OFFENSIVE OUTBURST: The Omaha Storm Chasers tallied a season-high 13 runs and a season-high 16 hits—including tying a season high with five home runs—in a 13-8 win over the Iowa Cubs on Friday. The Chasers broke the game open in the third inning with seven consecutive two-out hits, scoring six runs on four singles, two doubles, and two home runs. **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn**, who hit two home runs and collected five RBIs, and **INF Emmanuel Rivera** each homered for the second consecutive game. **INF Ryan McBroom** and **INF Gabriel Cancel** hit back-to-back home runs in the six-run third inning. The Chasers also tied a season high with seven extra-base hits.

DYNAMITE LINEUP: Including Friday's 16-hit, five-homer effort, the Storm Chasers offense has recorded 12 games with 10 or more hits this season and 11 games with multiple home runs through the first 27 games of the season. Omaha currently ranks second in Triple-A East and first in the Midwest Division in average (.268), hits (243), and home runs (46). The Chasers also rank third in the league and first in the division in stolen bases (36) and OPS (.823). The Chasers have at least one home run in 15 of the last 16 games and a league-best 35 home runs in that span.

HOME COOKING: The Chasers are 9-1 through the first 10 games of the current 12-game homestand, and 13-3 overall at Werner Park this season. The Chasers average 5.6 runs/game in 16 games at Werner Park this season, batting .282/.355/.495 with 24 doubles and 28 home runs. In 11 road games, Omaha averages 5.4 runs/game, batting .247/.333/.450 with 18 doubles and 18 home runs. On the mound, the Chasers have a 3.44 team ERA at home and a 5.46 team ERA on the road.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 19-8 (.704), the Omaha Storm Chasers are tied for the fourth-best record in all of Minor League Baseball with the Delmarva Shorebirds and Tampa Tarpons. The Bowie Baysox, the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, currently have the best record in Minor League Baseball at 21-5 (.808). As an organization, the Kansas City Royals minor league affiliates have the third-best record in baseball at 66-41 record (.617), which includes Triple-A Omaha (19-8, 1st, AAA-E Midwest), Double-A Northwest Arkansas (13-13, 3rd, AA-C North), High-A Quad Cities (17-10, 1st, A+C West), and Low-A Columbia (17-10, 1st, A-E South).

FOR OMAHA: RHP **Scott Blewett** takes the mound for his second appearance of the series and first start. Blewett entered Tuesday's game in relief in the second inning after **RHP Ronald Bolaños**, who was recalled by Kansas City on Thursday, threw only 1.0 inning in his start. Blewett threw 4.0 innings, allowing two runs (all in the third inning) on three hits with three strikeouts and three walks. The right-hander faced Iowa at Principal Park on May 20, allowing a career-high nine runs (five earned) on seven hits—including two home runs (one grand slam)—in an eventual 16-1 loss. In his most recent start on June 1 vs. Indianapolis, Blewett threw 40 pitches in the first inning en route to exiting after 1.2 innings, allowing four runs on five hits with four walks and two strikeouts in an eventual 10-7 win.

FOR IOWA: RHP Scott Effross gets the start in place of RHP Cory Abbott, who was scheduled to start until he was reportedly called up by Chicago-NL on Saturday. Abbott struck out a career-high 13 batters in his last start and is tied for second in the league with 41 strikeouts in 25.1 innings. Effross made his Triple-A debut on Thursday, pitching a scoreless eighth inning and retiring the side in order on eight pitches. The sidearmer made eight relief appearances for Double-A Tennessee prior to his promotion, posting a 2.89 ERA with 20 strikeouts and five walks in 18.2 innings. He has made three starts in his career, most recently on June 9, 2018, when he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings.

DOPPLER RADAR: **INF Emmanuel Rivera** is 12-for-24 (.500) with three doubles and two home runs across a five-game hitting streak that began on Sunday... **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** has homered in three of the last four games and reached safely in all six games with Omaha since being optioned on May 28... The Storm Chasers will play as the Omaha Runzas on Saturday in a cross-promotion with the Lincoln-founded fast food establishment, Runza, whose flagship menu item (depicted on the green and yellow jerseys and hats) is the runza sandwich, which consists of ground beef, onions, a secret blend of spices, and cabbage.
