**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game homestand against the Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Nationals) on Thursday night at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Aaron Wilkerson is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Kyle Luckham for Rochester.

**LAST NIGHT'S RECAP:** The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game homestand against the Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Nationals) with a 5-4 loss on Wednesday night at AutoZone Park. Second baseman Noah Mendlinger went 2-for-4 with a double and RBI. The left-handed hitter accounted for two of the six Redbirds hits. Memphis went 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position in the loss. Designated hitter Mike Antico smacked a double. Starting pitcher Ian Bedell (0-5) allowed three runs on five hits, walked two and struck out one in 3.0 innings pitched. The right-handed hitter allowed a two-run home run as part of a three-run top of the second inning. Gerson Moreno, Skylar Hales and Oddanier Mosqueda combined to go scoreless through the final 5.0 innings of the game.

**WIN CHASE:** With 16 games to play in the 2025 regular season, Memphis currently stands four wins shy of clinching a winning season for the first time since 2018. The Redbirds finished an even 74-74 in 2024, the club's best campaign since it won the Triple-A Championship over the Durham Bulls in 2018 and went 83-57 in the regular season. A winning season in 2025 would mark the first in the tenure of manager Ben Johnson.

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

### COACHING CAREER

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)
- 348 - 367 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason.
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

### PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

### PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

## PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

• Marrero, 44, is beginning his 13th season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis.

### COACHING CAREER

• Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

### PLAYING CAREER

• Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

## HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

• Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis

### COACHING CAREER

• In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

### PLAYING CAREER

• Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.

• Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

2025 Season: 2025 marks Wilkerson's first year in the Reds system, pitching for the Bats. Wilkerson leads all Bats pitchers in innings with 90 and strikeouts with 72. Named International League Pitcher of the Week for 5/19-5/25. 2025

Transactions: Signed to a minor league contract by the Reds on 1/27. Opened the season with Triple-A Louisville.

2024 Season: Spent the full season playing in the KBO as a member of the Lotte Giants. Went 12-8 in 32 starts, logging a 3.84 ERA in 196.2 IP with a career-high 167 strikeouts. Ranked among Giants leaders in innings pitched (1st, 196.2), games started (1st, 32), strikeouts (5th, 167) and wins (T-7th, 12).

Career Highlights: Made his professional debut with the Red Sox organization in short season A ball with Lowell, tossing six innings on 7/20/14 at Auburn, allowing one earned run on three hits and two walks while striking out seven. Traded to the Milwaukee Brewers along with INF Wendell Rijo in exchange for INF Aaron Hill and cash on 7/7/16. Made his Major League debut with the Brewers on 9/15/17 at Miami, tossing a three up, three down ninth inning out of the bullpen to seal a 10-2 Brewers win and picking up his first two big league strikeout of J.T. Realmuto and Brian Anderson. Spent the 2022 season pitching in Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan for the Hanshin Tigers. Pitched for the Lotte Giants of the Korean Base- ball Organization in 2023 and 2024.

MLB Career: Made 14 appearances with the Brewers from 2017-19, posting a 6.88 ERA (27 ER/35.1 IP) and striking out 28 batters. His best outing came on 10/1/17 at St. Louis when he threw seven innings on one-run ball, striking out five and allowing just two hits.

- Is tied for 4th among St. Louis minor leaguers with 21 wins since the start of the 2022 season, the most by any left-handed pitcher in the organization during that time.
- Also leads St. Louis minor league left-handers with 279 strikeouts from 2022-24 (7th in STL system) and his 288.1 IP are second among lefties (9th overall) behind only Connor Thomas (319.2 IP).
- Southern California native graduated from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., which produced former MLB pitchers Dylan Covey and Tim Worrell.
- Attended the University of Southern California from 2018-21 but did not play his first two seasons because of injury.
- Made 15 starts in 2021 with 65 strikeouts against 21 walks.
- Originally selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 37th round of the 2017 MLB Draft, but did not sign.
