LEADING OFF

ROUGH ROAD – Daytona returns home this week after completing its only 12-game road trip of the season, a stretch that saw the Tortugas go 3-9 overall with series losses at Palm Beach (1-5) and Jupiter (2-4). Daytona enters the Tampa series at 1-7 in series play this season and 0-4 in road series while posting an 8-13 record in May. Despite the results, the Tortugas found encouraging signs from the rotation last week. Daytona starting pitchers combined for 29.2 innings and allowed just nine runs (2.73 ERA) across the six-game Jupiter series while holding opponents to a .220 batting average. Sheng-En Lin delivered the best outing of his professional career Saturday, firing a career-high 6.0 shutout innings with a season-best six strikeouts in a 3-0 victory – the longest outing by a Daytona starter this season. Deivi Villafana followed Sunday with another strong effort, allowing just one run over 5.0 innings. Daytona also continued to play close games throughout the trip, with four of the club's nine losses coming by two runs or fewer. The Tortugas enter the week looking to build momentum back at Jackie Robinson Ballpark after navigating the longest road stretch of the 2026 season.

FRIEND IN HIGH PLACES – Florida State League April Player of the Month Jacob Friend continues to cement himself as one of the premier offensive players in the Florida State League. The Daytona first baseman is hitting .313 (5th in FSL) with 41 hits (T-8th), 11 doubles (T-3rd), seven home runs (T-5th), 30 RBI (T-4th), and a 1.017 OPS (T-2nd). Friend also ranks 3rd in slugging percentage (.588), tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (20), 4th in total bases (77), and 4th in on-base percentage (.429). He leads Daytona in

batting average, home runs, RBI, slugging percentage, OPS, extra-base hits, and total bases while serving as the centerpiece of the Tortugas lineup. After missing three games last week, Friend returned to the lineup Saturday and wasted no time making an impact, launching the first pitch of the game for a leadoff home run – the first leadoff homer by a Tortugas hitter this season. The long ball also pushed him to seven home runs on the year and continued a breakout sophomore campaign after hitting .191 across 67 games in Daytona last season.

PUNCHING BACK – Daytona's offense continues to balance production with swing-and-miss tendencies as the Tortugas enter the week with 539 strikeouts through 45 games, the 2nd-most total in Single-A Baseball and the 4th-most across all of Minor League Baseball. Daytona has now recorded double-digit strikeouts in 10 consecutive games and has reached 10+ strikeouts in 35 of 45 contests overall this season, averaging 12.0 strikeouts per game. Despite the swing-and-miss profile, the Tortugas continue to generate offensive production, leading the Florida State League with 80 doubles while ranking 4th in batting average (.231) and 5th in OBP (.343). Kyle Henley remains a catalyst near the top of the lineup, ranking 2nd in the Florida State League in hits (49), 2nd in runs scored (33), and 4th in stolen bases (19), while Jacob Friend and Bernard Moon continue to provide middle-of-the-order impact as Daytona looks to pair its offensive upside with improved consistency.

Ricky Gutiérrez returns to the Cincinnati Reds organization in 2026 as manager of the Daytona Tortugas, bringing extensive Major League experience and a proven track record of leadership throughout professional baseball.

Gutiérrez is no stranger to Daytona Beach. He previously served as the Tortugas' bench coach in 2017 before managing the club from 2018-19, guiding Daytona to the Florida State League Championship Series in 2018. He also appeared in games at Jackie Robinson Ballpark during rehab assignments late in his playing career, giving him a long-standing connection to the franchise.

Across four seasons as a Minor League manager, Gutiérrez compiled a 193-188 record at the Class A and Double-A levels. After leading Daytona for two seasons, he was promoted to manage the Double-A Chattanooga Lookouts in 2021, guiding the club to a winning record.

Following the 2021 season, Gutiérrez joined the Washington Nationals organization, first serving as a special assistant in international operations before moving onto the Major League staff. He worked as the Nationals' run prevention coordinator in 2023 and spent the 2024 and 2025 seasons as the club's third base coach, gaining daily experience at the game's highest level.

