**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the third in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Southpaw **Hogan Harris**, the Athletics' third-round selection in 2018, 85th overall, makes his second start. Lake County counters with right-hander **Lenny Torres**, the 41st overall pick in the 2018 draft. Expect right-hander **Grant Holman** to follow Harris to the mound.

**On the Air:** Listen in via <http://mlb.streamguys1.com/lansing> as **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaks** deliver the call, while **John Vicari** has the Captains' home call on WJCU 88.7 FM.

**Last Night:** Lansing 4, Lake County 1. Left fielder **Brayan Buevas** capped a tie-breaking three-run seventh-inning rally with a two-run homer, his first roundtripper of the season, and the Lugnuts rode five strong innings from starter **Joey Estes** and the tandem relief of **Joe DeMers**, **Kumar Nambiar** and **Angello Infante** to a second straight win at Classic Park. **Brett Harris** and **Jared McDonald** each collected two hits in the winning cause.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday at Classic Park, including a Saturday doubleheader to make up last night's postponement, before returning home for a 12-game, 13-day homestand at Jackson Field stretching from May 3-15 against the West Michigan Whitecaps and the Dayton Dragons. With the Lugnuts out of town this week, Jackson Field will host Beerfest at the Ballpark on Saturday, with over 50 local vendors bringing their top selections for tasting.

### LUG•NOTES

**Let's Play Two... Again:** The Lugnuts have had doubleheaders scheduled in each of their first four series of this season, getting swept in a twinbill at home against the Captains on April 9, splitting two at West Michigan on April 14, getting swept in two at home against Fort Wayne on April 23, and now Saturday's scheduled doubleheader following Wednesday's postponement. Last year, the Lugnuts played seven doubleheaders, four in September.

**Key Indicators:** The Lugnuts scored first and outlived Lake County in their wins on Tuesday and Thursday, two important aspects to note when it comes to the team's overall success. When the Nuts have scored first, they're 5-1 (but 1-10 when the opposition scores first); when they outlive the opposition, they're 5-3 (but 1-8 when the opponent collects more hits).

**Pitching Excellence:** Over the 18 innings of this series, Lugnuts hurlers have limited Lake County to two runs, one earned, with 22 strikeouts compared to just two walks. In the process, Lansing has lowered its league high ERA from 6.66 to 5.86. The starting pitchers, **David Leal** and **Joey Estes**, have combined for 11 IP, 5 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 13 K.

**Streaking:** Infielder **Brett Harris** went 2-for-2 last night with two singles and two walks, reaching base in his 12th straight game. Harris is hitting 15-for-43, .349, with 11 walks over that span, and is third in the Midwest League with a .456 OBP and fifth with a .326 batting average.

**Others Amongst the League Leaders:** Outfielder **Lawrence Butler** is tied for fourth in the Midwest League with 14 walks, infielder **Euribiel Ángeles** is third with 21 hits, starter **David Leal** is third with a 0.70 WHIP, relievers **Kumar Nambiar** and **Angello Infante** are tied for first with seven appearances, and Infante is second with four saves.

**164 Major League Nuts:** Infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013 in Lansing) debuted off the bench April 20 for the Oakland Athletics, becoming the 164th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the third this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson**. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, including four (Jackson, **Dany Jiménez**, **Kirby Sneed** and the injured **Kevin Smith**) on the A's.

**Welcome Back:** The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

**Talent Rich:** The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buevas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Ángeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 18), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 20) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 21).

**Recent Acquisitions:** Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Ángeles** and outfielder **Gabriel Maeli** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Ángeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maeli was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

**2001:** Aaron Krawiec sets a franchise record with 17 strikeouts in eight shutout innings, allowing two hits and no walks, as the Lugnuts defeated the South Bend Silver Hawks, 2-0. 2000 Cubs third-rounder Krawiec struck out 14 of the first 18 batters and pitched 6 1/3 innings of no-hit baseball. The gem earned him the honor of Midwest League Pitcher of the Week.

**In a Nutshell:** Considered at one time one of the Athletics' top left-handed pitching prospects in the organization, Harris has overcome a series of injuries to return to the mound this year, delivering his first outings since August 2019... he is expected to be followed to the mound today by Grant Holman... @itshoganharris.

**Sports in the Family:** Harris's mother was an All-American softball player at Louisiana, playing from 1992-1995... grandfather Joe Harris played football at Auburn University... Hogan himself started two years at quarterback at St. Thomas More.

