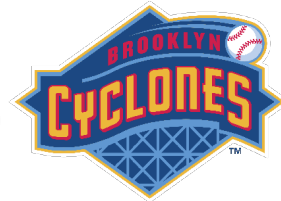

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Bowling Green beat Brooklyn 5-1 in game three of the series behind home runs from INF Osleivis Basabe and OF Diego Infante. Brooklyn OF **Rowdey Jordan** reached base in four of his five plate appearances, including a double and a run scored. Over the middle three innings, the Cyclones stranded seven men and ended up leaving 11 on for the game. RHP **Carson Seymour** made his High-A Brooklyn debut, allowing three runs (two earned) over five innings.

FLY ME TO THE MOON: Brooklyn took its first-ever flight on Monday en route to Bowling Green, Ky. for the first-ever series at Bowling Green Ballpark, flying into Nashville and driving north. The Cyclones have also never played at Greensboro, Rome, Hickory, or Winston-Salem -- all new Brooklyn opponents since the shift to High-A in 2021.

MUCHO POWER MENA: C **Jose Mena** is enjoying the best season of his career, hitting .312 with a .775 OPS and is tied for the team lead with 15 RBIs over 22 games after Wednesday's 4-for-5 performance in game one. With 82 plate appearances already, Mena looks to smash his previous high for plate appearances in a season when he had 112 in 2017 as a member of the GCL Mets. Mena's wOBA sits at .347, while his wRC+ is 107.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** have joined the team in Bowling Green after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, ranks tied for third in the South Atlantic League with 13 doubles, sitting four behind the league leader

vs. BOWLING GREEN: The Tampa Bay Rays affiliate currently leads the South Division of the South Atlantic League with a 25-16 record. Bowling Green has won five of the nine meetings against Brooklyn in 2022. The Rays have four of their Top 30 prospects, including RHP Seth Johnson (8), OF Heriberto Hernandez (16), 1B Kyle Manzardo (26), and SS Osleivis Basabe (28).

Luis Mieses of Winston-Salem. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 50 total bases and is tied for the team lead with C **Jose Mena** who have both collected 15 RBIs.

WHO ARE THESE GUYS?: The Cyclones entered Sunday's doubleheader in Coney Island against Hudson Valley with seven home runs in 34 games which ranked at the fewest in Minor League Baseball. The Cyclones hit a whopping five home runs over the doubleheader with Hudson Valley, receiving two from both OF **Jaylen Palmer** and INF **Shervyen Newton** and one from INF **Jose Peroza** for his first blast of the year. Currently, the Cyclones have hit 13 home runs, which is now the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

CHANGES: There were many changes throughout the Brooklyn Cyclones and the Mets organization on Sunday, including the releases of RHP **Colby Morris** and RHP **Evy Ruibal** who were both in their second season with the Cyclones. At Double-A Binghamton, 2019 NYPL Champion OF **Jake Mangum** was promoted to Triple-A Syracuse, while OF **Antoine Duplantis**, who was also a league champion in 2019 with Brooklyn, was released.

METRIC MATT: C **Matt O'Neill** leads the team with a 115 wRC+ and a .361 wOBA, according to Fangraphs. O'Neill has 12 walks and just 13 hits, reaching base on walks at a 17.3% clip which ranks highest on the team. For his career, O'Neill has 65 hits and 81 walks, batting .220 with a .400 OBP.

TODAY: Acosta makes his eighth start of the season. and the second against the Bowling Green Hot Rods in 2022.

LAST TIME OUT: Acosta retired two of the game's first three batters on May 21 versus Hudson Valley before reaching a limit of 30 pitches in one inning. The righty faced just six batters before the early exit. The early exit marks the third time in Acosta's career he has not lasted through the first inning, and the first time since 2017.

THE RETURN: After missing 2021 recovering from Tommy John Surgery, Daison Acosta made his first appearance in a game since September 2, 2019 on Wednesday against Jersey Shore on April 13, 2022...954 days in between starts. Acosta lasted just two innings on paper but faced and walked the leadoff batter in the third inning before being replaced by Colby Morris.

2019: Acosta's last assignment came with Low-A Columbia where he made 11 starts after four games and three starts with Short Season Class A Brooklyn to being 2019. With the Fireflies, Acosta struck out 49 over 52.1 innings with a 3.78 ERA. With the Cyclones, Acosta spun a 0.98 ERA over 18.1 innings, fanning 25 and walking just six.

TOP-OF-MIND: Acosta is the No. 30 prospect in the New York Mets organization according to *Baseball America*. Due to injuries and COVID coming between Acosta's progression through the system, *MLB Pipeline* did not have him in the Top 30 list.

K-MAN: Acosta's strikeout rate across his 2017, 2018, and 2019 campaigns has been north of 20%, including a career-high 36% with Brooklyn in 2019.

SALLY LEAGUE VET: Acosta pitched with the Low-A Columbia Fireflies in 2019, pitching in the South Atlantic League against teams like Hickory and Rome.
