Right-handers **Stevie Emanuels** and **Jeff Criswell**, who started last Saturday's doubleheader against Fort Wayne, get the start today against Cleveland's top two selections in the 2021 draft, northpaw **Gavin Williams** and southpaw **Doug Nikhazy**.

**On the Air:** Listen in via <http://mlb.streamguys1.com/lansing> as **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaks** deliver the call, while **John Vicari** has the Captains' home call on WJCU 88.7 FM.

**Last Night:** Lake County 4, Lansing 3. **Jhonkenzy Noel** led off the bottom of the 9th with a walk and **Angel Martinez** followed with a game-winning two-run homer to right, lifting the Captains to victory over reliever **Daniel Martinez** and the Lugnuts. **Euribiel Angeles** had given Lansing the lead with an RBI single in the eighth inning. In the loss, the Lugnuts received two perfect innings from starter **Hogan Harris** and six innings from piggybacker **Grant Holman**.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts wrap up this series against the Captains tomorrow at 1 p.m. before returning home for a 12-game, 13-day homestand at Jackson Field stretching from May 3-15 against the West Michigan Whitecaps and the Dayton Dragons. With the Lugnuts out of town this week, Jackson Field will host Beerfest at the Ballpark today, with over 50 local vendors bringing their top selections for tasting.

### LUG•NOTES

**Let's Play Two... Again:** The Lugnuts have had doubleheaders scheduled in each of their first four series of this season, getting swept in a twinbill at home against the Captains on April 9, splitting two at West Michigan on April 14, getting swept in two at home against Fort Wayne on April 23, and now today's scheduled doubleheader following Wednesday's postponement. Last year, the Lugnuts played seven doubleheaders, four in September.

**Starting Strong:** Lansing's three starting pitchers in this series, **David Leal**, **Joey Estes** and **Hogan Harris** have combined for 13 IP, 5 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 17 K.

**Streaking:** Infielder **Brett Harris** went 2-for-2 Thursday night with two singles and two walks, reaching base in his 12th straight game. Harris is hitting 15-for-43, .349, with 11 walks over that span, and is second in the Midwest League with a .456 OBP and fifth with a .326 batting average.

**Others Amongst the League Leaders:** Outfielder **Lawrence Butler** is fifth in the Midwest League with 15 walks, infielder **Euribiel Angeles** is third with 23 hits, starter **David Leal** is third with a 0.70 WHIP, relievers **Kumar Nambiar** and **Angello Infante** are tied for second with seven appearances, and Infante is second with four saves.

**164 Major League Nuts:** Infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013 in Lansing) debuted off the bench April 20 for the Oakland Athletics, becoming the 164th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the third this year, joining A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson**. There are currently 15 Major League teams with at least one Lugnut representing, including four (Jackson, **Dany Jiménez**, **Kirby Sneed** and the injured **Kevin Smith**) on the A's.

**No. 165?** The Blue Jays called up infielder **Vinny Capra** yesterday, a 20th-round pick in 2018 from Richmond; Capra hit .266 in 25 games for the Lugnuts in 2018 before breaking out with a .327 average for Double-A New Hampshire last year.

**Welcome Back:** The Nuts return one coach (hitting coach **Javier Godard**) and 12 players from 2021, pitchers **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **David Leal**; catcher **Jared McDonald**; infielders **Brett Harris**, **Patrick McColl** and **Drew Swift**; and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Austin Beck**, **Jonny Butler** and **Lawrence Butler**.

**Talent Rich:** The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in **Tyler Soderstrom**, a 20-year-old catcher drafted 26th overall in 2020 who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 10) and **Euribiel Angeles** (No. 11), starting pitcher **Joey Estes** (No. 18), first baseman/outfielder **Lawrence Butler** (No. 20) and pitcher **Jeff Criswell** (No. 21).

**Recent Acquisitions:** Three Lugnuts – pitcher **Joey Estes**, infielder **Euribiel Angeles** and outfielder **Gabriel Maciel** – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Angeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maciel was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021.

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

**Draft Day:** Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Coffman, who also signed Lugnuts catcher Jared McDonald (Western Oregon) and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three of Oakland's five 2020 draft picks on the Lugnuts (1st round - Tyler Soderstrom; 2nd round - Jeff Criswell).

**Personal:** Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

**Hometown:** Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree hosue) for \$36 million.

**Glory Days:** Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

**Life as a Huskie:** Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

**UW in The Show:** Notable Huskies in MLB history include Tim Lincecum, Mike Blowers, Jim Colborn, Fred Hutchinson, Jeff Heath, Jake Lamb, Andrew Kittredge, Adam Cimber, Austin Voth, Braden Bishop, Jeff Bringham, Kevin Stocker, and the unforgettable Hunky Shaw.

**2021 Professional Debut:** Opened season as the Lugnuts' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnuts franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.

**2022 - Back in Lansing:** Piggybacked Jeff Criswell in season debut, Sunday, April 10, striking out six Lake County Captains in three innings... earned win as Lugnuts topped Caps, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... made first start of the year in the fourth game of the series at West Michigan, pitched scoreless 1st and 2nd inning and recorded two outs into the 4th, but in between, gave up five runs on six hits in the 3rd inning, including doubles by Parker Meadows, Colt Keith and Jake Holton and a triple by Andrew Navigato... that supplied the lion's share of the Whitecaps' offense in a 6-3 victory over Lansing... **last start, April 23 vs. Fort Wayne, Game 2:** tied his own franchise single-game record, giving up four home runs to the TinCaps (Corey Rosier leading off the game, Robert Hassell III hit two, Ripken Reyes hit one) in six innings in Lugnuts' 6-2 defeat.

**Personal:** Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

**Hail to the Victors:** Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

**The Run to Omaha:** A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

*NCAA Regional:* Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

*NCAA Super Regional:* Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings.
