JACKSONVILLE WINS RAIN-SHORTENED GAME

Chi Chi González worked 5.2 strong innings and Troy Johnston added a pair of hits on Tuesday as the Jumbo Shrimp beat the Stripers 2-1 in a rain-shortened seveninning contest. Gwinnett grabbed the lead in the second on Dalton Guthrie's RBI single, but in the bottom of the inning, Jacob Amaya's RBI base hit tied the game. The score remained that way until the seventh. Johnston lashed an RBI double to puut Jacksonville ahead 2-1. Moments later, a storm came through, with the game eventually getting called

FOR THREE!

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville has earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. Sitting at 68-70 (.493) with 11 games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp would have to finish the season 7-4 to make it three winning seasons in a row. Additionally, Jacksonville has posted a 34-35 record at 121 Financial Ballpark this year. With five games remaining in their final homestand with Gwinnett, the club would have to net at least three wins to seal a home record of at least .500. The last time the Jumbo Shrimp suffered a losing home record was when they went 27-41 in 2018.

Over the last month, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 30 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 47 runs, 38 earned, on 94 hits (8.2 H/9) in 103.2 innings for a 3.30 ERA. During this stretch, Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 127 batters (11.0 K/9) against 69 walks (6.0 BB/9).

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 119, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 82.8 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks tied for third in Triple-A. Over their last 25 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 24 of 28 stolen base attempts (85.7 percent).

BROKEN BATS

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 10 of their last 13 games, with the club mustering a meager .198/.292/.288/.580 batting line as a team. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 38 runs (2.9 per game) ranks 29th in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 49-38, Jacksonville has posted an 8-5 record. All eight of the club's victories have been decided by three runs or fewer

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 41 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 55-for-160 (.344/.414/.575/.989) with 11 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 32 RBIs, Johnston reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 115 runs in 121 games this season, which ranks first in MiLB. He is the first Marlins' minor leaguer to post a season with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases (Johnston has 26 and 22, respectively, between Double-A and Triple-A) since 2008.

IFRARSSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana, D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs. 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 33 games, however, the 26-year-old is 27-for-105 (.257/.392/.467/.859) with four doubles, six home runs, 20 RBIs and 24 walks (18.5 BB percent).

SHRIMP BITE

Jacksonville's elimination number sits at seven with 11 games to play, meaning any number of Jumbo Shrimp losses or Durham wins adding up to seven will eliminate

ABOUT JEFF

- -A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2023, he has already totaled 45 minor league starts in 63 career games.
- -Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.
- -An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2023 SEASON

- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 5-11.
- -Threw a seven-inning complete game against Nashville on June 7 with one-run allowed on two hits with five strikeouts.

2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combined, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

2021 SEASON

- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.
- -Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).
- -When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

- --With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.
- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
