## NEWS & NOTES

### LAST TIME OUT: CHIEFS 11, SKY CARP 1

Behind a six-run fourth inning last night, the Chiefs cruised to a series-opening win against the Beloit Sky Carp at Dozer Park...Peoria jumped on Beloit with a two-run home run by Jack Gurevitch in the first inning...With the bases loaded in the second, the Chiefs added another when Báez walked in Cameron Nickens to make it 3-0...In the fourth, Peoria opened it up with six runs on four hits and four walks...Báez had a sacrifice fly followed by RBI singles from Jalin Flores and Cade McGee to extend the lead to 6-0...Won-Bin Cho scored on a wild pitch and then José Suárez knocked a two-run single to lengthen the Chiefs' lead to 9-0...The Sky Carp cracked their goose egg in the fifth on a Brandon Compton RBI single to cut their deficit to 9-1...Peoria starter Yhoiker Fajardo allowed one run on five hits over 4.2 innings...Bobby Olsen, Gerardo Salas, and Jason Savacool led Peoria through the eighth in 4.1 scoreless frames...Suárez put the icing on the cake for the Chiefs with an opposite field two-run homer inside the right field foul pole to make it 11-1...Dominic Freeberger worked around a leadoff walk in the ninth to finish the game...

### PERFECT 10 (OR MORE)

Last night's 11 run output marked the eighth time this season the Chiefs have scored 10 or more runs. Peoria is 7-1 in those games. When allowing 10 or more, Peoria is 1-9.

### DANDY DOZEN

Across the last 12 games, the Chiefs are 9-3. In that stretch, the team has outscored its opponents 84-56 (+28), posting league bests in batting average (.306), OPS (.958), HRs (22) and runs.

### LONG WALKS BY THE ILLINOIS RIVER

The Chiefs tied their season high with 12 walks last night, marking the third time this season Peoria has walked 12 times. 5 of those walks eventually resulted in runs.

### SUÁREZ SURGE

With his eighth-inning two-run homer last night, José Suárez matched his career high of seven home runs, accomplishing the feat in just 38 games after needing 78 contests to reach the mark in 2024. Suárez also recorded his first three-hit game at the High-A level and drove in four runs, his highest RBI total since Aug. 31, 2024 with Low-A Palm Beach. Over his last eight, Suárez is batting .323 with two home runs and 11 RBIs.

### CHO TIME

Won-Bin Cho has been named the Midwest League Player of the Week for May 26-31 by Major League Baseball, becoming the first Chief to earn the weekly award this season. Cho, helped Peoria to a series win at Wisconsin by finishing the week 7-17 at the plate, with six of those hits going for extra bases. His 1.445 OPS for the week led the MWL among hitters with more than 10 at-bats. In May, Cho batted .325 with a 1.097 OPS and five home runs in 24 games.

### TRE TRENDING UP

Tre Richardson III finished May with a team-best .367 BA, recording a hit in 12 of his 15 games played while launching five home runs. Richardson also scored a run in all but two contests during the month. Among Midwest League hitters, Richardson ranked third in OPS (1.203), while he hit the most homers in the fewest number of at-bats (49).

### LOWER THIRD, TOP PRODUCTION

Peoria's 7, 8 and 9 hitters hit a 24-74 (.324) with 4 home runs and 18 RBIs last week, extending a season long trend. The Chiefs' lower third has combined to bat to a league-best .854 OPS and .274 batting average, driving in 113 runs.

### BOMBS AWAY! (PART I)

- Peoria's 74 home runs lead the Midwest League and have surpassed the team's total of 68 in 130 games last season. The Chiefs are on pace to break the franchise record for home runs of 122, set in 2002 (Yadier Molina hit 7 of those HR)  
- The Chiefs are the first team in High-A and the second below AAA to reach 70 home runs this season.  
- Peoria's 16 game home run streak was snapped on Sunday. It stands as the longest team home run streak in Minor League Baseball this season. The Chiefs have homered in 23 of their 25 wins this season.

### BOMBS AWAY! (PART 2)

Chiefs pitching has let up a league-high 72 home runs (13 more than any other MWL team) in 52 games. Peoria has allowed more than one home run in a game 18 times this season, posting a 4-15 record in those games. The Chiefs are 12-4 in games in which they do not allow a homer, including Tuesday's series opener.

