### NEWS & NOTES

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The Hudson Valley Renegades return to Heritage Financial Park to host the Wilmington Blue Rocks in their first full series of the second half. It's the third head-to-head matchup this season, with Hudson Valley capturing the first two series. This week marks the final time Wilmington will play in Hudson Valley in the regular season. The Renegades make two trips to "The First State" in August.

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Hudson Valley Renegades walked off the Wilmington Blue Rocks for the second time this year, 6-5 on Sunday afternoon. In the ninth with the game tied at five, **Spencer Jones** scored on a wild pitch to win the game for the Renegades. **Juan Carela** punched out nine in 4.2 frames while **Jack Neely** struck out the final seven batters of the game to help secure a victory. Rafael Flores and Jones paced the offense with two hits each, while **Ben Cowles** plated two runs with a pair of sacrifice flies.

**SUNDAY'S BEST:** RHP **Drew Thorpe** has been the Renegades' Sunday starter for the entire season until his start on Monday. The former 2nd round pick currently ranks first in wins (6) & IP (72.1), fourth in strikeouts (86), ERA (2.64), & WHIP (1.08), and seventh in AVG (.213) in the South Atlantic League. Among Yankees' Minor Leaguers, his ERA ranks first while his six wins are tied for the most with Clayton Beeter (SWB---AAA). His 86 strikeouts are the third-most in the system, only trailing 2023 Renegade Chase Hampton (SOM---AA) and current teammate Juan Carela.

**SEE YOU IN SEATTLE SPENCER:** On Monday, Major League Baseball announced that Renegades OF **Spencer Jones** was selected to represent the American League team in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game on July 15 at T-Mobile Park in Seattle. Jones becomes the 21st Renegades player all-time selected to play in the prestigious mid-summer Minor League showcase, and is poised to be the first-ever active Renegades player to appear in the game. In 2022, Renegades alumni Anthony Volpe, Ken Waldichuk and Jasson Dominguez all played in the Futures Game.

**ANOTHER PITCHING CROWN:** On Monday, Renegades RHP **Tyrone Yulie** was named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 19-25. The right-handed starter tossed a career-high 7.0 innings, allowing no hits and striking out seven in a first-half SAL North division-clinching win last Tuesday against the Brooklyn Cyclones. Yulie became the fourth Renegades player this season to win a weekly award, and the third to win Pitcher of the Week joining **Juan Carela** and **Drew Thorpe**. Aaron Palensky won the lone Player of the Week honor.

**HEATING UP:** **Antonio Gómez** finished the month of June as one of the hottest hitters in the South Atlantic League. In 19 games, the Renegades

catcher slashed .344/.420/.525 with five doubles, two HRs, 6 RBI, and 10 runs. His .344 average was the second-highest among qualified hitters in High-A. He's also currently riding a 13-game on-base streak.

**STARTERS AIN'T TOO SHABBY:** Since May 31st against Aberdeen, the rotation for Hudson Valley has seen some outstanding pitching. In this span, Renegades starters own a 1.75 ERA (144.0 IP, 75 H, 35 R, 28 ER, 71 BB, 192 K), the best in Minor League Baseball in that span. The rotation leads also leads MiLB in strikeouts (192) and WHIP (1.01), while the 144.0 innings are good for fourth place.

**CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR:** The Renegades have played in 22 one-run games this season and they own an 9-13 record (.409) in those contests. In June, nine of the 13 Renegades' losses were decided by two runs or less.

**HOW LOW CAN THEY GO:** The Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff finished the month of June with the lowest ERA in MiLB at 2.16. The Vancouver Canadians (TOR---A+) finished a distant second at 2.43. The 'Gades also held the second-highest mark in strikeouts, punching out 287 batters in 220.2 innings. The Somerset Patriots (NYY---AA) sat fifth, with 272 K's in 229.0 innings and the Tampa Tarpons (NYY---A) struck out 254 batters, good for 16th.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** With a hit on Sunday against Wilmington, **Eduardo Torrealba** has tallied 122 career hits with the Renegades, good for third all-time. Angel Perez holds the franchise record with 125. Torrealba also appeared in his 151st contest as a Renegade on Sunday, passing Matt Spring for the most in franchise history.

**THE K-ZONE:** The Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff has been dominant all season long at getting swings-and-misses and they have been rewarded for it. The 'Gades currently own the second-highest strikeout total in all of Minor League Baseball. The Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN---AA) have struck out 862 batters compared to 856 for Hudson Valley this year. On Sunday, the Renegades tied their season-high with 19 strikeouts against the Wilmington Blue Rocks. The mark also tied their franchise record, which they also recorded earlier this season on April 23rd versus the Rome Braves.

**HAPPY MONDAY:** Monday night's contest against the Wilmington Blue Rocks at Heritage Financial Park marks the lone contest that the Renegades will play on a Monday this season. Hudson Valley defeated the Brooklyn Cyclones last year on July 3rd 6-2 and then won at Jersey Shore on the Fourth 8-0.

