TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game set with the Akron RubberDucks, Altoona is 6-8 against Akron this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Luis Ortiz pitched into the 8th inning, but the long ball proved to be his achilles heel in a 4-2 loss. Jared Triolo picked up two hits in the defeat. Altoona and Akron were rained out on Thursday night with a doubleheader slated for Friday.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 126 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 40 games to play. Altoona is on track to have 3 players, Liover Peguero (21), Jared Triolo (20), Andres Alvarez (18), with 20 stolen bases for the first time since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 110 home runs across 62 of their 98 games played this season. Altoona has allowed a home run in a season-high 8 straight games, the franchise record is 11 (5/19-29, 2013).

ALVY'S POP: Curve infielder Andres Alvarez has already set a career-high with 17 home runs and 41 RBI and on Tuesday, August 2 picked up his first career multi-homer game with two solo shots. Alvarez ranks 9th in the EL in HR (17), 8th in SLG% (.496), 7th in OPS (.865) and 4th in BB (53). Alvarez recorded the 4th multi-homer game of the season on Tuesday.

A TOUGH WEEK: The Curve dropped 5-of-6 in their series at Bowie last week and had a rough outing on the mound in four of the defeats. Curve pitching allowed 17 home runs and 32 extra base hits in the series with Bowie. The Curve lost by a combined score of 36-12 in the first three games of the series, allowing 10 or more runs in three straight games to begin the series. Altoona last allowed 10 or more runs in three consecutive games on 7/2-4 in 2015 when the Curve allowed 11 and 10 runs in the final two games of their series at Trenton and 11 runs on July 4 vs. Harrisburg.

A FABULOUS START: Since joining the Curve on July 1, Fabricio Macias has made quite an impact in the middle of Altoona's batting order. Macias had a hit in 15-of-17 games to begin his tenure with Altoona and finished July with 18 RBI; 5th-most in the Eastern League.

SOME GOOD ARMS: Quinn Priester finished July with a 1.69 ERA in July, the second-lowest among all pitchers in the Eastern League with at least 25.0 IP. His 1.69 ERA ranks 7th among Double-A Pitchers in the calendar month. Tahnaj Thomas has tossed 10.0 scoreless innings while recording 13 strikeouts, a 0.70 WHIP and .167 batting average against in 7 outings across July.

A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK: After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF Jared Triolo drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 33 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .406 on-base percentage which has raised his season OBP mark from .359 to .372. Triolo reached base safely in 19-of-23 games in July.

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 46 of 98 games played this season and hold a 33-12 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 22-3 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: Managed by Rouglas Odor, the uncle of Baltimore Orioles infielder Rougned Odor, is back in the rubber city as Manager for a third season after previously coaching in Akron with the Aeros from 2011-2013 and later as the Hitting Coach in 2015-17. His roster features several Guardians top prospects including: RHP Daniel Espino (#1), OF George Valera (#2), RHP Gavin Williams (#4), INF Bryan Rocchio (#5), INF Jose Tena (#9), RHP Tanner Burns (#11), INF Jhonkensy Noel (#13), RHP Tanner Bibee (#29) and LHP Joey Cantillo (#30).

THE 'DUCK ON THE POND: Gavin Williams takes the ball on Friday night for Akron. Williams went 4.2 IP against Altoona on July 10 at Canal Park and allowed just 2 runs, he's allowed just 3 runs in 14.0 innings across his last 3 starts. Cleveland's first round pick (23rd overall) in 2021 out of East Carolina University, Williams' collegiate catcher, Seth Caddell has been with the RubberDucks this year for 14 games and is currently with Triple-A Columbus. Raised in Fayetteville, NC, Williams is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 3 prospect in the system and features a fastball in the mid-90's that has touched 100 with a curveball, slider and change-up. He was the American Athletic Conference's Pitcher of the Year in 2021 in his final year at ECU.

CAREER NOTES

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Threw 8.2 scoreless innings to start the season, holding opponents to a .077 batting average against before allowing 6 runs on 6 hits, including 2 HR (4 total) in the second inning of his third start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/29 at Akron pitching in front of dozens of family and friends. Canal Park is just 35 minutes from his native Massillon, OH... Threw 14.2 scoreless innings in road games to start the year... His 31 strikeouts in May were tied for 6th-most by an Eastern League Pitcher (Burrows also had 31 K's in May)... Placed on IL on 6/4 (shoulder) and activated on 6/25, was the first time in his life that he's missed a start due to injury... Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 7/1 to be the Best Man in his older brother's wedding, activated on 7/6... **Has allowed 2R or fewer in 13-of-16 outings this season...**

2021: Made his professional debut splitting the season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola in the Marlins system... Combined to go 6-4 with a 4.18 ERA in 21 appearances, 20 starts... Led all Marlins minor leaguers with 136 strikeouts, ranked second in walks with 49, and sixth in the organization with 99.0 innings pitched... Began the season with High-A Beloit and went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA in four starts in the month of May, struck out 28 batters in 19.1 innings pitched... Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his fourth professional start on May 28 against Peoria, also allowed five hits and walked two in 4.1 innings... Lasted 3.1 innings or shorter in each of his first three starts in the month of June before picked up his third win of the season on June 19 at Peoria, allowing one run on two hits and one walk in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts... Was named Prep Baseball Report's Ohio Player of the Year in 2017... First team all-state and Federal League Co-Player of the Year as a senior... Went 8-0 with a 0.50 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 56 innings pitched in 2017. Threw 7.0 innings, struck out seven batters and held Lakota West to one run in the 5-1 state semifinal victory... Also played basketball for three years... **Was high school teammates with Tigers prospect Dillon Dingler, they both played baseball and basketball for Jackson High School and won state championships in Baseball and Basketball as seniors...** Kyle's father, Todd, coached the basketball team... His father played baseball at Youngstown State... Earned his degree from Ball State in Business Administration in three years... Signed with the Marlins for a bonus of \$1,129,700...