### SCOUTING REPORT

Throws: FB (Mid-90s, carry), SL (low-80s), CV (mid-70s), CH (low-80s)  
**Baseball America Draft report (July 2025):** Van Dyke began his college career at Seminole State (Fla.) JC before transferring to Stetson in 2024, where he struggled initially but emerged as a dominant closer as a senior in 2025. He posted a 1.52 ERA with 71 strikeouts and 16 walks over 47.1 innings, earning third-team All-America honors. A strong, 6-foot-2, 255-pound righthander, Van Dyke attacks hitters with a lively 91-93 mph fastball that touches 97 and produced a 37% miss rate thanks to its carry. His primary secondary is a low-80s slider with sharp tilt that drew an eye-popping 49% miss rate. He'll also occasionally show a mid-70s curveball and a low-80s changeup, but rarely uses them.

### SEASON NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** Delivered six shutout innings to earn first High-A win... Only allowed two hits, but issued pro career high five walks... Induced five double plays, just the fifth time on record the Chiefs have turned five or more in a game...

**AN INTERESTING DAY:** Became one of just five High-A pitchers since 2021 to throw six shutout innings, walk five batters and record a win on 5/27 at WIS...

**ON THE BEACH:** Opened the season with Single-A Palm Beach, pitched to 1.64 ERA in 33 innings... Did not allow an earned run in 19.1 innings in April (4 starts), striking out 21 while walking three...

**THE DEAN OF THE ROAD:** Van Dyke posted his best numbers away from Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium with Palm Beach, hurling 15.2 scoreless innings in road games, compared to 6 ER in 17.1 IP at home...

### ABOUT TY

**ORIGIN STORY:** Drafted by the Cardinals in 10th round of 2025 draft out of Stetson... Pitched four seasons of college ball: two at Seminole State Junior College (Sanford, FL), two at Stetson...

**WHAT HE'S SAYING:** "I feel like I've always had a starters' mix... The way I attack hitters is more of a starting style. It's more of a chess match... My mentality hasn't changed much."

## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO ESPINOZA

### MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals. He collected his 200th managerial victory on May 18, 2025 with Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids.

### MIKE HABAS

### HITTING COACH

Mike Habas (HAH-biss), an experienced MiLB hitting coach, will spend his first season in the Cardinals organization with the Peoria Chiefs. Habas joins the Cardinals after spending the last two seasons with the Fredericksburg Nationals, helping guide the FredNats to the 2024 Carolina League title. The Chicago native began coaching in the professional ranks with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2017-18) before spending four seasons with the Brewers (2019-2023). Habas played college baseball at South Suburban College, Moraine Valley College and North Greenville University.

### MICHAEL OH

### PITCHING COACH

Michael Oh, 28, joins the Chiefs for his second season in the Cardinals organization. The Northbrook, Illinois native began his time coaching in the pro ranks with the Palm Beach Cardinals last season, guiding a number of future Chiefs hurlers. Oh pitched four seasons of college baseball, one at North Iowa Area Community College, two at North Carolina and one at Charlotte. After completing his career with the 49ers in 2022, he was added to the Charlotte coaching staff as the pitching coordinator. He was promoted to pitching coach for the 2024 season, where he guided the 49ers to the program record 10.45 K/9 rate.

### JASON EARLY

### BENCH COACH

Another newcomer to the Cardinals organization, Jason Early will spend his first season coaching professional baseball in Peoria. Early joins the Cardinals organization after three seasons with St. Louis University, where he coached Billikens infielders. Early got his coaching start at UNLV, where he served in a player development role. A Las Vegas native, Early earned an undergraduate degree in Kinesiology from Cal-State Fullerton, where he worked as a baseball manager for four seasons, including the Titans run to the College World Series in 2017.

### WADE STAUSS

### ASSISTANT COACH

A familiar face to Chiefs fans, Wade Stauss will spend his first full season as a coach in Peoria. Stauss, 26, was signed by the Cardinals as an undrafted free agent in 2021 after four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. The catcher played 26 games with the Chiefs across two seasons, including a two-home run game on June 28, 2022 at Quad Cities. Stauss played at all four full-season levels of the Cardinals system and appeared in 138 games before transitioning to coaching prior to the end of 2025.

### KILY GILBERT

### ATHLETIC TRAINER

Kily Gilbert is the Chiefs certified athletic trainer after she joined the Cardinals system in November after a previous stint with the Houston Astros. Gilbert originates from southern Oregon and attended Oregon State for her undergraduate and master's studies. She obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in kinesiology in 2019 and her master's degree in athletic training in 2021. Gilbert worked with the OSU football team when she was a student. She was a former intern for the San Francisco 49ers.
