CARDINALS BATS SILENCED AS NATURALS TAKE SERIES EDGE: The Cardinals matched a season low with just three hits and the Naturals clubbed two homers as Springfield dropped game five of the final regular season series at Hammons Field 6-3 on Saturday night in front of 6,825 fans. Chase Davis, St. Louis' 2023 first-round pick, homered in his first Double-A at bat to give Springfield a 1-0 lead and also scored two runs in the 2nd inning, but the Cards weren't able to muster much more offense the rest of the night. Lenoardo Taveras fired 2.0 scoreless innings in relief for Springfield.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander Ryan Brady makes his 2nd start of the season for the Naturals... Just the 3rd start of his career... Only other start in 2024 came against the Cardinals on June 16 at Hammons Field and he allowed 1 ER on 4 H with 2 K over 2.0 IP... The Cardinals lost the game 14-7... Made a relief appearance on Thursday night and got the win, allowing just 1 H and 0 R over 1.1 IP

CARDINALS HOST NATURALS IN FINAL REGULAR SEASON HOMESTAND OF 2024: The Cardinals close out their 2024 home slate this week with a six-game series against the NW Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). The Cards were swept by the Naturals at Hammons Field in a six-game series from June 11-16, and won 5 of 6 in the last meeting from July 1-6.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

ON PACE... With 9 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- » Springfield is on pace to win 79 games this season, which would eclipse the franchise record of 77 (2012 & 2017).
- » The Cardinals set a new franchise record with their 39th road win last Sunday afternoon at Wichita, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- » The current strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,279, which would surpass the 2019 franchise record of 1,263.
- » With an average of .330, **Bryan Torres** is on pace to tie the record held by **Tyler Minges** who hit .324 in 2005.
- » With 24 saves, **Matt Svanson** is within 3 of the franchise record of 27 (**Mark Worrell**, 2006 & **Chris Perez**, 2007).

AWARDS SZN: For the first time in franchise history, the Springfield Cardinals have swept monthly Texas League awards:

OF/INF **Bryan Torres** was named Texas League and St. Louis Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month after a red-hot August. Torres batted .418 with 8 2B, a home run and 12 RBIs while compiling a .491 OBP and 1.029 OPS in 23 games in the month. He recorded multiple hits 13 times, including in 10 of his last 14 games in the month. **Torres** was named Texas League Player of the Week for August 13-18.

LHP **Quinn Mathews** was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month despite earning a promotion to Triple-A Memphis on August 28. The Stanford product went 2-0 with a 0.70 ERA and 0.58 WHIP with 40 K across 25.2 IP in the month. **Mathews** saved his best performance for his last Springfield start, retiring the first 19 batters he faced and carrying a perfect game into the 7th on August 23 against the Drillers at Hammons Field.

Torres and **Mathews** join **Tink Hence** (Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April) as the only Cardinals to earn a Texas League monthly award. **Nathan Church** was named St. Louis Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month in April.

LONG, HOT SUMMER: The Cardinals are 36-20 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-3 in series and has the best batting average in Double-A at .267. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.78, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 23 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Springfield is 15-8 during that time, and have outscored its opponents 43-15 in the 8th inning or later.

RUN PRODUCER: Through 5 games in the month of September, Cardinals 1B/ OF **Matt Lloyd** is batting .350 (7-for-24) with 2 HR and a league-high 9 RBIs. For the season, the Canadian product has been one of the top run producers in the Texas League. His 75 RBIs ranks 2nd in the circuit behind only **AJ Vukovich** of Amarillo who has 80.

5-HIT TORRES: With a 5-for-5 performance on Friday night, **Bryan Torres** became the first player in Springfield Cardinals history to have 5 hits in two separate games in the same season. The reigning Texas League and Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month also went 5-for-5 on August 14 at Frisco. **Torres** leads the Texas League in batting average (.330), hits (143), OBP (.415) and is tied with **Nathan Church** and **Javier Vaz** (NWA) for most runs scored (77).

MAKING A SPLASH: In his first game at Double-A on Saturday, 2023 1st-round pick **Chase Davis** announced his presence with his very first swing. The 21st overall pick homered on the first swing he took in a Springfield uniform, a solo shot to give the Cards a 1-0 lead in the 2nd inning. **Davis** finished his debut going 1-for-3 with a home run, RBI and two runs scored.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 24-for-24 and his 50 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 14-for-14 in save opportunities. **Svanson** had a run of 19 appearances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday afternoon in Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 55-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