As a player, Gutiérrez appeared in 1,119 Major League games across 12 seasons from 1993-2004 with the San Diego Padres, Houston Astros, Chicago Cubs, Cleveland Indians, New York Mets and Boston Red Sox. Primarily a shortstop, he later developed into a versatile utility infielder known for steady defense, situational hitting and consistent preparation.

He was a key contributor on three consecutive Houston Astros division championships from 1997-99, starting all but one postseason game during that stretch. His most productive offensive season came in 2001 with the Chicago Cubs, when he set career highs in batting average (.290), hits (153), runs (76) and RBI (66) while tying for the Major League lead in sacrifice hits. Gutiérrez concluded his playing career as a member of the 2004 World Series champion Boston Red Sox.

A Miami native, Gutiérrez was selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the first round (28th overall) of the 1988 MLB Draft out of American Senior High School. He signed forgoing a scholarship offer to the University of Miami and steadily climbed through the minors before making his Major League debut with the San Diego Padres in 1993.

Baseball has been a lifelong part of Gutiérrez's family. His father, Roberto Herrera, was a professional catcher who played 20 seasons in the Mexican League before later becoming an umpire, and his older brother also spent time in the Orioles' farm system. Gutiérrez grew up around the game in South Florida and developed into one of the top high school shortstops in the state before being selected in the first round.

After his playing career, Gutiérrez transitioned into coaching at the high school level in Miami, leading American Senior High School to its first state championship in 2014. He later returned to professional baseball, where his calm demeanor, attention to detail and player-focused approach have defined his managerial style.

Now back in Daytona, Gutiérrez brings more than three decades of professional baseball experience to the Tortugas dugout as he continues developing the next generation of Cincinnati Reds talent.

Gutiérrez and his wife, Lisa, have five children. He is a native of Miami, Florida, and comes from a professional baseball family that spans multiple generations.

Pitching Coach

JASON IMMEKUS 50

Pitching Coach Jason Immekus returns for his second season with the Daytona Tortugas and his second year in the Cincinnati Reds organization.

Before joining the Reds, Immekus spent three seasons (2021-24) as a pitching trainer with Premier Pitching Performance in St. Louis, Missouri, where he worked with amateur and professional pitchers on individualized training and pitch-design programs. During that time, he also served as an associate scout for the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2023-24).

Immekus previously spent more than two decades as a collegiate pitching coach. His coaching stops included Crowder College (1999-2002, 2018-21), Jefferson College (2006-09), Missouri Southern State University (2009-15), and Pittsburg State University (2016-18). During his time at Missouri Southern, he coached an MIAA Pitcher of the Year and six all-conference pitchers while helping the Lions win a conference championship and advance to two NCAA Regionals.

At Pittsburg State, he was part of a staff that led the program to its first postseason appearance in 16 years. Across his collegiate coaching career, he worked with more than 60 players who later signed professional contracts, including several who reached the Major Leagues.

Immekus also coached in multiple summer collegiate leagues, including the Coastal Plain League, Northwoods League, and MINK League.

A native of Carthage, Missouri, Immekus played collegiately at Independence Community College and Washburn University before pitching three seasons of independent professional baseball in the Frontier League from 2000-02.



Hitting Coach

JOSÉ LEÓN 18

Hitting Coach Jose Leon returns to the Daytona staff for the 2026 season, his fifth year as a coach in the Cincinnati Reds organization.

Leon spent part of the 2025 season with Daytona before moving to Double-A Chattanooga in May to serve as the Lookouts' hitting coach. He previously worked with the High-A Dayton Dragons in 2024, helping guide an offense that led the Midwest League in home runs and finished third in total runs while reaching the postseason.

He joined the Reds organization in 2022 as the hitting coach for the DSL Reds before moving to the Arizona Complex League in 2023.

Prior to his time with Cincinnati, Leon spent five seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals organization. He served as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2017 and 2018 before managing the State College Spikes in 2019. That season, State College led the New York-Penn League in runs scored while also pacing the league in batting average and slugging percentage. He later managed the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Low-A Southeast League in 2021.

