### The Final Countdown (of the first half)

The Fightin Phils continue the final week of the first half with game three of a five-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Friday night. It is the third-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and third-of-11 at New Hampshire. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from July 23-28, and the Fisher Cats come to Reading from Aug. 13-18. New Hampshire won the 2023 season series over Reading 17-7, and leads 2-0 in this season's series.

### Comeback Falls Short Wednesday Night

The Fightin Phils were unable to complete a comeback in a 4-3 loss to New Hampshire on Wednesday night. Trevor Schwewe put Reading on the board first with a solo home run in the third inning. New Hampshire then took a 4-1 lead off Fightin Phils' starting pitcher Matt Osterberg. Osterberg took the loss, falling to 1-4, allowing four runs on nine hits over five innings, with two walks and two strikeouts. Carlos Francisco, Matt Russell and Tommy McCollum each pitched scoreless frames of relief to keep New Hampshire's bats quiet. Reading then got two runs in the top of the seventh to make it 4-3. Otto Kemp drove in one with a ground-rule double and Kendall Simmons knocked in another with a sacrifice fly. But, Reading was held quiet in the eighth and ninth innings in the defeat. Thursday night's game was cancelled due to inclement weather, and with both teams being eliminated in the final week of the first half, the game will not be made up.

### Road Woes

The Fightin Phils have played vastly better defense at home than on the road this season. At home, Reading owns a 21-15 record, which is compared to just 7-22 on the road. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are hitting .261 at home, while averaging 5.6 runs per game at home. On the road, the R-Phils are hitting .207 and average 3.7 runs per game away from home. Reading has 30 more home runs at home, and 44 more extra-base hits at home, compared to on the road.

### All Good Things Must Come to an End

Kendall Simmons snapped his 19-game on-base streak on Wednesday night, dating back to May 21. Over that streak, he's slashed .292/.410/.600, with a 1.010 OPS. He's added 13 runs, three doubles, one triple, five homers and 15 RBI over that stretch. Simmons 19-game on-base streak was the longest active streak in the Eastern League, and tied for the fifth-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. It was the longest on-base streak by a Fightin Phil since Carlos De La Cruz (38; 5/12-6-25) and Oliver Dunn (22; 5/26-6/23) did it last season.

### Bombs Away

The Fightin Phils have been hitting home runs at a much-higher clip as of late. After hitting a home run Wednesday, Reading has homered in 13-of-14 games, and six in a row. Prior to that, Reading hit home runs in seven-straight games, prior to that being snapped briefly. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are now second in the Eastern League with 66 home runs hit this season. In June, Reading has hit 24 home runs, which is second in the Eastern League this month, behind Binghamton who has 25 this month.

### The First Fightin

Robinson Pina will get the ball to start for the Fightin Phils. Pina has been Reading's most consistent pitcher this season as he leads the team in wins and strikeouts, and is 2.2 innings shy of re-claiming the lead in innings pitched. In the Eastern League, Pina ranks 10th in ERA (3.49), tied for second in wins (7) and third in winning percentage (.778). His 8.13 strikeout-to-walk ratio leads all of Double-A, with teammate Lachlan Wells second at 8.00.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 21, 1971:** At Pittsfield, Mike Schmidt makes his Reading Phillies debut in a 3-2 loss to the Senators. Schmidt, batting 7th and playing shortstop, goes 2-for-4 and knocks in both R-Phils runs with RBI singles in the 2nd and 6th innings. Only 371 are in attendance to witness his first Minor League game.

### Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight in fifth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division with a 30-35 record. New Hampshire most recently dropped four-of-six at home against the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, New Hampshire heads to Hartford to take on the Yard Goats. New Hampshire's roster features five players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), CJ Van Eyk (17), Alex De Jesus (23) and TJ Brock (29).

### On the Mound for New Hampshire

Righty, and Blue Jays' No. 17 prospect, CJ Van Eyk makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Van Eyk is 2-4, with a 7.25 ERA over 12 games and nine starts. Over 44.2 innings, Van Eyk's allowed 60 hits, 19 walks and 42 strikeouts. Van Eyk most recently took his second-straight loss on June 14 against Richmond. He went four innings, allowing four runs on seven hits, with three walks and three strikeouts. After missing all of 2022, Van Eyk made stops last season with the FCL-Blue Jays (2), Single-A Dunedin (6) and New Hampshire (4). Van Eyk faced Reading on Aug. 31, 2023, allowing two runs on three hits in a no-decision. He began his pro career in 2021 with High-A Vancouver, after Toronto selected him in the second round in 2020 out of Florida State.

### CAREER NOTES

**2024 Notes:** On Fightin Phils Opening Day roster. Made first start Apr. 7 at Bowie. Allowed just two-earned runs over five innings, but did not record any strikeouts or walks. Picked up season-best to date seven punchouts Apr. 13 vs Portland, but suffered loss as he gave up five-earned runs over just three innings pitched. Was efficient, throwing 40-of-63 pitches for strikes in loss. Twirled best start of season to date Apr. 19 at BNG. Matched season-high with five innings and set new-season best with nine strikeouts in the win. Tossed best outing of season on Apr. 25 vs SOM, earning second-straight win. Threw season-high six innings and did not allow a run, with five hits scattered. Earned third-straight win May 4 at Portland. Season-high 11 strikeouts, which was the most in a game by a R-Phils since 2018 season. Picked up fourth-straight win May 8 vs Hartford. Streak of four-straight winning decisions snapped with loss May 18 at RIC. Allowed two runs on seven hits. Lasted just four innings as he fell victim to high pitch count. Earned team-leading fifth win May 25 vs BNG, striking out eight over five innings. Matched season-high with eight hits allowed. Has earned a decision in seven-straight starts and win in five-of-six. No-decision on June 2 at HFD, allowing one run over 5.2 IP, but did work around some traffic. Was his first start without a decisions since his first one of season on April 7 (seven-straight decisions). Tossed first complete-game shutout of professional career with seven two-hit innings against Harrisburg on June 8. Named Eastern League pitcher of the Week on June 10. Picked up second-straight win and seventh of season June 14 vs POR.

Made 19 appearances (7 starts) with Rocket City and had 3.29 ERA. Struck out 58 hitters across 68 innings. Returned to Triple-A Salt Lake on Sept. 1 to close out season. Overall, made seven appearances and four starts in two Triple-A stints and had 7.83 ERA. Pitched for Estrellas Orientales in Dominican Winter League after season.