**Glory Days:** It was baseball, however, where he truly distinguished himself... played at Petco Park in the 2014 Perfect Game All-American Game, the only player from Louisiana invited... ranked Louisiana's No. 1 player in 2015 and the No. 5 southpaw in the nation... led St. Thomas More to back-to-back state titles in 2014 and 2015... as a senior, in 42 innings, posted 0.67 ERA with five shutouts; allowed eight hits and 26 walks while striking out 76 batters... career high school ERA: 1.03.

**Ragin' Cajun:** In first ever college appearance, notched save... in all, made 14 relief appearances and two starts as a freshman: 3.90 ERA, 27 2/3 IP, 26 K... moved to the starting rotation as a sophomore in 2017, with a 2.66 ERA (5th in Sun Belt Conf.) and 87 strikeouts (6th) in 67 2/3 innings... followed up with a 2.62 ERA in 58 1/3 innings as a junior in 2018, whiffing 54 while allowing just one home run... played summer in Cape Cod League in 2016 (Wareham, teammates with Casey Mize and former Lugenut Sean Rackoski) and 2017 (Yarmouth-Dennis)... worked as high as 98 mph, putting him among the hardest throwers in the country.

**Draft Day:** Signed for \$660,000 as the 85th overall selection in the 2018 draft... other notable Athletics picks in the draft: Tyler Murray (1st round), Jeremy Eierman (2nd round), Lawrence Butler (6th round), Joe DeMers (11th round), Cobie Vance (18th round), Matt Cross (19th round), Max Schuemann (20th round), Daniel Martinez (21st round), Aiden McIntyre (22nd round), Jonah Bride (23rd round), Chase Calabuig (27th round).

**Shut Down:** Wrote Melissa Lockard for The Athletic, Hogan Harris was "the first pitcher the A's selected in that draft after they used their first three picks on college position players. There was a lot of excitement at the time about Harris, who came to pro ball with a fastball in the mid-90s and a high spin rate from the left side. He signed quickly, and then the momentum stopped. Before he could throw a professional pitch, Harris was sidelined with an elbow strain. The A's were cautious with his rehab, shutting him down for the rest of the 2018 season and keeping him back at extended spring training to start the 2019 campaign."

**Optimism in 2019:** Harris made his professional debut for the Vermont Lake Monsters in the New York-Penn League, tossing 3 1/3 innings in a loss to Connecticut on June 17, though he struck out five... two appearances later, he whiffed six while allowing just one run on two hits on June 28 vs. Staten Island... on July 3, he struck out the first six batters he faced and finished with 8 K's in 3 2/3 innings at Lowell... on July 8, he tossed four perfect innings vs. Hudson Valley... on July 13, he fanned six in three scoreless innings vs. Batavia... on July 26, he was promoted to Stockton, combining to allowing just two runs in his 9 1/3 innings in his first two starts... finished the season with four hitless innings on August 29 at Modesto.

**But Then:** Melissa Lockard promoted Harris as one of her top three Athletics prospects ready for a 2020 breakout, projecting him as returning to High-A Stockton to start the year before a quick promotion to Midland awaited... she wrote, "Although Harris sat more in the low-90s than the mid-90s last season, he did touch the mid-90s on occasion. A's minor-league pitching coordinator Gil Patterson said Harris got nearly 40 percent of his strikeouts on his curveball and the fastball and changeup were effective pitches for him in 2019. The focus will be improving his command a bit and tightening up the slider." Unfortunately, there was no 2020 Minor League Baseball season, and then Harris missed all of 2021 due to injury.

**2022 in the Midwest League:** Harris joined the Lugenuts from Spring Training, but was placed on the Injured list on Opening Day... on April 24, at last, he was activated and made his return as a starter that afternoon vs. Fort Wayne... allowed an unearned run in the 1st inning, then walked the first two batters in the 2nd inning and departed; both scored against reliever Osvaldo Berrios in a seven-run 2nd inning, and the TinCaps rolled onward to a 13-5 win.

**Little League Hero:** One of the all-time great Little League World Series performers... coached by father Doug... 6'4, 166 lbs. at age 13, throwing 70s mph heat... opened up 2013 LLWS with an extra-inning no-hitter, crushing a game-winning grand slam to clinch the second game, and then delivering an extra-inning walk-off three-run homer in the third game... led Eastlake Little League to the LLWS championship game, where they fell 6-4 to Japan... Padres prospect Robert Hassell III also competed in the tournament as a member of the Southeast champ from Nashville.

He touched 97 miles per hour as a reliever in the San Diego Collegiate League over the summer, and was regularly hitting 96 in bullpens this fall for Cal, throwing his fastball for heavy riding life. All of Holman pitches have a lot of action, and he has a feel to find the strike zone with all of them.
