INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians relied on timely hitting and a solid outing from Domingo Germán to defeat the Iowa Cubs, 4-2, on Tuesday evening in the series opener at Victory Field. Matt Gorski kickstarted the Indians (30-38) offense with his 14th home run of the season in the second inning. Pirates rehabber Arika Williams then extended the lead to 2-0 in the third with a single to score Fraizer, who roped his first double of the contest to lead off the frame. With the game knotted at 2-2 following a two-run triple by Hayden Cantrelle in the I-Cubs half of the fifth inning, Indianapolis responded immediately to take the lead. The first three batters of the inning reached base safely, with a leadoff walk to Andrés Alvarez coming around to score the go-ahead run on a Canaan Smith-Njigba sacrifice fly. In the sixth, back-to-back doubles by Alvarez and Matt Fraizer plated an insurance run.

MATT'S GONNA MASH: Matt Gorski continued his hot streak of home runs last night, launching a solo home run for the first run of the game in the second inning. It was his third home run in his past five games and his 13th home run in his last 29 games dating back to May 16. In that time, he is hitting .279 (29-for-104) with 22 runs, 21 extra-base hits, 31 RBI, .750 slugging percentage and 1.089 OPS. He also leads International League leaders in home runs, slugging percentage, extra-base hits and RBI (T-1st) through that stretch. In 53 games this season, Gorski is over halfway to besting his 2023 season total of 20 home runs in 108 games. The Fishers, Ind. native launched a career-high 24 home runs in 81 games between Single-A Bradenton, High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis in 2022.

MATT'S MOVIN': Matt Fraizer logged a season-high three hits last night and became the first Indian to hit two doubles in a game since Nick Gonzales on May 5 vs. Buffalo. Four Indians have recorded a total of six two-double performances this season (Gonzales 3x, Lamb, Nuñez and Fraizer). It was Fraizer's second game of the season with multiple extra-base hits, the first coming on May 22 at Iowa when he doubled and homered.

PEGUERO PEPPERS: Liover Peguero went 4-for-4 last night with two stolen bases, marking his most hits in a single game since going 4-for-5 on April 9 at Toledo. It was just one hit shy of tying his career high of five hits, set on April 5 vs. Memphis. Five Indians batters have recorded nine total four-plus hit games this season (Peguero 3x, Alvarez 2x, Bae 2x, Gonzales and Lamb). Peguero is also just the third Indians batter to swipe more than one base in a game, following Ji Hwan Bae on May 2 vs. Buffalo and Gilberto Celestino on May 3.

OUR BULLPEN IS BRAGGING: The Indians 2.25 ERA (15er/60.0ip) over their last seven games leads all 30 International League teams in that stretch. The Indians bullpen has been at the center of that success, logging a 1.07 ERA (3er/25.1ip) in that time. Geronimo Franzua and Brent Honeywell helped hold the Indians lead last night with 3.0 shutout innings, one hit, one walk and three strikeouts in relief of starter Domingo Germán. None of Franzua (4.2ip), Honeywell (4.0ip), Chris Gau (3.0ip), or Isaac Mattson (4.0ip) have allowed a single run during that stretch.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their lone homestand vs. the Iowa Cubs, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, tonight at 7:05 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians and I-Cubs faced off at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa from May 21-26, splitting the series 3-3. In that series, the Indians launched 14 home runs. Continuing the series for Indianapolis today is RHP Braxton Ashcraft (1-0, 1.50) in his second start with Indianapolis. Countering for Iowa today will be RHP Kyle McGowin (0-0, 9.00), who has made two starts with the I-Cubs this season. In 77 career Triple-A games (61 starts) since 2016, McGowin has never faced Indianapolis.

CRAFTING UP A QUALITY START: Pittsburgh Pirates No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, RHP Braxton Ashcraft, takes the mound tonight for his Victory Field debut. He earned the win with a quality start in his Triple-A debut vs. Jacksonville last Thursday, striking out four across 6.0 one-run innings and didn't walk a batter in his Indians debut. At one point, he retired 12 hitters in a row. Ashcraft's Indians debut came on the heels of a career-high 12 strikeouts in his final Double-A start with Altoona, where he had an ERA under 2.00 during the month of May. He began the season with the Curve, going 2-for-2 with a 3.69 ERA (22er/53.1ip) and 63 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts). Ashcraft was selected by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson (Waco, Texas) High School and had his contract first selected by the Pirates on Nov. 14.

THIS DATE IN 1990: Indians first baseman German Rivera went 5-for-5 with a double, RBI and three runs scored in an 11-9 win over Oklahoma City at Bush Stadium. Indy scored in six of its eight trips to the plate, with eight runs through the first six innings before a six-spot in the seventh by Oklahoma City put the visiting team on top. The Indians then tied the game in the bottom half and plated two in the eighth, fending off defeat. They recorded 18 hits altogether.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Braxton Ashcraft: Right-hander and Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline Braxton Ashcraft is set to make his home debut tonight at Victory Field.

Last Outing: Ashcraft struck out four batters in his Triple-A debut on June 13 at Jacksonville, tossing 6.0 innings with four punchouts to earn his first win and quality start of the Triple-A season.

Against the I-Cubs: Ashcraft has never faced Iowa.

Prospectus: Ashcraft entered the 2024 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 7 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 10 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 10 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, jumping up from being ranked No. 22 in '21 and undergoing Tommy John surgery later that season.

Miscellaneous: Ashcraft was selected by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). ... Had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.
