#### CHIRINOS, MESA JR. LEAD JAX TO 3-1 WIN

Yonny Chirinos fired 5.0 innings of one-hit ball and Victor Mesa Jr. launched a home run on Wednesday to spur Jacksonville to a 3-1 victory over Indianapolis. The Jumbo Shrimp opened up the scoring in the second, scoring a pair of runs on an error and Javier Sanoja sacrifice fly. Mesa Jr. went yard in the fifth, and Indianapolis was kept off the board until the seventh, when Matt Gorski smacked a solo shot. Chirinos ceded just one hit and three walks in his five shutout frames. Luarbert Arias fired 2.1 perfect innings with a season-high five strikeouts in relief.

#### HIGH FIVE!

After getting swept in a doubleheader at Charlotte on Thursday, Jacksonville was just 9-22 (.290) in its previous 31 games. The Jumbo Shrimp have responded with five consecutive wins, matching their longest roll of the season (May 23-28). Jacksonville is vying to win six straight contests for the first time since an eight-game winning streak from August 4-12, 2023.

#### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 31 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 33-for-his-last-101, slashing .327/.425/.713/1.138 with six doubles, 11 home runs, 29 RBIs, 18 walks and 23 runs scored. He's homered in five of his last seven games entering play on Thursday. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks eighth in HR/FB (29.2 percent). The 26-year-old has driven in at least one run in 19 of those 31 games, with multiple RBIs in eight contests.

#### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 13-22 (.371) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 17-13 (.556) road record is one of only seven winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Shrimp have scored 160 runs in 30 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (139 runs in 35 games, 4.0 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 183 runs (12th-most in Triple-A) in 35 home games (5.2 per game) compared to 135 (fourth-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game).

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 42 of Jacksonville's 65 games (64.6 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 24 of the club's last 34 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 27 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 19-23 (.452) in these affairs.

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. After an injury scuttled the beginning of his season, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 12 of his first 14 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 20-for-56, slashing .357/.400/.464/.864 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

#### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 28 of his last 32 games, notching 15 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 46-for-128 (.359/.410/.531/.941) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 23 RBIs, 13 walks and 19 runs scored. Among the 215 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (50.9 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (4.1 percent).

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has homered in eight consecutive games, their longest such streak since going yard in 13 straight contests from July 1-18, 2023... Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers (Shaun Anderson, JT Chargois, Kyle Tyler & Yonny Chirinos) have not allowed a run in four consecutive games, tossing a total of 14.1 innings with 10 hits and seven walks against 10 strikeouts.

**ABOUT VALENTE**

-Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.

-Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in each of the past two offseasons.

**2024 SEASON**

-Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.

-At the time of his promotion, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

**2023 SEASON**

-In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA).
