RIDERS FORCE SPLIT WITH ARKANSAS IN SUNDAY WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders got all the runs they needed on back-to-back pitches in the third inning, scoring four tallies on a triple and a home run, and took a 6-3 victory on Sunday over the Arkansas Travelers at Riders Field. With the RoughRiders (8-7) trailing 2-0 in the third, **Dustin Harris** laced a triple down the right-field line with two outs to tie the score. The next pitch, **Diosbel Arias** homered for the fourth time in the series versus Arkansas (10-5) to give Frisco a 4-2 advantage. Frisco pitchers struck out 19 batters in the ballgame, besting their previous season high of 14. RoughRiders reliever **Grant Wolfram** (2-0) entered in the third inning to limit damage, stranding two inherited runners after **Jack Leiter** exited. Leiter had given up a two-RBI single and finished his day with 2.1 innings pitched, five walks and five strikeouts. Wolfram went the next 2.2 innings without a run or hit. Arkansas' starter Prelander Berroa (1-1) lasted into the fifth inning, conceding five runs on six hits with nine strikeouts and took the loss. With a 6-3 lead in the ninth, **Alex Speas** entered for the RoughRiders first save opportunity of the season. He walked two runners but left the tying run at the plate in a scoreless inning. **Justin Slaten** set the table for Speas, striking out five batters in the two prior innings. That was a personal season high for Slaten, who had last struck out five batters on June 19, 2022. **Chris Seise** earned an RBI in the fifth inning when the RoughRiders added some insurance with a two-run frame. His single to score a run continued an excellent series for Seise, who went 5-for-15 with two doubles, two home runs and four RBIs. Sporting throwback uniforms celebrating the 20th anniversary of RoughRiders baseball, Frisco won its first Sunday home game of the season.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN:

RoughRiders infielder **Dio Arias** crunched two home runs on Wednesday for his second multi-home run game of his career. His first, also with Frisco, took place 363 days earlier on April 21st, 2022 against Northwest Arkansas. In the series, Arias hit two more long balls. Over his last six games, he is hitting .333 (8-for-24)/.407/.917/1.324 with two doubles, four home runs and seven RBIs. Arias hit a career-high seven home runs last year and has hit four home runs in his last five games.

THIS PEN IS NO BULL...:

To start this season, the RoughRiders bullpen had been brilliant, but they have faltered against a strong Arkansas offense. Through nine games, the Riders allowed zero home runs and owned a 1.76 ERA, which was second-best in Minor League Baseball. In the first four games of this series, the Riders pen owns a 4.23 ERA. On the season, four different Frisco relievers have thrown at least four times without allowing an earned run (**Justin Slaten**, **Grant Wolfram**, **Triston Polley** and **Alex Speas**). Overall, the RoughRiders have a team ERA of 3.30 which is the second-best in the Texas League (Tulsa, 3.18 ERA).

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 22 RBIs with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .368 (7-for-19)/.348/.947/1.295 with three grand slams and 22 RBIs. They are one of just two teams in Minor League Baseball with at least three grand slams this season already (Triple-A Round Rock) as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another on Sunday in San Antonio and **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one on Thursday.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed six errors through 15 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday in San Antonio. The team's .989 fielding percentage is second in Minor League Baseball (Memphis leads at .991).

WALK THIS WAY:

The Riders hitters worked 40 walks in the six games against the San Antonio Missions, which was the sixth-most in the minors last week. On the season, Frisco's 79 walks lead the Texas League while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Evan Carter** is third in the Texas League with 13 walks and is first in OBP (.525).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders eight wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs and three runs, respectively, while their seven losses have come by a combined 22 runs. That gives Frisco a +31 run differential through 15 games, which is tied for the best in the Texas League despite being tied with Amarillo, Midland and San Antonio for first in the South Division, all of which have negative run differentials. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 10-5 (+29). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs eight times (8-0) and scored three or fewer runs seven times (0-7).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 11 of his 12 games this season, batting .378 (17-for-45)/.525/.600/1.125 with a double, three home runs, 13 walks, 15 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is fifth in the Texas League in average (.378), tied for sixth in hits (17), tied for ninth in home runs (3), tied for second in RBIs (15), tied for third in walks (13) and sixth in OPS (1.125). On Wednesday in San Antonio, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career before adding another home run on Sunday. The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo.

ABOUT OWEN

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the 2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school offers at QB).

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 15 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers MiLB Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders) and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way player candidate if he went to South Carolina.

-2018 is the same draft as eight other former/current RoughRiders: RHP Cole Winn (1, 15), INF Jonathan Ornelas (3, 91), RHP Sean Chandler (6, 179), RHP Tim Brennan (7, 209), INF Jax Biggers (8, 239), LHP Grant Wolfram (18, 539), LHP Josh Smith (25, 749) and RHP Cole Uvila (40, 1199).

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

-Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.

-Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost no-hitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starter before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From *The Athletic*: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.

-Did not see action in the 2018 season after being drafted as part of Rangers "de-load program".

-Missed the entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.
