SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

WHAT. JUST. HAPPENED.: The Shuckers set a new season-high with 10 runs in the ninth inning on Saturday to complete a five-run comeback, and win, 12-7 over the Biscuits... In the inning, the Shuckers scored 10 runs on four singles, two doubles, a home run, three walks and an error.

THE FIRST TIME IN A LONG TIME: With Saturday night's 12-7 win, the Shuckers clinched their first series win at Riverwalk Stadium since May 7-11, 2018, snapping a streak of nine straight series without a win in Montgomery... This week, the Shuckers have outscored the Biscuits 48-31, hitting .324 as a team with a 1.007 OPS... Biloxi's 48 runs this series are the most in Double-A, and the third-most in Minor League Baseball.

SUMMER OF CHIOURIO: OF Jackson Chourio enters today with a season-best nine game hit streak, tallying a multi-hit game in eight of the nine games... Over that stretch, Chourio is 21-42 (.500) at the plate with three doubles, a triple, four home runs and just four strikeouts... Since the start of his streak on July 6, Chourio's .500 average is the second-highest in Minor League Baseball and his 1.438 OPS is the third-highest... Chourio is also six home runs away from becoming the first teenager with a 20/20 season between Double-A and Triple-A since OF Delmon Young in 2005.

BACK IN BLACK: INF Tyler Black enters today with a six-game hit streak after a home run and a single during Biloxi's 10-run ninth inning on Saturday... During this week's series against Montgomery, Black has tallied multi-hit performances in four of five games, going 10-23 (.434) with a double, two triples and two home runs... Black is hitting .352 (19-54) in July with a .444 on-base percentage and a 1.111 OPS.

<u>CLUTCH GENE</u>: C Nick Kahle smashed a bases-clearing double to the wall in right-center on Saturday night, giving Biloxi a 10-7 lead during their 10-run ninth inning... In games with the Shuckers' trails by three runs or fewer, is tied or is ahead by only one run in the seventh or later, Kahle is 4-5 with two doubles, two walks and six RBI... Since the start of July, Kahle is a perfect 4-4 in the situation with two doubles and two singles.

HE'S ON THE MOVE: With two stolen bases on Thursday, INF Tyler Black has 45 stolen bases in 2023, seven away from tying OF Johnny Davis' franchise record of 52, set in 2017... Black enters today with 17 stolen bases against the Biscuits, the most by any opposing player this year... Black currently leads the Southern League and Double-A in the category.