A native of Cayey, Puerto Rico, Leon was selected by the Cardinals in the 22nd round of the 1994 MLB Draft and played 16 professional seasons from 1994-2009. He appeared in 88 Major League games with the Baltimore Orioles from 2002-04, primarily at first and third base. He also spent time in four different MLB organizations and played professionally in multiple countries during his career.

Bench Coach Lenny "All Time" Harris returns to the Daytona staff for the 2026 season, his sixth year with the Tortugas and his 10th season coaching in the Cincinnati Reds organization.

Before joining the Reds in 2016, Harris coached at the Major League level with the Washington Nationals and Miami Marlins, and also worked in the Los Angeles Dodgers system. He has served in a variety of roles throughout his coaching career, including hitting coach, assistant hitting coach, third base coach, and minor league instructor.

Harris originally entered professional baseball as a player when he was selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 1983 MLB Draft. He went on to play 18 Major League seasons from 1988-2005 with eight different organizations, including the Reds, Dodgers, Mets, Rockies, Diamondbacks, Brewers, Cubs, and Marlins.

Over his career, Harris appeared in more than 1,800 Major League games while playing every infield position and both corner outfield spots. He set the Major League record with 212 career pinch hits, a mark that still stands. Harris also won a World Series championship as a member of the 2003 Florida Marlins.

He spent parts of seven seasons with the Reds during his playing career and has remained connected to the organization through both his playing and coaching tenures.

Sebastian Almonte is in his fourth season as a coach in the Cincinnati Reds organization.

He began his coaching career with the DSL Reds in 2023 before spending the 2024 and 2025 seasons on the Arizona Complex League staff. Prior to transitioning into coaching, Almonte played five seasons in the Reds minor league system from 2018-22.

A native of Padre las Casas, Dominican Republic, Almonte appeared in 177 career minor league games as an infielder. He reached the Low-A level in 2022 and spent part of that season with the Daytona Tortugas,

appearing in 26 games.

JACKIE ROBINSON BALLPARK

Opened on June 4, 1914, Jackie Robinson Ballpark is the oldest active ballpark in Minor League Baseball and one of the most historically significant venues in the sport. Originally known as City Island Ballpark, "The Jack" sits along the Halifax River at 105 East Orange Avenue and has continuously hosted professional baseball for more than a century.

On March 17, 1946, history changed here. Jackie Robinson took the field for the Montreal Royals in his first integrated professional spring training game, breaking the color barrier in organized baseball in the state of Florida. While other cities locked their gates, Daytona Beach allowed Robinson to play. The moment helped pave the way for his historic 1947 Major League debut with the Brooklyn Dodgers.

Today, a bronze statue of Robinson stands outside the Orange Avenue entrance, and the ballpark is designated a National Commemorative Site, part of the African American Civil Rights Network, and listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Jackie Robinson Ballpark is home to the Daytona Tortugas, the Single-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, and Bethune-Cookman University Baseball. Generations of players, from Minor League standouts to future Major Leaguers, have taken the same field where Robinson once stood. With a capacity of 4,200 and classic sightlines that keep home plate nearly in its original location, the ballpark offers a direct connection to baseball's past.

The facility is currently undergoing a transformative \$40 million renovation project that will carry the ballpark into its next century. The most significant addition is the new Daytona Beach Club presented by Progressive Medical Research, located beyond the right field fence. This state-of-the-art development also includes the Advent Health Player Development Center, which features new home and visiting clubhouses, indoor batting cages, a weight room, team offices, hospitality suites, a new merchandise store, and a dedicated Jackie Robinson museum space. The upgrades are designed to enhance both player development and the overall fan experience while preserving the historic charm that defines "The Jack."

Additional improvements throughout the ballpark continue to modernize amenities while honoring tradition. A high-definition videoboard complements the manually operated scoreboard, and ongoing enhancements ensure the venue remains both historically authentic and fan-forward.

More than a stadium, Jackie Robinson Ballpark is a living monument to courage, progress, and the enduring power of baseball.
