LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn grabbed the opening game of a six-game set against Rome on Tuesday night, 3-1...CF **Nick Morabito** enjoyed one of his best performances since joining the Cyclones, notching two hits and drawing a walk...The 21-year-old laced the go-ahead RBI single in the bottom of the eighth before later scoring from second on a LF **Chris Suero** sacrifice fly...Both Morabito and Suero finished with multi-hit affairs...RHP **Jonarhan Pintaro** continued his stretch of now four-straight starts without allowing an earned run...The Pelham, Ala. native struck out five over 4.2 innings...RHP **Ben Simon** silenced all seven batters he faced in relief, while RHP **Eduardo Herrera** recorded the final out with the tying runs on base in the ninth to earn his first save since joining the New York Mets organization.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 24, 2004, Cyclones manager Tony Tijerina was ejected for arguing a safe/out call on a stolen base attempt by Corey Coles in the third inning...In the fourth inning, hitting coach Donovan Mitchell, who had taken over as manager in Tijerina's absence, was also ejected for arguing a strike call...Pitching coach Hector Berrios ends up managing the rest of the game...In 2008, RHP Brad Holt tied a franchise record with 14 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of two-hit shutout ball...Holt became the first right-hander to accomplish the feat for the Cyclones in an 8-1 win vs. Vermont...In 2013, LHP Dario Álvarez struck out 12 over 6.0 scoreless frames, allowing one hit...2B L.J. Mazzilli went 3-for-4 and provided the go-ahead RBI double in the top of the ninth in a 3-2 win at Lowell...In 2017, the winning run scored on a fielder's choice and throwing error off the bat of C Carlos Sánchez in the bottom of the 11th during a 4-3 walk-off win vs. Aberdeen

THEY SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: Current and former Cyclones INF Mateo Gil and RHP Nolan McLean celebrate their 24th and 23rd birthday on Wednesday...In 108 games over two seasons with Brooklyn, Gil is hitting 214/.276/.420 with a .696 OPS, 47 runs scored, 22 doubles, 5 triples, 15 home runs, and 53 RBI...Before joining Double-A Binghamton on May 20, McLean hit .224/.297/.552 with a .849 OPS, 10 runs scored, 7 doubles, 5 home runs, and 13 RBI in 25 games as a hitter, while registering a 2-2 record and a 2.57 ERA (8 ER in 28.0 IP), 10 walks, and 36 strikeouts in seven starts.

MORABITO BITE: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season... The 21-year-old notched the go-ahead RBI single on Tuesday, in addition to scoring on a sacrifice fly from second base for an insurance run...The McLean, Va. native is 13th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (38)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito leads the league in hits (66), is third in stolen bases (28), and tied for sixth in runs scored (41)...The former second-round selection is eighth in the SAL in stolen bases (28) and 10th in batting average (.280) on the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.309), stolen bases (39) and on-base percentage (.405)...He is also second in hits (97) and runs scored (55), and tied for fifth in triples (3).

PAZ DISPENSER: OF **Kareli Paz** is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is hitting .327/.431/.531 with a .962 OPS in 16 games...Paz has scored eight runs and picked up three doubles, two triples, a home run, six runs batted in, eight walks and seven stolen bases...Since that date, Paz is 10th in the SAL batting average (.319), tied for fifth in stolen bases (7), and seventh in on-base percentage (.431) and OPS (.962).

GRAB A PINT-ARO: RHP Jonathan Pintaro has been on a tear over the past month or so...The Pelham, Ala. native surrendered only one unearned run over 4.2 frames of work in Tuesday's win over Rome...The 26-year-old has not surrendered an earned run since June 25 at Aberdeen...Over his four July outings, the veteran has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 14.0 IP), with eight hits, two hit batters, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Pintaro is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in ERA (0.00) and is third in batting average against (160) and tied for eighth in WHIP (0.93) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.96 ERA across six games, while giving up only one earned run over two relief appearances...The Shorter University has unfortunately not received a bevy of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump across his six starts this season.

'TALK 2 'EM: RHP Kade Morris has started to find his stride at the High-A level...Despite being tagged with the loss on Saturday against Jersey Shore, Morris still holds a minuscule 1.63 ERA over his last five starts dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Morris' record during that five-game span (four starts) sits at 2-2...He has yielded just 21 hits and 10 walks while striking out 29...Since June 20, Morris and RHP Jonah Tong have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Morris is fourth in the circuit in ERA (1.63) and Tong is sixth (1.75)...Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (27.2), 10th in batting average against (.204), and 11th in WHIP (112)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is fifth in the league in innings pitched (51.1), ninth in batting average against (.231) and ERA (3.33) and 10th in WHIP (125).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Over his last five starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-1 with a 1.75 ERA (5 ER in 25.2 IP), allowing only 14 hits and seven walks, while striking out 36 ...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit in strikeouts (74)...He is also second in batting average against (203), ERA (3.14) and WHIP (1.19), and 10th in

vs. ROME: Brooklyn continues a nine-game homestand with six contests against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors have six of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Cade Kuehler (7), RHP Jhancarlos Lara (12), INF Sabin Ceballos (17), and RHP Blake Burkhalter (26)...RHP Owen Murphy (4) and INF Ambioris Tavarez (20) are on the injured list...This marks Rome's first trip to Coney Island and the second series ever between the two franchises...Brooklyn and Rome split a six-game series at AdventHealth Stadium from May 7-12.

