SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (31-25) vs. FRISCO ROUGHRIDERS (32-23)

RHP MAX RAJCIC (2-3, 4.40 ERA) vs. RHP TREY SUPAK (3-2, 5.45 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals take on the RoughRiders (TEX) in the final game of a 6-game series and 6-game road trip ... SGF is 4-1 in the series ... is SGF's only trip to Frisco this season and only series between the clubs.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Springfield enters the day in 1st place in the North Division, 2.0 games ahead of 2nd-place WCH and 3.0 ahead of 3rd-place ARK/NWA... 13 games remain in the 1st Half.

RAJCIC CARPET RIDE: RHP Max Rajcic makes his 11th start of the season and his 2nd this week vs. FRI ... allowed 1 hit over a season-high 5.2 IP in the series opener to pick up his 1st win since 4/6 ... tied a season-high with 7 strikeouts and walked 2 batters ... was his 3rd start of 5.0+ IP and 0 ER allowed.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield dropped its 1st game of the series as Frisco homered twice in a 12 run, 13 hit barrage ... OF Noah Mendlinger tied a club season-high with 4 hits and IF JJ Wetherholt doubled in a 2-hit night ... OF Darlin Moquete hit his 2nd home run of the season, a solo shot in the 9th inning ... LHP Pete Hansen allowed season-highs with 7 hits and 7 runs in the loss.

X MAN: LHP Ixan Henderson tied a career-high with 9 strikeouts on Friday night ... allowed 1 unearned run (0 ER) on 4 hits over 5.2 IP ... was 2nd-straight start without an ER ... has allowed 3 ER or fewer in all 10 starts ... now leads the Texas League with 65 strikeouts ... lowered his ERA to 2.03, the league's 2nd-best mark ...

BEST CARDS DEALER: The Cardinals selected RHP Tekoah Roby as the org's MiLB Pitcher of the Month for May ... went 2-1 with a 3.86 ERA and a 1.03 WHIP over 5 starts (23.1 IP) ... struck out 33 and walked only 4 ... led the system in SO, SO/9 (12.73) and SO/BB (8.25) ratio ... joins teammate LHP Ixan Henderson (April) as SGF starters to earn the award this season.

NATHAN'S MAY FLOWERS: OF Nathan Church was named Texas League Player of the Month for May ... hit .357 with 6 HR, 19 RBI, and a 1.009 OPS ... led the league in average, hits, and total bases ... ranked 2nd in runs, SLG, and OPS ... recorded 12 multi-hit games and hit safely in 10-straight (5/14-28) ... struck out only 7 times ... was promoted to Memphis (AAA) on Tuesday.

FEEL THE BERN: C Leonardo Bernal is 8x17 with a HR, 2 doubles, and 4 RBI through the 1st 3 games at FRI ... ranks 1st among active Texas Leaguers with a .901 OPS ... leads SGF and ranks 3rd in the TL in HR (9) and RBI (33) ... since May 1, is batting .337 (32x96) with 8 HR, 28 RBI, and a 1.044 OPS.

ON THE RECORD: Springfield enters play Sunday at 6 games above .500 (31-25) ... is 19-9 over last 28 games since falling to a season-worst 12-16 ... had a 5-game road winning streak snapped last night.

- Spent entire 2024 season in Springfield rotation ... went 10-11 with a 4.33 ERA over 131.0 innings (25G/24GS) ... set career-highs in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts (131)
- Ranked 2nd in Texas League in wins, 3rd in strikeouts, and 4th in innings ... led Springfield in wins, strikeouts, starts and innings
- Struck out a career-high 9 batters three times, including his longest career start of 8.0 innings on July 4 vs. NW Arkansas ... held opponents to 2-or-fewer runs in 7 of last 8 starts
