JUMBO SHRIMP EDGED 3-2 BY SPACE COWBOYS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were nipped 3-2 on Thursday by the Sugar Land Space Cowboys at VyStar Ballpark. The Jumbo Shrimp loaded the bases with nobody out in the first before a pair of sacrifice flies gave them a 2-0 lead. All three Space Cowboys runs came in the third courtesy of an RBI double from Jack Winkler and a two-run two-bagger from Carlos Pérez. Three Jacksonville relievers (Zach McCambley, Jack Ralston and Josh White) combined to fire 6.0 shutout innings, yielding just one hit while striking out nine.

IT'S NOT HOW YOU START

At 1-5, Jacksonville is off to its worst start since also beginning the 2022 campaign 1-5. The good news for the Jumbo Shrimp is that that 2022 club was able to rebound from a rough start to finish that season 80-69 (.537). With a win on Friday against Sugar Land, this year's Jumbo Shrimp would avoid being the first Jacksonville squad since at least 2005 to begin a season 1-6.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but one game thus far in 2026, with the lone exception being a nine-punchout performance on March 29 against Rochester. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 14 strikeouts in each of the last three games, totaling 43 against 14 walks during that span. As a result, heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 72 strikeouts over the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 29.4 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%).

RECORDS ARE MADE TO BE BROKEN

Jacksonville set franchise-records in 2025 in stolen bases (305) and pitching strikeouts (1,344). The club also neared a pair of other records; The Jumbo Shrimp used a whopping 90 players last season, matching the club record set in 2024. Of those 90 players, 49 were pitchers, just two away from tying another club record set in 2024. Jacksonville logged 35 different starting pitchers, smashing the previous record of 28 set in 2024. At VyStar Ballpark, the club's 44 home victories in 2025 were their most at home since 2010 (also 44), while their 45 road triumphs were their most in recorded club history (since at least 2005).

STRESS RELIEF

Jacksonville's bullpen was arguably the club's biggest strength in their 2025 championship run, with the club leading Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and batting average against (.214) while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, through six games in 2026, that strength has turned into an early weakness; the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has surrendered 22 runs, 21 earned, on 28 hits (.235 BAA) in 31.1 innings for a 6.03 ERA that ranks 23rd in Triple-A. One positive is that Jacksonville relievers have combined for 47 strikeouts (13.5 K/9), more than any other bullpen at the level.

GET 'EM ON, GET 'EM OVER, GET 'EM IN

Jacksonville ranks last in Triple-A in batting average on balls in play (BABIP) at just .211, a figure far below the baseball-wide average in the range of .290-.300. The club's lack of luck has been most evident with the bases empty. With no one on, the Jumbo Shrimp rank last in Triple-A in batting average (.144), sporting a woeful .148/.287/.222/.509 line. Jacksonville has been slightly better in the young season with runners in scoring position, hitting .174/.286/.348/.634 as a team.

MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MiLB teams. Jacksonville was not much better in the 2023 (124 steals, 20th in Triple-A) nor 2022 (114, 23rd in Triple-A) campaigns. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, had more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's 29 one-run victories in 2025 tied for the most in Minor League Baseball and were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2026, the club has started 1-2 in one-run games... Robby Snelling has a 1.34 ERA in 13 career Triple-A starts (73.2 IP, 54 H, 5 HR, 20 BB, 91 K, .205 BAA).

ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

-MLB Pipeline ranks Snelling as the No. 39 prospect in baseball entering 2026.

-On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 148 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was named the Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year, an International League All-Star and a 2025 Rawlings Gold Glove Award® recipient for defensive excellence. He is the just the fifth Jacksonville player ever to earn a Gold Glove.
