ROAD WARRIORS: To date, the Cardinals have been the best road team in

the Texas League. Springfield is 34-19 (.642) away from Hammons Field this season, and .500 at home (29-29). The Cardinals' .642 road winning percentage is the 2nd best in all of Double-A behind the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM)

The Cardinals lead the league in runs scored (224, 5.3/game) and OPS (.762) in the 2nd half and are 2nd in SLG (.415). In the 1st half, the Cards were 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712).

GRINDIN': The Cardinal lineup has been one of the hardest in the minor leagues to strike out all season long.
