LAST TIME OUT

MOOSIC, PA (September 3, 2026) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders walked off the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 4-3 Thursday night at PNC Field. Training for most of the game, the RailRiders tied it in the seventh and won it in the ninth, claiming their eighth walk-off victory of the year and their third straight against Lehigh Valley.

The IronPigs took an early lead in the top of the first against Yankees #28 Prospect Brendan Beck. Otto Kemp was hit by a pitch and scored on a Keaton Anthony base hit, giving Lehigh Valley a 1-0 edge. Beck retired the side over the next three frames to keep the game a one-run contest. In the bottom of the fourth, Anthony Volpe homered off IronPigs starter Alan Rangel, launching a slider over the center-field wall to level the game at one.

Lehigh Valley responded in the top of the fifth. After loading the bases, Kemp laced a two-run single to center for a 3-1 advantage.

The RailRiders cut into the deficit in the bottom of the sixth. Kenedy Corona walked before Volpe ripped a single to center, scoring Corona from first to close within one. Volpe finished the game 3-for-4, a triple shy of the cycle. Trailing by one in the seventh, consecutive singles from Max Schuemann and Oswaldo Cabrera put runners on the corners for Tyler Hardman, who lifted a sacrifice fly to tie the game at three.

Tied at three in the bottom of the ninth, Schuemann singled with one out before Duke Ellis entered as a pinch runner. Ellis stole second and scored on an RBI walk-off single from Cabrera to capture the victory.

Beck worked 4.2 frames, striking out seven and allowing three runs on three hits. Justin Topa (1-3) earned the win, pitching 1.1 scoreless frames. Rangel surrendered two runs on four hits, striking out six over 5.1 innings. Kirby Sneed (5-2) gave up one run on two hits in the loss.

NEWS & NOTES

IN THE LEAGUE - After three consecutive wins, the RailRiders move up to sole position of second place with Rochester atop the International League. They are now just a half of a game out and a game in front of Indianapolis and St. Paul. The RailRiders are 7-3 in their last ten games, are ten contests above .500 on the full season. Lehigh Valley is seven games out of first place and have gone 2-8 in their last ten contests.

VOLPE'S VALUE - Anthony Volpe homered yesterday to help lift the RailRiders to victory. It was his second of the series and helped drive in his second RBI. In three games this week, Volpe is hitting .700 with seven hits and five runs scored. He has also stolen three bags. The 25-year-old has hit .287 since returning to the RailRiders in 24 games since August 7.

WELCOME KYLE - Kyle Carr is now ranked as the #13 prospect in the New York Yankees organization. Tonight, he makes his second start off the injured list as he builds back up his endurance. Carr was placed on the IL on July 21 and activated on August 25. Since then his pitch count was limited to 27 in his first appearance and 39 in his second. He holds a 5.40 ERA in 16.2 Triple-A innings. Carr made thirteen starts for Somerset to hold a 4.32 earned run average. Carr was originally drafted in the 3rd round, 97th overall, back in 2023. The 24-year-old split his college career at the University of San Diego and a Palomar Junior College.

AGAINST KELLER - SWB has faced off against IronPigs starter Brian Keller twice already this summer. The RailRiders have lost both of those contests. The team holds a .229 average against Keller, going just 8-for-35. However, Ernesto Martinez Jr., Duke Ellis, and Anthony Volpe have each hit a homer off the righty.

ELI'S ENERGY - Eli Morgan has now made four scoreless appearances out of the SWB bullpen. In six innings of work, he has walked just two while striking out six. Morgan joins the team from the Kansas City organization where he was playing in Triple-A Omaha. With the Storm Chasers, the righty held a 1.40 ERA in 25.2 frames. With the Royals, he made 16 appearances for a 5.12 ERA.

FROM NEW YORK - Both Yerry De Los Santos and Justin Topa recently joined the RailRiders roster from the Yankees. De Los Santos pitched two scoreless frames while Topa added a clean inning and a third. Yerry has been nothing but stellar in New York's bullpen with a 1.35 ERA in 20 frames. Topa holds a 0.00 ERA for the Yankees before he was designated for assignment and chose to re-sign with the organization.

DUKE'S RECORD PERFORMANCE - Duke Ellis set a new single season record with 47 stolen bases on the season. He broke the record of 44 set by Tommy Barrett in 1989. Barrett did so in 120 games, whereas Ellis marked his in 85 contests. Ellis also holds the franchise record for 88 total with Scranton/Wilkes-Barres. The prior record was held by Nick Punto who stole 82 bags in 263 games.
