SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels picked up their fifth straight win, beating the Erie SeaWolves, 5-2, at The Diamond. The SeaWolves opened the scoring in the fourth with a solo homer by Andrew Navigato. **David Villar** tied the game, 1-1, in the bottom of the fourth with a solo home run, his team-leading 16th of the year. Erie took a 2-1 lead in the top of the fifth with an RBI single by Kerry Carpenter. Richmond answered with a sac fly by **Sandro Fabian** to tie the game in the bottom of the fifth. In the seventh, **Diego Rincones** gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead with a solo homer. **Heath Quinn** hit a two-run homer in the eighth to extend the lead to 5-2. **Patrick Ruotolo** closed out the ninth for his ninth save. Starter **Aaron Blair** allowed two runs over five innings. **Gerson Garabito** picked up his second with, working two scoreless innings. **Joey Marciano** pitched a scoreless eighth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Richmond is 8-8 in series-opening games, including a 5-2 mark on the road. The Flying Squirrels are 24-30 against teams from the Southwest Division and 10-14 in road games against division opponents. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from June 1-6, with the Curve winning four games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 11-17 since July 21 but have won five straight games, which is the longest current win streak in the Double-A Northeast. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 10.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.89 ERA for the season.

THE CURVE have lost back-to-back games after winning the previous three. They split last week's six-game series against the Patriots. The Altoona offense is ranked sixth in the league with a .248 batting average and the pitching staff is eighth with a 4.66 ERA. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including SS Oneil Cruz (No. 3), RHP Roansy Contreras (No. 6 - on IL), 1B Mason Martin (No. 17), OF Matt Frazier (No. 23), OF Canaan Smith-Njigba (No. 28 - on IL), RHP Cody Bolton (No. 29 - on IL) and OF Jack Suwinski (No. 30). Martin ranks tied for third in the league in homers (21), first in RBIs (66), third in SLG (.536), 10th in OPS (.868), second in doubles (26), first in extra-base hits (49) and first in total bases (178). Ji-Hwan Bae is tied for second in the league in triples (5) and tied for fifth with 17 stolen bases.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Michael Plasmeyer** makes his 13th Richmond start. Last time out, he picked up a win after allowing two runs against Erie last Wednesday, matching season highs with 7.0 innings pitched and nine strikeouts. It was his first winning decision since July 2. After allowing seven runs in 4.2 innings in his Richmond debut on June 15 at Somerset, Plasmeyer has gone 2-5 with a 3.52 ERA (24 ER/61.1 IP) over his last 11 starts dating back to June 20. Plasmeyer was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants on June 11 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. He began the season with Montgomery in the Double-A South. Plasmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season. In his first year with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plasmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Floro in 2013. **For more on Plasmeyer, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Jeff Passantino makes his 12th start of the season and his 15th overall appearance. He last pitched last Wednesday against Somerset and allowed three runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision. Passantino went 1-4 with a 3.29 ERA (15 ER/41.0 IP) in his first 10 outings of the year, but has gone 0-2 with a 7.29 ERA (17 ER/21.0 IP) over his last four starts since July 31. He has made one start against Richmond this season, picking up a loss after allowing two runs (one earned) in 5.1 innings on June 6 at The Diamond. Passantino was drafted in the 40th round in 2017 by the Cubs out of Lipscomb. He was picked up by the Pirates in the minor league phase of the Rule 5 Draft on December 10, 2020.

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 25 homers in the last 12 games since August 10, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. In that stretch, **David Villar** has hit five home runs, **Sandro Fabian** and **Diego Rincones** have four, **Brandon Martorano** and **Heath Quinn** have two and **Andres Angulo**, **Vince Fernandez**, **Jacob Heyward**, **Shane Matheny**, **Mitchell Tolman**, **Frankie Tostado**, **Simon Whiteman** and **Will Wilson** each have one. All but two active Richmond position players have homered in that span. The Flying Squirrels hit 15 homers during a six-game set at Bowie from August 10-15 and added 10 homers during last week's six-game series at The Diamond against the SeaWolves.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank fourth in the Double-A Northeast with 108 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 135 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. Richmond's 108 home runs this season is the second-highest homer total in a season in the franchise's history, ahead of the entire 2018 (97), 2017 (93), 2019 (84), 2016 (83), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons. This year, the team has combined for a .399 slugging percentage, which is ninth in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 53 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have five players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **Vince Fernandez** (14), **David Villar** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11) and **Heliot Ramos** (10). Five players with 10 or more homers ties a franchise record, matching the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: In his last 12 games since August 10, **David Villar** is batting .405 (17-for-42) with five homers, six doubles and seven RBIs. He now leads the team with 16 home runs this season, which is also tied for the fifth-most in a season in franchise history and is two homers shy of matching the single-season franchise record. On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. He finished that series with three home runs and homered in each of the last two games of last week's series against Erie at The Diamond.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 12 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .326 (15-for-46) with four homers and 16 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 12 RBIs over the last eight games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in four of those contests.

GO, DIEGO, GO! Over his last 29 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .317 (33-for-104) with eight homers, six doubles, one triple and 23 RBIs. Over his last 18 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .348 (24-for-69) with four homers, five doubles and 12 RBIs. He added a walk-off single on Friday night to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves. Rincones homered on Saturday night and hit a go-ahead homer in the seventh in the series finale against the SeaWolves on Sunday night.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 27 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 107 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **David Villar** is tied for eighth with 16 homers, ninth with a .371 OBP, sixth with 88 hits, tied for ninth with 22 doubles, tied for fifth with 41 walks, seventh with 38 extra-base hits, tied for fifth with 158 total bases and eighth with 58 runs scored. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for seventh with 15 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is ranked ninth with a 5.20 ERA and tied for seventh with 81 strikeouts. **Patrick Ruotolo** (33/T-3rd), **Joey Marciano** (33/T-3rd), **Matt Seelinger** (30/T-6th) and **Frank Rubio** (30/T-6th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for third with nine saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for ninth with six.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (14 - on IL), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Two players, Wilson (15) and Beck (29), are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: Former Richmond reliever **Jose Marte** made his MLB debut for the Angles on Friday night, becoming the 75th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. He entered in the fourth inning and worked 2.0 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and allowed one hit. Marte made 19 appearances for the Flying Squirrels in 2021, going 2-0 with a 3.57 ERA. He is the sixth Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors for the first time during the 2021 season, joining **Johneshwy Fargas**, **Sammy Long**, **Daniel Camarena**, **Dusten Knight** and **Connor Overtton**.
