### JUMBO SHRIMP DROP SERIES OPENER, 7-1

The Jumbo Shrimp struggled Friday in a 7-1 loss to the Sounds. Caleb Durbin's two-run home run started the scoring in the third inning, putting Nashville ahead. Ronny Simon halved the lead with a sacrifice fly in the fifth, but then Raynel Delgado's RBI single in the sixth made it 3-1. The Sounds scored three runs in the seventh and another in the eighth to set the final margin. Jacksonville's four errors was their most since committing five miscues on September 8, 2024 at Louisville. The Jumbo Shrimp also surrendered five stolen bases in the defeat.

#### **GRAND OPENING**

Since 2005, Jacksonville is 11-9 (.550) on Opening Day since 2005, collectively outscoring their opponents by a narrow 83-81 margin. Jacksonville has won on Opening Day in eight of their last 13 season openers dating back to the 2012 season. However, the Jumbo Shrimp's 7-1 loss in Friday's 2025 opener was their fewest runs in an Opening Day contest since getting shut out 5-0 by Jackson in the 2019 season lid-lifter.

### **SOUNDS BITES**

When Jacksonville rejoined the Triple-A level in 2021, they took five out of six against Nashville in the lone series the clubs played during that campaign. Since then, however, the Sounds have won each of the next three season series', with Jacksonville owning a combined 23-37 (.383) mark against Nashville since the 2022 campaign. The Jumbo Shrimp and Sounds will meet 15 times throughout the 2025 season, with nine of the meetings coming in the Music City.

### JUST WIN, BABY

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. The Jumbo Shrimp, though, have followed those two campaigns up with consecutive losing records; Jacksonville finished just 70-79 (.470) In 2023 and 73-76 (.490) in 2024. The club is trying to avoid a third straight season with a losing record for the first time since suffering through five consecutive losing marks from the 2015-19 campaigns. Prior to that, Jacksonville finished .500 or better in each season from 2005-14, winning four Southern League championships.

#### **CARP-E DIEM**

The 2025 season will be **David Carpenter's** first piloting a team in MiLB. The 39-year-old spent the last two seasons at the helm of the West Virginia Black Bears in the MLB Draft League while also serving as the pitching coach at Division II Fairmont State University from 2021-24. With the Black Bears, he posted an 81-66 (.551) record, steering West Virginia to a league championship in 2023. Carpenter pitched in 222 MLB games over six seasons from 2011-15 and 2019 with the Astros, Blue Jays, Braves, Yankees, Nationals and Rangers. He registered a career 3.69 ERA in the big leagues. Carpenter's ties to the IL include a stint of eight games pitched with Gwinnett from 2013-14 and 39 games with Nashville, then a PCL club, in 2019.

#### I DON'T KNOW WHY YOU SAY GOODBYE, I SAY HELLO

Of Jacksonville's 28-man Opening Day roster to begin the 2025 season, a whopping 15 players have previously played for the Jumbo Shrimp. The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp also feature six members of the Miami Marlins' Top 30 prospects. That list is headed by catcher **Agustin Ramírez**, who *Baseball Prospectus* ranks as the No. 55 prospect in the entirety of baseball.

### **DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS**

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Deyvison De Los Santos** is coming off a monster 2024 season while playing for Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. The 21-year-old native of Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic led all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (40), RBIs (120) and total bases (307). He also ranked in the top 20 in the minor leagues in hits (2nd, 158), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 67), slugging percentage (5th, .571), OPS (10th, .914) and runs scored (18th, 89). Of the 250 hardest-hit balls in Triple-A during the 2024 season, De Los Santos smacked 11 of them, including a 116.0 mile per hour (10th overall in Triple-A) single while playing for Reno on June 12, 2024.

### SHRIMP BITES

Only seven members of Jacksonville's Opening Day roster boast MLB experience. The club had 11 players with MLB experience on their Opening Day roster in 2024... The Jumbo Shrimp are coming off a 2024 season that saw them set club records for players used (90) and pitchers used (51).

### ABOUT ROBINSON

- -A native of San Cristobal in the Dominican Republic, Piña was originally signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on February 15, 2017.
- -Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

### 2024 SEASON

- -Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.
- -Piña posted an 8-2 record and 3.50 ERA over 12 starts during the season's first half (61.2 IP, 65 H, 8 BB, 70 K, .262 BAA). However, over 13 starts in the second half of the year, he went 5-6 with a 4.79 ERA (67.2 IP, 71 H, 19 BB, 62 K, .269 BAA)
- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .279/.329/.487/.816 against Piña. Those figures dropped to .245/.285/.431/.716 with runners on and .217/.246/.433/.679 with runners in scoring position.

### 2023 SEASON

- -Piña posted fairly similar platoon splits, actually faring slightly better against left-handed hitting (.225/.338/.318/.656 in 213 plate appearances). Right-handed hitters batted .242/.351/.320/.671 against him over 210 plate appearances.
- -With the bases empty, Piña held opponents to a .205/.323/.274/.597 line in 219 plate appearances. With runners on, however, that swelled to .267/.369/.373/.742 over 205 plate appearances.
