FRISCO OFFENSE EXPLODES IN WIN:

Liam Hicks reached base all five times on Wednesday and the Frisco RoughRiders ran out to a 9-5 victory over the Midland RockHounds at Riders Field. With three singles, two walks and two RBIs, Hicks led the way amidst a strong offensive performance from Frisco (16-13, 47-50). Hicks was the cleanup hitter behind **Jax Biggers**, **Evan Carter** and **Trevor Hauver**. Those four combined for 10 hits, five walks, seven RBIs and eight runs. Carter had three hits for the first time since July 3rd, including an RBI double. Midland (14-15, 46-52) was held off the board by Nick Krauth (3-8) until the fifth inning, scoring three runs in the starter's final inning. He garnered the win, complemented by two scoreless innings from **Justin Slaten** and one more by **Matt Bush**. Those relievers both struck out three, Bush going in order through the RockHounds order in the eighth. Blake Beers (2-7) took the loss, going 3.1 innings with five earned runs. The Riders struck early, scoring before recording an out on Wednesday. Biggers singled on the first pitch of the first inning and Carter walked. Those two scored on RBI singles by Hauver and Hicks. Frisco rebounded for three more runs in the second, highlighted by Biggers' RBI triple. Carter brought him home on a single to center field, stole second and later scored on a wild pitch. Those two teamed up again in the sixth when Carter doubled to score Biggers. In the eighth, Carter scored on Hauver's double and Hauver reached home on Hick's single. With one out in the second inning, Frisco had already totaled as many hits, six, as Tuesday's entire 11-inning affair. Frisco rebounded after the extra-inning loss on Tuesday, evening the series at one win apiece. Frisco has not lost back-to-back games since July 16th and has not lost three in a row since July 1st.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 16 outings. During that stretch, he has 23 strikeouts to three walks over 18.1 innings while recording three saves. He has converted on all seven save opportunities this season.

TRADE SEASON:

The Rangers and the Mets made a major trade on Saturday evening, being reported as completed during the sixth inning of that evening's Riders game, when the Mets sent three-time Cy Young winner and eight-time All-Star **Max Scherzer** to Texas in exchange for RoughRiders shortstop **Luisangel Acuña**. Acuña exits the Rangers franchise hitting .315/.377/.453/.830 with a team-high 25 doubles, 114 hits, 68 runs scored and 42 stolen bases. On Sunday, a second trade for the Rangers impacted Frisco with **Thomas Saggese** and **Tekoah Roby** going to the St. Louis Cardinals organization in exchange for LHP **Jordan Montgomery** and RHP **Chris Stratton**. Saggese was one of the best bats for Frisco, hitting .313/.379/.512/.891 with 22 doubles, 15 home runs, 78 RBIs and 67 runs scored over 93 games while Roby, who has been out with injury since early June, went 2-3 with a 5.05 ERA in 10 starts.

BIG(GERS) DAY IN WICHITA:

Riders infielder **Jax Biggers** had a monster day on Sunday after entering into the game in the second inning for **Thomas Saggese**. He whacked two home runs in a three-hit day for his first multi-home run game of his MiLB career and is now hitting .342 (13-for-38)/.457/.605/1.062 over his last 10 games. Riding a season-long seven-game hitting streak, Biggers is hitting .393 (11-for-28) over the streak.

OFFENSE, OFFENSE AND SOME MORE OFFENSE:

The RoughRiders set multiple season highs in their 19-10 win over the Wind Surge on Wednesday. Their 19 runs, 19 hits and six home runs were all season bests while it was also the longest game of the season at three hours and 31 minutes. In the ninth inning, Frisco went back-to-back-to-back for the first time this season (**Trevor Hauver**, **Josh Hatcher** and **Scott Kapers**). Over their last eight games, Frisco has hit .301/.399/.513/.912 with 21 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 16 steals and 44 walks (5.5 per game) while averaging 8.5 runs per game.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.22 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 41 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.45 (123ER/148.2IP) while the bullpen has a 4.53 ERA (110ER/218.2IP). Over the 41 games, the Riders have the third-best offense in the league by OPS (.795), second-best in runs per game (6.1) and have hit 43 home runs (5th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 25 games, he has driven in 28 runs and in July, Hatcher hit .318/.360/.545/.905 with five homers and 23 RBIs in 17 games.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT NOAH

-Grew up in Berkeley, California and played under father, Matt, at Berkeley High School. Mother, Shelly Neufeld played basketball at University of California. Older brother, Tyler, played baseball at Baylor and was drafted in the 27th round by the Cubs in 2012 (Finished his minor league career with Double-A Jacksonville in 2017 after 164 career outings).

-Went to University of Washington for college. Earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2015, going 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA. In 2016 and 2017, garnered All-Pac-12 honors with a 2.98 ERA and 3.15 ERA, respectively.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (T6th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.

2023 SEASON

-Returned from Tommy John Surgery on June 5th and pitched four games with AZL Rangers. Surgery was performed on March 30th, 2022.

2021 SEASON

-Named Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week for 7/19-25 after fanning 7 batters, walking none, and allowing just 2 hits over a pair of scoreless relief outings (6.2 IP total).

-Went 3-1, 4.89 (21 ER/38.2 IP) in 15 relief app. and 2-3, 3.94 (13 ER/29.2 IP) in 7 starts.

-Allowed just 1 ER over his first five outings (1.54 ERA).

-Pitched for Caguas of the Puerto Rican Winter League, going 0-1 with a 2.77 ERA (4ER/13.0 IP) in 4 starts
