FRISCO FALLS TO MIDLAND IN FRIST 2026 LOSS:

After a 4-0 start, the Frisco RoughRiders dropped their first game of the season, losing 5-4 to the Midland RockHounds at Riders Field on Wednesday night. The RockHounds (4-1) rolled to five runs in the first two innings off RoughRiders (4-1) starter **Blake Townsend** (0-1), who was making his first Riders start, and all five came on home runs. Tommy White launched a two-run blast in the first inning, Brayan Buelvas and Cameron Leary went back-to-back to start the second and Joshua Kuroda-Grauer added one with two outs for a 5-0 Midland lead. From there, the Riders' bullpen pitched yet another scoreless game, setting its offense up for a chance to potentially come back. **Tucker Mitchell** doubled off of Wei-En Lin to drive in **Julian Brock** for the first RoughRiders run of the night in the fourth inning and **Dylan Dreiling** and Brock had RBIs in the seventh, sending the game to the ninth at 5-3. After **Keyber Rodriguez** scored on a Shohei Tomioka wild pitch, **John Taylor** popped out to end the night and strand the potential tying run at third base. James Gonzalez (1-0) earned the win in relief for Midland while Tomioka took his second save of the season.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through five games the RoughRiders are tied for first in Double-A with 54 hits. Among teams with at least five games played, they are third in Double-A in batting average (.297) and 13th in runs (29). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Their 54 hits are the most in the first five games in recorded franchise history (since 2005), beating out 2017's 53 hits. Their 29 runs scored are also tied for the fifth-most in franchise history (since 2005) through the first five games of a season. **Tucker Mitchell** and **Keyber Rodriguez** both have 9 hits through five games, which is tied for the Texas League lead and second in Double-A. Mitchell's .474 batting average (9-for-19) is tied for the best in the Texas League, while he is third in OPS (1.208) and first in doubles (4).

QUITE THE START:

Frisco's overall 1.60 ERA through five games is the best in Minor League Baseball, while they are fourth in batting average allowed (.168) and first in WHIP (0.98) in the minors. Since 2005, their 1.60 ERA is the sixth-best in the Texas League through five games and it is the second-best in franchise history (2016, 1.31 ERA). Among starting pitching staffs with at least 15.0 innings through five games, they are sixth in Double-A with a 2.78 ERA (22.2 IP/7 ER) and their bullpen ERA of 0.40 (22.1 IP/1 ER) is the best in MiLB.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have committed just two errors defensively through five games, tied for the fewest in the Texas League. Since 2021, they have the best fielding percentage (.981) in Double-A and the second-fewest errors (463).

CAUGHT YOU THIEVING:

RoughRiders catcher **Julian Brock** had a sparkling day on Wednesday, going 2-for-4 at the plate with a double and an RBI while also catching three baserunners trying to steal. Through five games, he leads all of Minor League Baseball with 5 caught stealings and is 5-for-5 in catching runners. That includes all Triple-A catchers who have played upwards of 11 games. In 17 games for the RoughRiders last season, Brock hit .321/.400/.446/.846 with 4 doubles, 1 home run and 10 RBIs.

MONSTER INNING:

On Friday at Corpus, the Riders scored 10 runs in the fifth inning, tying the second-biggest output in a single inning in franchise history. It was the second time the Riders had scored 10 in an inning at Corpus Christi (May 8th, 2008) and came up one run shy of the franchise record of 11 at Amarillo on September 2nd, 2022. In the inning, **Dylan Dreiling** became the third player in franchise history to knock in four runs in a frame without a grand slam, belting a three-run home run and an RBI single. He joined **Trevor Hauver** (solo HR, three-run triple) in 2023 and **Casey Benjamin** (two-run double, two-run single) in 2007. When you add the six-run inning on Tuesday, 16 of the Riders' 29 runs (55 percent) have been scored in two half innings.

SOUTHERN SUCCESS:

Since 2021, the Riders have been very good against their South Division opponents, going 254-186 (.577) against their division teams. The only problem is that they have gone just 56-54 against Midland while they went a combined 197-132 (.599) against Corpus Christi, Amarillo and San Antonio.

CLASS OF THE LEAGUE:

Since 2021, the RoughRiders have been the best team in the Texas League. Over the last six seasons, Frisco has a 363-309 (.540) record. Their .540 winning percentage is the top mark in the Texas League and the fifth-best in Double-A during that span. Somerset (Yankees affiliate) has the best record in Double-A, going 388-283 (.578) in that stretch.

FAMILIAR AND NEW FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders welcome 16 returning players in 2026, but will have just three players on the roster (infielder **John Taylor**, outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** and RHP **Dylan MacLean**) made their Double-A debut in the season-opening series. Of the 28, 10 players made their Rangers organization debut with the RoughRiders in Corpus Christi.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
