THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2014, Nashville rides a massive 8-run seventh to a convincing 14-2 victory vs. Sacramento. The frame featured just four hits - two of which were homers from Matt Clark and Jeremy Hermida.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds look to make it 10 consecutive wins against the Gwinnett Stripers tonight at Coolray Field. Nashville hurlers Evan McKendry, Clayton Andrews, J.B. Bukauskas and Thyago Vieira held the Stripers to just one hit last night in their 3-1 victory. Tonight, righty Colin Rea gets the start against Gwinnett southpaw Dylan Dodd.

Colin Rea: 33-year-old Colin Rea gets the ball for the Sounds. In three starts for the club this season, he is 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP/3 ER). The right-hander has struck out 15 hitters in Triple-A while not yet issuing a walk. In his previous start, Rea allowed three runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings of work against Charlotte. He struck out six but did not factor into the decision. Rea spent most of his season with Milwaukee, going 5-5 with a 5.11 ERA (100.1 IP/57 ER) in 20 games (19 starts). The Cascade, Iowa, native went 5-6 with a 3.96 ERA in 23 games with the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks of the Japanese Pacific League in 2022. The Brewers signed Rea as a free agent on January 28 and invited him to spring training. Rea went 4-2 with a 2.27 ERA (35.2 IP/9 ER) across seven starts for Nashville in 2021.

Dylan Dodd: 25-year-old Dylan Dodd makes his 13th start with Gwinnett and 19th start of the season. The left-hander is 3-6 with a 7.41 ERA (54.2 IP/45 ER) with the Stripers. He's also made five starts for Atlanta, posting a 2-1 record with a 7.40 ERA (24.1 IP/20 ER). Dodd took the loss last Friday in Durham, surrendering six runs on six hits (three homers) over 6.0 innings. Atlanta's No. 20 prospect per MLB Pipeline, Dodd was placed on Gwinnett's 7-day injured list on June 24, making a rehab start in the FCL on July 27 (3.1 IP, 10 TB, 4 K) before returning to the Stripers on August 2. The Elk Grove, Ill. native was drafted by Atlanta in the third round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Southeast Missouri State University.

One-Hit Wonder: Starter Evan McKendry allowed a single to Gwinnett leadoff man Forrest Wall to start the bottom of the first last night, then combined with three relievers to hold the Stripers hitless for the rest of the game. It was Nashville's first one-hitter since game one of a doubleheader on August 11, 2022 at First Horizon Park. Though that game was scheduled for seven innings, Gwinnett won in nine innings. Their last one-hitter in a regularly scheduled nine-inning game came on May 23, 2021 vs. Gwinnett at First Horizon Park (W, 1-0).

Wink If You Have Three Hits: Rehabbing Milwaukee outfielder Jesse Winker ripped three hits last night, including a go-ahead RBI double in the sixth inning. It was his second three-hit performance of the season, with his first coming during his first rehab assignment with Nashville - on June 13 vs. Gwinnett. Winker is 4-for-8 during this rehab assignment and batting .393 (11-for-28) in nine games for Nashville this year.

Bases Painted Black: Tyler Black extended his on-base streak to 15 games with an RBI single in the sixth inning of last night's contest. He has reached in every appearance with Nashville. Since joining the Sounds on August 6, Black has scored 15 runs, tied for the fourth-most in the International League in that span. He's also drawn 13 walks, tied for eighth-most in the IL. The 23-year-old top prospect (No. 5 in Brewers system and No. 56 in baseball per MLB Pipeline) boasts a .368 OBP since getting the promotion from Double-A Biloxi.

Keston Krushing: Keston Hiura saved a pair of streaks in the ninth inning last night, lining a single to extend his on-base streak to 19 games and hitting streak to nine games. He's batting .355 (27-for-76) with four doubles, seven homers, 23 RBI, four walks, 11 runs, .405 OBP and a 1.089 OPS during the stretch which began on July 28. It is tied for the sixth-longest active on-base streak in the league.

He's a Winner: Evan McKendry is the first International League pitcher to reach 10 victories this season. He is one of 20 arms in the minor leagues with double-digit victories. McKendry looks to be the second Nashville hurler in a row to lead the circuit in wins after Caleb Boushley paced the league in 2022 with 12.

Smashing the Stripers: Nashville has won nine straight games against Gwinnett dating back to May 14, including a six-game sweep of the Stripers in June. This is the team's longest winning streak against an opponent since taking 10 in a row against Columbus from Sept. 22, 2021 to July 9, 2022.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet collected his 304th win at the helm of the Nashville club last night. He trails Rick Renick (1993-96) for second place on the all-time Sounds manager wins list. In order for Sweet to pass Trent Jewett (1998-00, 2003-04) for the most wins in Sounds history, Nashville would need to win 17 of their next 28 games. Sweet has a 304-237 record in four seasons as Nashville's skipper.

LAST OUTING: In his first start with Nashville since April 7, Rea allowed three runs on seven hits against Charlotte. He struck out six and did not issue a walk in 5.0 innings of work. Rea did not factor into the decision in Nashville's 5-4 victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Rea has pitched well against Gwinnett in the past, going 1-0 with 11.2 scoreless innings over two starts. On 8/27/21, he took no decision after fanning nine in 5.2 frames, then he earned the win at Coolray Field on 9/16/21, striking out five in 6.0 innings of work.
