SUGAR LAND SPACE COWBOYS (32-23) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (25-30)

Sunday, June 1, 2025 • 6:05 p.m. (MT) • RGCU Field at Isotopes Park • Albuquerque, NM Game #56, Home Game #29

LHP Brandon Walter (3-1, 1.94) vs. RHP Andrew Quezada (0-2, 8.51)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes have a 3-2 series lead after holding on for a 10-8 victory last night ... With a win, Albuquerque will claim its first series triumph since August 27-September 1, 2024, vs. Reno ... Albuquerque has won six of its last eight ... Andrew Quezada is expected to start for the Isotopes while Brandon Walter is expected to take the hill for the Space Cowboys.

LAST EIGHT: Over Albuquerque's last eight games, the club is first in Triple-A in homers (20) and total bases (154) and second in runs (64), doubles (21) and hits (96).

SERIES: With a victory today, the Isotopes would claim their first-ever series victory over Sugar Land in the 19th all-time set. This is the fifth time Albuquerque has won three of the first five games in a series against the Space Cowboys (also: Aug. 12-16, 202 May 31-June 4, 2022; June 28-July 2, 2022; Aug. 20-24, 2024).

HOUSTON AFFILIATE: The Isotopes have not won a set against Houston's Triple-A affiliate (Fresno, Round Rock, Sugar Land) since sweeping the Grizzlies from Aug. 20-23, 2016 (27 series streak)

DOUBLE-DIGITS: The Isotopes scored in double digits for the fourth time in their last six games Saturday after accomplishing the feat just once in the previous 24 contests.

MARGIN: With the victory last night, Albuquerque is 11-12 in games decided by two runs or fewer. Yesterday was their first occurrence since May 24 at Reno (8-7 win), ending a stretch in which 10 of 16 contests were settled by exactly one run.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL: The Isotopes have a -9 run differential in 2025. Through June 1, 2024, the club's run differential was -134.

HOMERS: The Isotopes have hit 17 homers in their last six games (seven Sunday at Reno and 10 over the first five games of this series).

TRIPLE-A DEBUT: Rockies No. 15 prospect Gabriel Hughes made his Triple-A debut on the bump last night, working 5.2 innings of six-hit, four-run ball (three earned). Is the 47th different player to appear in a game for the Isotopes this season.

9TH INNING: The Isotopes permitted four runs in the 9th frame Saturday, tied for the most relented in the final inning this season and second against Sugar Land (also: May 28 and May 18 vs. Tacoma)

25: Albuquerque won their 25th game Saturday. Last season, they did not reach the mark until June 21.

RIT: Ryan Ritter extended his career-long hit streak to 16 games last night, longest active in PCL. During streak is slashing .451/.500/1.042 with nine doubles, three triples, nine homers, and 27 RBI . Longest hit streak by an Isotope since Greg Jones (18, Aug. 25-Sept. 15, 2024).

-During hit streak leads MiLB in average, hits, total bases, homers, RBI, OPS and slugging ... Has 22-game on-base streak, tied for longest active streak in PCL ... Has 12 multi-hit games in his last 15 contests and team-leading 19 in 2025 ... Has an extrabase hit in 14 of his last 15 contests.

-Tied a career-high with five RBI Saturday, also reached April 23, 2024, against the Portland Sea Dogs ... Marked his eighth game with multiple RBI in his last 15 contests.

-In May, slashing .381/.445/.918 with 10 doubles, three triples, 12 homers and 31 RBI after hitting .224 over first 26 games. During May, led all of MiLB in total bases (89), extra-base hits (25), slugging percentage (.918), tied for 1st in home runs (12), and second in RBI (31) and OPS (1.363).

AMADOR: Adael Amador tallied two hits and three RBI last night ... Had three RBI for the first time since Aug. 15, 2024, vs. Somerset ... Has hit safely in 10 of 12 contests at Triple-A this season ... Has three multi-hit games.

YF: Yanquiel Fernández went 0-for-3 last night with two walks, ending his 11-game hit streak. Slashed .432/.490/.636 with six doubles, a homer, and six RBI, his longest since a 14-gamer with High-A Spokane from May 31-June 16, 2023 ... Had eight multi-hit games during stretch ... Has a 12-game on-base streak.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson went 0-for-4 last night but was hit by a pitch to extend his on-base streak to 10 games ... During May, slashed .351/.455/.649 with six doubles, two triples, four homers and 14 RBI ... Among PCL leaders during Month in OBP (4th), OPS (5th) and slugging (6th).

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel ended a two-game hitless streak (0-for-5) with his 17th multi-hit contest of the season Saturday and third in his last six contests.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is 1st in runs (44), total bases (125), OPS (1.056), and slugging (.641), T-1st in XBH (31), 2nd in homers (16) and RBI (43), 4th in OBP (.415), T-6th in walks (33), and triples (3), and T-7th in hits (59) ... Warming Bernabel is T-6th in doubles (15) ...Sterlin Thompson is T-6th in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is T-9th in stolen bases (11).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
