This marks 12th of 24 games to be played between the Whitecaps and Lugnuts in 2021. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affliate in their 27th season in professional baseball, and first in the High-A Central League. Lansing is in their 1st year of affliation with the Oakland Athleticss. These two teams met 16 times in the 2019 regular season, with the Lugnuts taking the regular season series 11-5.

Up Next: The 'Caps battle Fort Wayne and Lansing in what would tie their longest homestand in franchise history at 13 games. The last time a homestand lasted that long in West Michigan was from July 5-20, 2007 between Fort Wayne (2), Great Lakes (3), Beloit (4), and Kane County (4).

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: Eric De La Rosa captured the longest hitting streak for any West Michigan Whitecaps player this season, but the team fell short as part of a 5-3 loss to the Lansing Lugnuts in front of 4,904 fans at LMCU Ballpark. The 24-year-old De La Rosa finished the night 1-for-4 with an RBI, capturing the longest hitting streak of any Whitecaps hitter this season at 11 games. De La Rosa is hitting .409 with two doubles, a pair of triples, and six RBIs over his last five games. Lansing jumped all over 'Caps starter Brendan White, plating four runs on seven hits - including a two-run home run from Patrick McColl before De La Rosa roped an RBI-double to make the score 4-1 at the end of the fourth. The Lugnuts added another run in the fifth inning as Andrew Navigato and Wenceel Perez both added individual RBIs to make it a 5-3 Lansing lead at the end of the fifth. West Michigan didn't manage a hit the remainder of the game as Lansing closer Brock Whittlesley slammed the door in the ninth to earn the save and a Lugnuts victory. Lansing starter Colin Peluse (4-2) allowed three runs through six innings of work in his fourth win, as Whittlesley collected his second save of the season with a pair of strikeouts. White (2-4) allowed five runs on ten hits while striking out four in his fourth loss of 2021. The Lugnuts improve to 34-37 as the Whitecaps fall to 32-38. The Whitecaps haven't won a six-game series since a sweep of the Lake County Captains to conclude the month of May.

DRAFT AND FOLLOW: The 2021 MLB Draft is in the books. The Detroit Tigers used the 3rd overall pick on Oklahoma High School Right-handed pitcher Jackson Jobe, who was rated the #7 overall player on MLB Pipeline's rankings of the 2021 MLB Draft Prospects. Detroit then used the 32nd overall selection on another righty, as hard throwing Ty Madden, rated the #9 overall player in the draft from the University of Texas.

RAIN RAIN GO AWAY: The Whitecaps have had five gamedays postponed this season, with three coming in a week-span in late June (24, 26 & 29).

KIDS ARE THE FUTURE: Former Whitecaps Riley Greene ('19) and Spencer Torkelson ('21) played in the MLB Futures Game at Coors Field in Denver, Colorado on June 11, July 11. Greene hit .271-5-28 in 57 games between three teams in 2019 -- including the 'Caps, while Torkelson hit .312-5-29 in 31 games with West Michigan earlier this season.

THRIFTY THURSDAYS ALSO FEATURE ...: The Whitecaps hold a 9-3 record on Thursdays this season -- their best performance of any day of the week.

SUNDAY NO-FUNDAY: The Whitecaps have lost 7 of their 9 games played on a Sunday this season.

DON'T ROLL A SEVEN: The Whitecaps are winless in 30 games this season when trailing after seven innings this season. They are also 0-33 when trailing after eight frames.

STILL GOT PROSPECTS: Outfielder Daniel Cabrera headlines a team featuring seven of the Tigers Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. The others include outfielder and #7 prospect Parker Meadows and infielder Gage Workman, who sits ranked #11.

ALUMNI REPORT: 2018 'Caps infielder Kody Clemens blasted two home runs in going 3-for-4 with three runs, two homers and two RBI with a walk as the Mud Hens beat the Indianapolis Indians 7-2 on Thursday. Clemens is hitting .262-6-16 with Toledo this year as the Tigers No. 13 prospect after hitting .302-4-17 in 42 games for the 'Caps in 2018.

College: University of Louisville

The highly-regarded lefty dominated at the University of Louisville in 2018, going 14-2 with a 2.41 ERA in three years with the Cardinals, but has struggled in the professional ranks.

LAST START: Wolf tossed three scoreless innings but ran into trouble in the fourth in giving up four runs as West Michigan lost by a score of 8-3 to the Lansing Lugnuts on July 20 at LMCU Ballpark.

2021: Pitched better in Low-A than his last stint, going 2-2 with a 3.90 ERA in seven games with Lakeland.

2019: Had a tough year with the Whitecaps, going 4-10 with a 6.23 ERA in 17 starts. Gave up 105 hits in just 78 innings and allowing hitters to hit .317 against him.

2018: Pitched well in his short professional debut, posting a 2.19 ERA in 37 total innings while allowing just 30 hits and striking out 32.

College: Dominated during his time in the ACC, going 8-2 with a 2.63 ERA in 102.2 innings pitched. The Ohio native struck out 109 batters and walked 29 while keeping opponents to a .219 batting average against.

HONORS/AWARDS:

2018 National Pitcher of the Year Watch List 2018 ACC Pitcher of the Week Ranked the Detroit Tigers #31 prospect before 2018 season, according to the Detroit News.

MORE: Was a reliever the previous two seasons he pitched at Louisville before turning into an outstanding front-line starter. His turning point came during his last college offseason when he realized he needed to add another pitch to his repertoire, and ran a google search for "Mariano Rivera," "cutter" and "video".

The 24-year old was a quick study, and was able to add a fourth pitch to his arsenal. That pitch then became his best pitch almost instantly, and the one he relies on most.
