## SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (25-13, 68-39) vs. SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS (16-22, 55-52) LHP PETE HANSEN (7-3, 3.69 ERA) vs. RHP ENMANUEL PINALES (6-5, 6.32 ERA)

**NEVER SATX-FIED:** The Cardinals clinched a series victory with their win Saturday night but look to make it a 5-1 trip to San Antonio in their final game of a 6-game series vs. Missions (SD) ... San Antonio will visit Hammons Field during the season's final week to wrap up the 12-game season series.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** The Cardinals sit in 1st place in the 2nd-half North standings, 4.0 games up on 2nd-place Tulsa ... are in 1st place in the overall standings, 11.0 games ahead of Wichita.

**TEXAS PETE:** LHP Pete Hansen makes his 21st start and his 2nd vs. SA this week ... allowed 2 hits over 6.1 shutout IP in the series-opener on Tuesday ... left with a 4-0 lead in the 7th before Missions came back to win ... has completed at least 5.0 IP in 13 of last 14 starts and 6.0 IP in 5 of last 6 outings ... former Texas Longhorn ranks 5th in TXL with a 3.59 ERA.

**PINALES GAME:** The Cardinals face RHP Enmanuel Pinales for the 2nd time this week ... allowed 4 runs on 5 hits over 5.0 IP in start vs. Cardinals on Tuesday ... is 6-5 with a 6.32 ERA in 15G/10GS since joining SA from Fort Wayne (A+).

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** OF Darlin Moquete's 2-run 3B started a 4-run 5th inning to help the Cardinals come back for a 6-2 win on Saturday night ... IF Jeremy Rivas added a 2-run single in the 7th ... RHP Cade Winqest picked up his 2nd win in his 4th start after allowing 2 runs over 6.1 IP ... LHP Michael Watson (1.2) and RHP Austin Love (1.0) combined on 3.0 scoreless innings of relief.

**WIN QUEST:** RHP Cade Winqest went a career-high 6.1 IP in his start on Saturday ... Cardinals are now 4-0 in his 4 starts since joining the club on 7/14 from Peoria (A+).

**MISSION IMPOSSIBLE:** Springfield starting pitchers have posted a 0.94 ERA (3ER/28.2IP) over the first 5 games of the series in San Antonio ... held Missions hitters to just 16 hits with 29 strikeouts.

**WE MESS WITH TEXAS:** The Cardinals are 29-6 vs. South Division opponents this season including a 20-3 record in games played in Texas.

**DUB STEPS:** Saturday's win pushed the Cardinals' record to a season-high 29 games above .500 (68-39) ... hold the best overall record and 2nd-half record (25-13) in the Texas League.

**BRILLIANT BRYCEN:** LHP Brycen Mautz struck out a season-high 10 and allowed only 1 hit over 6.0 IP on Friday ... became 3rd SGF starter to strike out 10+ in this season and the 3rd to allow just 1 hit over 6.0 IP ... has allowed 4 ER over his last 7 starts posting a 1.04 ERA (4ER/34.2IP).

**DOZEN DINGERS:** IF Ramon Mendoza's 2-run HR in Thursday's game was his 12th of the season and tied him for the team lead with C Leonardo Bernal ... the HR total is a career-high for Mendoza and his .807 OPS leads the team.