**FLORES:** Held hitless in back-to-back games for the first time in his career on 5/2 & 5/3 vs Wilmington.  
**GARCÍA:** After only playing in only one game (2 AB) since 5/3, went 1-for-3 vs ABD (6/4).  
**GÓMEZ:** Hit .151/.200/.233 in May after batting .271/.358/.339 in April. Ranked second in High-A in the month of June with a .344 batting average.  
**HENSON:** Back-to-back-to-back multi-hit games on 5/24, 5/25, and 5/26 at Wilmington -- 9-for-16, 2 2B, HR, 3 RBI  
**JONES:** Season-long seven-game hitting streak from 6/10 - 6/18... hit .464/.531/.857 with two 2B, three HRs and 6 RBIs during this span.  
**RAMIREZ:** Promoted to Hudson Valley from Tampa on 6/29, named a *Baseball America* prospect to watch beyond the Top 30 for the Yankees.

# RENEGADES STARTING PITCHER

**28 DREW THORPE · RHP · 6'4" · 190 LBS · 22**

**LAST TIME OUT:** Thorpe delivered another sterling outing last Sunday at the Brooklyn Cyclones, tossing 7.2 innings of one-run ball and got no decision in a 2-1 Cyclones walk-off win. Thorpe's lone run allowed came home on a Drake Osborn sacrifice fly in the bottom of the fifth, snapping a 28.1 inning scoreless streak dating back to May 28. He retired the first 12 batters he faced in the outing, and needed an efficient 90 pitches to nearly complete 8.0 innings for the second time in a four-start span. The right-hander has thrown at least 7.0 innings in three of his last four outings.

**QUALITY STUFF:** Thorpe has fired five quality starts in his last seven outings (QS = at least 6.0 IP, 3-or-fewer ER). He is one of only four pitchers in the South Atlantic League with three quality starts this season, and is joined by Greenville's Isaac Coffey (5) and Hunter Dobbins (4), Wilmington's Dustin Saenz (4), and Greensboro's Anthony Solometo (4).

**YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON THORPE:** "The first thing that sticks out in my mind about Thorpe is he's just a competitor. You always want those kinds of guys. New York is a really tough place to play so you want to draft and sign guys that have a makeup that says that this guy is going to be able to handle pitching there and Thorpe hands down has that. He's really impressive out there, nothing rattles him. And then on top of that the secondary pitches are great. The changeup was a weapon to both hands in college, he's a high raw spin guy, the slider is disgusting. He throws two kinds of sliders -- he does throw the sweeper one and he has the shorter, tighter one and he just has such command of the zone with those offspeed pitches. It makes it really tough when you've got three different shapes there that are all going in different directions and he can move them around in the zone. As a hitter you can't really sit on anything and it's been awesome to watch."

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Allowed a leadoff home run to Greensboro's Mike Jarvis on his first pro pitch on April 9, then struck out 4 of the next 5 batters.
- Struck out 10 batters in 4.2 innings on April 23 at Rome, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since T.J. Sikkema on July 16, 2022 against the Greenville Drive. HV tied a franchise record (for 9-inn. game) in that game by striking out 19 Rome batters.
- On June 4 vs Aberdeen threw 8.0 IP, 1H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to throw 8.0 shutout innings in a start since Tyree Hayes threw a 9-inn. complete game shutout against the Lowell Spinners on Aug. 17, 2008. He was only the third HV starter to complete 8.0 innings in a start in the Portal Era (2005-Present).
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for the week of May 29-June 4 after 8.0 shutout innings vs Aberdeen.
- Struck out 12 batters on June 11 at Jersey Shore, setting a new Renegades franchise record for most strikeouts in a game.

**PERSONAL:**

- Full name is Andrew Robert Thorpe.
- As a redshirt sophomore at Cal Poly in 2022, went 10-1 with a 2.32 ERA (104.2 IP, 65 H, 31 R/27 ER, 25 BB, 149 K, 5 HR) in 15 starts... His 149 strikeouts ranked second in the nation, trailing only Oregon State's Cooper Hjerpe (161 K), who was selected by St. Louis with the 22<sup>nd</sup> overall selection in 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
- Ranked third in the country in H/9.0IP (5.59), sixth in WHIP (0.86), 10th in wins (10), 13th in K/9.0 IP (12.81) and 17th in ERA... Was named to six All-America First Teams, including Collegiate Baseball, ABCA, Perfect Game, Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the NCBWA, becoming the first six-time All-American in program history.
- Was named one of five finalists for National Pitcher of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for both the Dick Howser Trophy and Golden Spikes Award.
- Was also named the Big West Conference Pitcher of the Year, becoming the first pitcher in school history to earn the accolade... Prior to the 2022 First-Year Player Draft, was ranked as the No. 61 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline and the No. 62 prospect by Baseball America.
