Heading to Jersey

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on the road at the Somerset Patriots tonight. The series begins with three games in Somerset, then it shifts to Reading from Thursday-Saturday. It's the eighth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and second-of-nine in Somerset. After this week, Reading returns to Somerset from Aug. 27-Sept. 1. The Fightin Phils won their first matchup of the season 4-2 over Somerset from Apr. 23-28. Reading leads the season-series 4-3.

Slipped Away in Somerset

The Fightin Phils had a 6-5 lead with two outs and two strikes in the ninth, but a wild pitch from Carlos Francisco tied the game. Then, back-to-back doubles from the Patriots ultimately gave them the 7-6 walkoff victory in game one. Carlos De La Cruz and Marcus Lee Sang each had two hits in the loss, while Lee Sang and Kendall Simmons both drove in a pair of runs. Lachlan Wells got the start and allowed three runs (two-earned) over five innings, with three strikeouts and a walk. Eury Ramos was spectacular, going two-shutout innings, allowing just one hit and four strikeouts. Daniel Harper suffered a blown save, allowing two runs two tie the game in the eighth. Somerset swiped seven bases on the night, setting a new season-high for an opponent in stolen bases this season.

Marcus Mashing

Marcus Lee Sang continued his consistent season with two hits, two runs, a double and two RBI on Monday night. Lee Sang had a slow start to the season, hitting just .197 in April. But since May 1, Lee Sang is hitting .303, with an .812 OPS. Lee Sang also has showcased some pop as well, as he is tied with Carson Taylor for the team lead in home runs at 10. Lee Sang also leads the team in: at bats (246), hits (67), runs (43) and triples (3).

Ramos Rolling

Fightin Phils relief pitcher Eury Ramos has been on a roll as of late. Since returning from Triple-A Lehigh Valley and making his first appearance back with Reading on June 4, the righty owns a 1.74 ERA over seven appearances and 10.1 innings pitched. He's allowed just four hits and two-earned runs, which both came on June 18 at New Hampshire. When eliminating that New Hampshire outing, Ramos owns a 0.00 ERA over 9.2 innings pitched.

Carlos De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz finished off the month of June slashing .300/.386/.560, with a .946 OPS for the month. He added 21 runs, six doubles, one triple, six home runs and 16 RBI for the month. It's a month that was completely turned his season around, as De La Cruz entered June hitting just .213, and after two more hits on Monday night, he is now up to .255 on the season.

Schwecke On a Roll

Like Eury Ramos, Trevor Schwecke has been red-hot since returning from Lehigh Valley. Since his first game back on June 15, Schwecke is slashing .333/.356/.548, with a .904 OPS. He's added seven runs, six doubles, one homer and 10 RBI. He's also raised his average from .216 to .242 over that stretch.

Next Crop

Two of the Phillies Top Prospects, and potentially futrue Fightin Phils, Aidan Miller and Justin Crawford were each named to the All-Star Futures Game on Tuesday morning. Crawford and Miller are both teammates with High-A Jersey shore and were the Phillies 2022 and '23 first round draft picks, respectively.

Somerset Synopsis

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are first in the Northeast Division with a 6-1 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took five-of-six on the road at the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, Somerset remains on the road for a six-game series at Erie. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Brock Selvidge (10), Zach Messinger (21), Trystan Vrieling (22), Tyler Hardman (25), Danny Watson (27) and Benmjamin Cowles (29).

Righty, and Yankees' No. 21 Prospect, Zach Messingers gets the start tonight for Somerset. This season, Messinger is 2-4, with a 3.60 ERA over 15 appearances and 13 starts (80 IP, 64 H, 25 BB, 90 SO). Messinger last pitched June 27 at Richmond in a no-decision. He allowed two runs (none earned) on three hits, with seven strikeouts, over six-innings pitched. Messinger faced Reading on Apr. 23 and 28, combining to go 0-1 over 11 innings, allowing nine hits, six-earned runs, four walks and 12 strikeouts. Messinger spent most of 2023 with High-A Hudson Valley, but made one start with Somerset. He combined to go 1-10, with a 4.35 ERA over 22 appearances and 21 starts. The Yankees drafted the 24-year old in the 13th round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Virginia.
