#### RIDERS FALL IN SERIES FINALE TO MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped their series finale against the Midland RockHounds 14-2 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. The RockHounds (25-20) took an early 5-0 lead in the top of the second, when Caeden Trenkle rolled an RBI fielder's choice, Colby Halter clipped an RBI double and Brennan Milone crushed a three-run home run. Frisco (26-18) answered in the bottom of the second when Luis Mieses belted a two-run homer to take a 5-2 lead. Midland then scored six runs in the top of the third. Shane McGuire ripped an RBI double, Brayan Buelvas and Caeden Trenkle notched consecutive RBI fielder's choices and then Milone hit his second three-run homer of the game to take an 11-2 lead. The RockHounds added three more when Henry Bolte scored on a passed ball and Junior Perez rolled an RBI groundout in the top of the eighth, then Bolte scored on a wild pitch in the top of the eighth to take a 14-2 lead. Midland starter Gage Jump (3-0) pitched his third-straight quality start, punching out six while walking two. Frisco starter **Trey Supak** (3-2) took the loss, allowing 11 runs while whiffing six. Riders relievers **Larson Kindreich, Gerardo Carrillo, Travis MacGre** gor and Janser Lara combined for just two earned runs and seven punchouts across six innings.

#### SAVE TONIGHT:

On Friday night, Travis MacGregor became the 10th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher Robby Ahlstrom leads the Riders with four saves while Gavin Collyer has three saves and Skylar Hales has recorded two saves. Frisco leads the Texas League and is tied for second in MiLB with 16 saves.

#### **ODD SERIES OVER MIDLAND:**

The Riders took four of six games against Midland last week, but were outscored 33-18 because of two lopsided loses. Frisco's 1.50 ERA was the best in the Texas League over the four games and tied for third in Minor League Baseball. The Riders also recorded a save in each of those four games, the most in the minors.

#### **OVER THE WALL-COTT:**

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 10 games, he has blasted four home runs while slashing .256/.304/.605/.909 with three doubles, eight RBIs and eight runs scored. His six home runs for a 19-year-old in Double-A are tied for the sixth-most since 2005 through 44 team games, trailing Oscar Taveras (10), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (8), Fernando Tatis Jr. (8), Delmon Young (8) and Samuel Basallo (8).

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .235 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 27 games. In that stretch, the Riders are 14-13, batting .188 (41-for-218)/.264/.298/.562 with RISP. Their .188 batting average is ninth in the Texas League and 27th among 30 Double-A teams.

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. In his last 15 games, Ortiz is hitting .310 (18-for-58)/.403/.534/.937 with four doubles, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (**Josh Stowers**). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single. For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week two weeks ago.

#### **MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:**

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 18 this month, which is eighth in the league and have allowed 26, which is the most. Frisco's 4.58 ERA is sixth in the league during the month while they are 12-9 in

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .299 (26-for-87)/.436/.471/.907 over his last 26 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (35) and OBP (.421) while leading the league in walk rate (23.0 percent), a mark which also ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball (min. 145 PA). In May, he is hitting .313/.446/.448/.894, ranking 10th in average, first in OBP and 10th in OPS in the Texas League.

#### **BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:**

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first eight starts, his 1.94 ERA is first in the Texas League. He has the best start to a season through eight starts in recorded franchise histroy by ERA. His 3.6 percent walk rate, 8.5 K/BB and 91.9 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 51 strikeouts are the second most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 41.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands.
