FRISCO CAPTURE FINALE OVER SAN ANTONIO, TAKE TWO OF SIX:

The Frisco RoughRiders wiped out a four-run deficit and finished the San Antonio Missions series with an 8-7 Sunday win at Riders Field. Frisco (22-28) put six innings together without an earned run from the bullpen. San Antonio (27-24) and Frisco are now tied in the season series at six wins apiece. **Chris Seise** led the way with a season-best four RBIs, matched with two hits by **Aaron Zavala**. After the Missions scored two runs in the first inning, Frisco immediately canceled the deficit. **J.P. Martinez** led off with the first of three straight singles, followed by **Luisangel Acuña** and Zavala. Zavala's base hit scored a run, and **Thomas Saggese** added an RBI with a sac fly to tie the game. San Antonio came back with four runs over the next two innings, but Frisco didn't trail for long. A three-run double from Seise pulled the RoughRiders within one run, and Seise scored on Acuña's single. Acuña then stole second and came home on Zavala's single to give the RoughRiders their first lead. Seise wasn't done collecting RBIs, singling the next inning to score **Liam Hicks**. The Frisco bullpen picked up for **Ryan Garcia**, who started for Frisco and was charged with six earned runs in three innings. **John Matthews** (2-1) followed with two scoreless innings to pick up the win, **Kyle Funkhouser** added a zero in the sixth inning and **Aidan Anderson** allowed just an unearned run in the seventh. **Eudrys Manon** kept the one-run lead intact in the eighth inning to set up **Antoine Kelly** in the 9th. Kelly set down the Missions in order to collect his team-high fourth save. Nolan Watson (3-3) entered the game with the Texas League's best ERA at 1.59 but was hit around for seven earned runs in 3.2 innings and saddled with the loss.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

With his appearance on Saturday, reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.93 over 17 appearances. In 19.1 innings, he has struck out 33 to 10 walks. Opponents are hitting just .145 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last eight outings. During that span, he has struck out 18 to three walks over nine innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .111 (6-for-54) against him on the season with a .354 OPS.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 15 games (6-9 record), Frisco has hit just three home runs while batting .222/.332/.298/.630. The three home runs (from **Liam Hicks**, **Trevor Hauver** and **Thomas Saggese**) are the fewest in the league over the last 15 and tied for the second-fewest in Minor League baseball (Salem, 2). The Riders are averaging just 3.9 runs per game over the last 15 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.9).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, fourth in the Texas League with a .579 average (11-for-19) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.442 OPS on the first pitch. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .579 (15-for-30) on the initial offering while his 15 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 21 bags in 48 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 48 steals, which would be far by a career high. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just 11 while stealing 74 bases (87 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on Friday. They are the only team with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Frisco also has a 1.249 OPS with the bags full, which is second in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.329).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .295 (54-for-183)/.366/.415/.781 through the first 43 games. Over his last 39 games, he is batting .309/.385/.442/.827. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (112).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 252 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 38 walks.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No. 16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over three starts on May 5th, May 11th and May 17th, Leiter allowed just three earned runs over 17.0 IP (1.59 ERA) while striking out 25 and walking five.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
