUGH: Since the 9th inning at Bowie on Sunday, New Hampshire's bullpen over its last 22.2 innings has an ERA of just 1.22. At one point, New Hampshire's relievers had thrown 13.2 consecutive scoreless innings until Thursday in the 8th. The longest scoreless streak by the Fisher Cats this season has been 24.2 innings between May 4-May 7.

PRIME TIME MIKE: RHP Michael Dominguez makes his eighth and final start with the Fisher Cats this season. Dominguez is coming off three road starts over the 12-game trip to Reading and Bowie. The 23-year-old struck out a career-high 10 over five innings at Reading but then failed to reach the fifth in each of his two starts at Bowie. Dominguez has a 3.60 ERA in three home starts this year.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (September 16, 2011) --- At the Diamond in Richmond, the Fisher Cats took a 2-1 lead in the EL Championship series with a 5-3 win over the Flying Squirrels. After failing to get a hit in the first 5.2 innings, the Fisher Cats finally broke through with a single by Anthony Gose. They would go on to score five runs in the sixth to cruise to victory. Bobby Korecky earned his fourth post-season save with a perfect ninth.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (81-67) beat the Red Sox 3-0 with all the runs coming on Vladimir Guerrero Jr.'s 23rd homer in the first inning of Brayan Bello. Jose Berrios, Jordan Hicks, and Jordan Romano combined on the five-hitter. With losses by the Astros, Rangers, and Mariners, the Blue Jays are back within a half-game of the third wildcard...Buffalo (72-68) lost 4-2 at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Orelvis Martinez homered to put the Bisons up 2-0 in the fourth, but the Rail Riders scored three off Jimmy Burnette in the seventh to move in front. Rafael Lantigua doubled in a run for Buffalo...Vancouver is now up 2-1 in the Northwest League Finals after a 1-0 win over Everett last night at Nat Bailey Stadium. Gabriel Martinez knocked in the only run of the game with a single in the sixth. Ryan McCarty, who had singled and moved up on a hit-by-pitch, scored the run. The Canadians can wrap it up at 10:05 tonight.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue the final home stand of the regular season until Sunday against the defending Eastern League champions and this season's Northeast Division first-half champions, the Somerset Patriots.
