Final Home Tilt

The Fightin Phils remain home for their final home series of the 2026 regular season, facing the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is the fourth-of-six games between the teams this season, with all six games at FirstEnergy Stadium. The teams met once last year, in Reading, with Erie taking the series 4-2. The two teams could be on a collision course for the Eastern League Championship, with both teams winning second half division titles.

Step One Complete

The Reading Fightin' Phils clinched the Eastern League Northeast Division second-half championship with an 11-10 victory over the Erie SeaWolves on Friday night, securing their first postseason appearance since 2019. Reading trailed 1-0 before scoring four runs in the second, highlighted by RBI singles from Bryson Ware and Luis Caicuto. Pedro Leon added an RBI triple in the third, while Carson DeMartini and Aaron Escobar followed with back-to-back doubles to extend the lead. Erie rallied to tie the game at six in the sixth, but Reading responded with three runs, including a two-run double from Aidan Miller and an RBI single from Dante Nori. DeMartini added two insurance runs in the eighth, finishing with three hits and a walk. Luke Russo allowed two runs over five innings with three strikeouts, while Evan Gates earned the win in relief. Estibenzon Jimenez recorded two outs in the eighth before Daniel Harper finished the game with a double play in the ninth. Reading will begin postseason play next week, seeking its first outright championship since 1995.

Back to the Postseason

With the Fightin Phils win on Thursday night, they have clinched the second half Northeast Division title. It snaps a drought of seven years between postseason appearances for Reading, as they will make their first trip to the playoffs since 2019. Reading's last playoff game was on Sept. 6, 2019, at Trenton, meaning that their playoff game on Tuesday against Hartford will be their first in 2,566 days. The Fightin Phils first playoff game is scheduled for Tuesday, Sept. 15, at 6:45 against Hartford, then they will play at Hartford on Thursday, Sept. 17, at 6:30, and if needed, on Friday, Sept. 18, also at 6:30.

Miller Time Returns

Phillies No. 2 prospect Aidan Miller made his return to Reading on Tuesday night, going 0-for-3 at the plate and playing seven inning defensively at shortstop. He had two hits on Thursday night, including a big two-run double. Miller had missed the majority of the season with a back injury, but after rehabbing with Clearwater (A) last Saturday, he was reinstated from the 7-day IL on Tuesday and assigned to Reading from Lehigh Valley (AAA). Miller spent the majority of 2025 with the Fightin Phils, slashing .259/.382/.427 (.809 OPS) over 108 games, while adding 25 doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, 41 RBI and 52 stolen bases. His 52 stolen bases ranked as seventh-most for a single season in R-Phils history and it was the first time since Jose Leiva stole 50 bags in 1987 that a Fightin Phils surpassed 50 steals in a season. Miller is expected to play seven innings at shortstop again on Saturday, following a scheduled off day on Friday.

Heredia Hits

With another base hit on Wednesday, Raylin Heredia now has 149 base hits this season, which leads the Fightin Phils and paces the Eastern League by three. Heredia's 149 base hits are the most by a Fightin Phil in a single-season since Dylan Cozens had 144 in his historic 2016 season. The last Fightin Phil to surpass 150 hits in a season was Darin Ruf with 155 in 2012, and Heredia is one hit shy from becoming the first Fightin Phil to reach a century and a half base hits in 14 years. Heredia also has a league-high 33 doubles on the season, which is tied for the 11th most in a single-season in Fightin Phils history. He is one-of-24 R-Phils to surpass 30 doubles in a season in franchise history. Heredia also leads the league with 57 extra-base hits in 2026.

Rincon Rakes

Bryan Rincon clubbed his 24th home run of the season on Tuesday night, which leads all active Fightin Phils and is second overall in 2026, trailing Alex Binelas who has 26, but was promoted to Lehigh Valley (AAA) last week. His 24 home runs are tied for second in the Eastern League, also trailing Binelas, and Rincon's .906 OPS ranks as second best in the league. Rincon has been a threat at the top of the lineup this season as well, as his 10 leadoff home runs lead all of Minor League Baseball, pacing second place by two.

Semi Day

Adam Seminaris makes his final regular season start of what's been a career-year in 2026 for the veteran. Entering play on Friday, Seminaris is third in the Eastern League in ERA (4.22), while also ranking T-1st wins (11), first strikeouts (157), T-2nd starts (25), first innings pitched (132.1), 10th average against (.262) and first in WHIP (1.24). Seminaris is also tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with his 157 strikeouts.

Best Season in a Bit

The Fightin Phils have secured their first postseason birth since the 2019 season. Their 68 wins this season are their most in a year since 2019, when they won 80. It is also their best record under manager Al Pedrique, who had a previous high of 59 (2023 and '24) as the Fightin Phils skipper. The Fightin Phils are now 13 wins over their win total from 2025 (55). Nearly through four seasons, Pedrique has collected 241 wins, which is ranked sixth most in R-Phils history.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 11, 1995: At Reading, (Game 3, ELCS), the Phillies move within a game of the EL championship by beating New Haven, 6-4. David Doster's 6th inning 3-run HR is the key blow.

Erie Arrives

Erie enters play today 78-56 overall record and 42-24 mark in the second half. The SeaWolves took three-of-six games from Somerset last week and Erie clinched the Southwest Division Title with their win on Sunday. Erie and Richmond will face off in the first round of the postseason and will face the winner of Hartford and the second half Northeast Division Title. Erie's roster features three of the Detroit Tigers' Top-30 prospects: Zylhir Hope (2), Thayron Liranzo (15) and Lucas Elissalt (26).

Wolves Pitcher

Lefty Joe Miller makes his 18th start of the season tonight for Erie. So far, Miller is 3-1, with a 4.09 ERA (30 ER, 66.0 IP), along with 71 strikeouts. Miller last pitched on Saturday against Somerset, allowing four runs on six hits, with five strikeouts, over 4.2 innings of work. Miller split 2025 between West Michigan (A+) and Toledo (AAA), going 8-4, with a 2.95 ERA over 26 appearance and 23 starts. The 26-year old was drafted by the Tigers in the 11th round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Pennsylvania.
