Today: It's the finale of this six-game series, a Capital City Market Kids Day with Tyler's Amazing Balancing Act and Kids Run the Bases after the game! Top prospect right-hander Jeff Criswell makes his return for the first time since May 8th, taking on West Michigan left-hander Adam Wolf, who tossed six no-hit innings with nine strikeouts against the Lugnuts on July 25th at LMCU Ballpark. Lansing has won three of the first five games of this series, taking a 9-8 lead in the season series and giving the Lugnuts their 100th all-time home victory over the Caps. Today marks the 398th all-time meeting between the intrastate archrivals.

Last Night: Lugnuts 7, Whitecaps 6. Two swings, one big, one small, each supplying three runs, lifted the Nuts to victory in front of 5,459 on Saturday. The big one came from William Simoneit, a three-run go-ahead home run in the fifth inning, helping the Nuts fully erase an early 3-0 deficit. The small one came from Yerdel Vargas, a swinging bunt in the seventh inning with the bases loaded that cleared the bases thanks to a pair of West Michigan errors, giving Lansing the lead for good.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

### Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

**Plus/Minus:** Though the Lugnuts lead the Whitecaps 9-8 in their season series, the Whitecaps have outhit the Lugnuts .250-.220 and outscored the Nuts 80-62 in those 17 games. Lansing's best hitter against West Michigan has been leadoff hitter **Shane Selman**, slashing .308/.429/.436 with two doubles and a home run in 12 games.

Keep it Clean: The Nuts went without an error last night, their fourth errorless game in the last five days. In the one game in this series in which they've committed a miscue, they were charged with four errors in Friday night's 11-6 loss.

The Strike Zone is That Way: Lugnuts batters were hit by pitches four times last night. That included Cobie Vance, who was plunked for the third time in four games by West Michigan pitchers. The Nuts have now been hit 82 times this year, third most in the High-A Central.

**Winning Tight:** Yesterday's 7-6 Lugnuts victory meant that each of the last four Lugs victory and six of the last seven have come by exactly one run. Lansing is 13-6 in one-run games this season.

**Drawing Power:** The Nuts have brought in crowds of over 5,000 each of the last three games: 5,624 on Thursday night, 5,177 on Friday night and 5,459 last night. That brings the home season attendance to total to 171,077 through 53 home games, fifth most in the High-A Central.

**High Quality:** Right-hander **Reid Birlingmair** limited West Michigan to three hits and three runs in six innings yesterday, his fourth quality start of the year. That ties Birlingmair with **Colin Peluse** for the most quality starts for a Lugnuts pitcher this season.

**Truth in Advertising:** Shortstop **Drew Swift** has lived up to his name; the 8th-rounder from Arizona State stole his sixth base in just 14 games with the Lugnuts yesterday. Consider that Swift only swiped six bases in 54 games during the 2021 college baseball season.

**Up the Ladder:** Oakland's Triple-A affiliate, the Las Vegas Aviators, have won eight straight games and 11 of their last 12 games, beating the Oklahoma City Dodgers last night, 10-9, to improve to 53-45 this year.

Down the Ladder: Oakland's Low-A affiliate, the Stockton Ports, has had each of their last two games postponed due to Covid-19 precaution.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2013:** Ben White (the self-proclaimed "Heartbeat of the Team"!) set a franchise record with four wild pitches in 4 1/3 innings on his way to 20 for the season (tied for the team record), and the Lugnuts lost at Lake County, 6-2. White also hit two Captains with pitches.

**2019:** It was beat-the-rain with the Lugnuts, in a two-hour, 24-minute 7-3 victory over West Michigan before a massive storm showed up at Cooley Law School Stadium. Fitz Stadler gave up one run in six innings and LJ Talley, Johnny Aiello, Rafael Lantigua and Griffin Conine all homered off Whitecaps starter Chance Kirby in the win.

New Talent Infusion: The Lugnuts have five 2021 Athletics acquisitions on their roster in infielders Brett Harris (drafted in the 7th round, Gonzaga) and Drew Swift (8th round, Arizona State), outfielder Jonny Butler (14th round, North Carolina State), and pitchers Kyle Virbitsky (17th round, Penn State) and Jack Owen (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vecas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore), pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17 (Toronto) and infielder Otto Lopez '19 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Welcome to the Pros: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Jack Owen, Kyle Virbitsky and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, infielder Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their professional debut with the Lugnuts this season.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 19 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Osvaldo Berrios, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Jack Owen, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka, Kyle Virbitsky and Brock Whittlesey.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison.

**Welcome Back:** Today marks Criswell's second professional appearance, following a stint on the Injured List from May 12-August 27.

Last Time Out: Jeff made his professional debut with two scoreless innings May 8th vs. Lake County, the fifth game of the season... needed only 23 pitches, 15 strikes... recorded one strikeout (Will Brennan)... committed two-out fielding error allowing Bryan Lavastida to reach in the 1st inning, but retired George Valera on a groundout to strand him... allowed two-out infield single to Daniel Schneeman in the 2nd, with Schneeman stealing second base, but retired Gianpaul Gonzales on a groundout to end the inning...

**Prospecting:** Criswell is considered one of the best lower-level pitching prospects in the Athletics' organization, rated Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... listed as one of two pitchers to watch, in addition to Colin Peluse, by farm director Ed Sprague in a pre-season interview with The Mercury News' Shayna Rubin, with Sprague saying, "He looked really good in instructional league. High velocity, starter mix."

**Personal:** Criswell played the trombone and cello while growing up... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A closer look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

National Pride: Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team, where he recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series. In all, he limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.