innings pitched (57:1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.08), fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), and sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%) and tied for ninth in strikeouts (110).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has five multi-hit efforts in his last nine games...Since July 6, he is 13-for-34 (.382) with four runs scored, a double, two RBI, and two walks...Clark had just one multi-hit game in the first 48 contests.

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Before this week's six-game set against Rome, the Cyclones had just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's previous full six-game home series was June 18-23 vs. Jersey Shore...Brooklyn was 7-14 in the 21-game stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and played another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break..The stretch also included a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Since powering a 42I-foot home run on July 13 at Wilmington, the 24-year-old has homered three times in his last four games, going 5-for-13 (.385) at the plate with six runs scored, a double, and five runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately..The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington... The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record..The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

LOCATION. LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is fifth in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (.45) and stolen bases (.25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .241/.313/.276 line with a .589 OPS, three extra-base hits, three RBI, and three stolen bases over 21 games...INF **Junior Tilien** has thrived at Malmonides Park, posting a .294/.350/.421 mark with a .771 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 35 games...On the road, Tilien is hitting 17/1/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .277/.407/.446 with a .853 OPS, three home runs, and 16 RBI in 19 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

WALK-OFF WOES: Brooklyn's 3-2 loss at Wilmington on July 12 marked the team's seventh walk-off defeat of the season. Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.91% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses. Brooklyn has two walk-off wins this year on Chris Suero's RBI single in the 10th on Friday and Nick Lorusso's game-winning home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Asheville on April 12

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (19), Báez (21), Ziegler (22), Wilfredo Lara (23), OF Nick Morabito (25), and Morris (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up a hold in a relief appearance on July 14 at Wilmington...Entered in relief of RHP Jake Stevenson to start the bottom of the fifth inning with Brooklyn leading 5-0...Tossed 3.0 innings of three-hit shutout relief... Did not issue a walk and struck out two...Threw 40 pitches and 31 strikes (77.50%)...Relieved by RHP Ben Simon to start the bottom of the eighth and the Cyclones still leading 5-0... RHP Jonathan Pintaro (1.0 IP), RHP Jawilme Ramírez (2.2), Stevenson (1.0), Wenninger, and Simon (2.0) combined on a six-hit shutout, the Cyclones' franchise-record-tying 11th of the year, in a 5-0 win over the Blue Rocks.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Wenninger is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 26 prospect at mid-season by *Baseball America*.

FLORIDA STATE FIRE: Wenninger was among the best ½23 pitchers in the Florida State League prior to joining the Cyclones on July 8...At the time of his promotion, the 22-year-24 old ranked second in the FSL in strikeouts (89)...Wenninger was also tied for fifth in innings pitched (71.2), seventh in WHIP (1.26), eighth in batting average against (.238), and ninth in ERA (5.02)...He was also first in xFIP (3.06), third in strike-out rate (28.7%) and strikeout-to-walk rate (21.3%), sixth in walk rate (7.4%).

2023: Wenninger signed with the Mets for \$225,000 on July 14...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Tossed a scoreless inning of relief, striking out one, that day at the FCL Cardinals...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 5...Started vs. Daytona that day...Took a no-decision after allowing two runs on one hit, walking two, and striking out three, in 1.1 innings.

ILLI-NOISE: Wenninger had an outstanding final campaign at the University of Illinois, transferring in after spending his freshman season at Murray (Ky.) State University in 2021... During the 2023 season, the Barrington, Ill. native posted a 6-4 record with a 4.59 ERA (41 ER in 80.1 IP), 28 walks (8.30 BB%), and 76 strikeouts (22.55 K%) in 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Fighting Illini...Wenninger was All-Big Ten Second Team in 2023.

MLB DRAFT LEAGUE: Prior to being drafted by the New York Mets, Wenninger made three starts for the Williamsport (Pa.) Crosscutters in the MLB Draft League in 2023...The Crosscutters were a former foe of the Cyclones in the New York-Penn League...The 22-year-old accrued an 0-1 mark with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP), seven walks, and 19 strikeouts.

FAMILY TREE: Wenninger is far from the only member of his family to play collegiate baseball...Jack's grandfather, **Robert Eckl Sr.**, and his uncle, **Robert Eckl Jr.**, both played baseball at the University of Wisconsin...The Badgers' baseball program, however, was discontinued following the 1990-91 school year.
