SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (27-37) vs. WICHITA WIND SURGE (25-38)

LHP BRADEN DAVIS (0-3, 4.94 ERA) vs. RHP PRESTON JOHNSON (0-2, 3.93 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals continue their week in Kansas with the 3rd game of a 6-game series against the Wind Surge (Twins) to wrap up the season's 1st half ... the Cardinals are 6-7 in the season series with Wichita... LHP Braden Davis starts for Springfield against RHP Preston Johnson ... one of the games scheduled for a doubleheader tonight has been canceled.

BRADEN'S BALL: LHP Braden Davis will make his 13th start of the season in tonight's contest and his 3rd start vs. Wichita ... in his last start on 6/12 vs. Amarillo he allowed only 1 unearned run on 2 hits over 4.2 innings ... he struck out 6 and issued 2 walks ... in his last start against Wichita on 5/31 at Route 66 Stadium he did now allow a run over 5.2 innings ... allowed 3 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out a season-high 10 Wind Surge hitters ... pitched at Equity Bank Park on 4/16 and allowed 3 runs on 5 hits in 4.0 innings with 5 strikeouts.

MATINEE MADNESS: The Cardinals lost, 10-9, in a wild game in Wichita Wednesday afternoon ... C Rainiel Rodriguez had 3 hits including a home run and OF Zach Levenson hit his 5th home run of the season ... Springfield scored 5 runs in the 5th inning to take a 6-2 lead but Wichita scored 6 runs over the next 2 frames to jump ahead.

SWITCH ON 'EM: SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje allowed 5 runs on 6 hits over 4.2 innings in his start on Wednesday ... he walked 3 hitters and struck out 4 ... ranks 2nd in the Texas League with 70 strikeouts this season behind Arkansas's Kade Anderson (82 strikeouts).

MAKE IT RAIN: C Rainiel Rodriguez went 3x3 with a his 4th Double-A home run on Wednesday and 2 walks ... has hit safely in 7 straight games ... batting .483 (14x29) during the streak with 5 multi-hit games ... hit two homers in last Thursday's game marking the 19-year-old's first HRs at Route 66 Stadium and his first multi-homer game in Double-A ... dating back to 2005 the only hitters younger than Rodriguez to hit 2+ HR in a Double-A game are Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Fernando Tatis Jr., and Konnor Griffin.

OTHER STREAKS: C Ryan Campos went 3x5 on Wednesday ... extended his hitting streak to 9 games ... is hitting .402 (13x32) during the streak ... IF Dakota Harris has a 7-game hitting streak during which he's hitting .429 (12x29).

THE WICKED WICH: Tonight's game is the 14th of 23 in the season series with Wichita ... Cardinals are 6-7 against the Wind Surge ... Springfield is 1-7 at Equity Bank Park this season.

SHUFFLING CARDS: RHP Brandt Thompson was added back to the club from Triple-AAA Memphis ... RHP Ryan Murphy was transferred to Memphis ... IF Tre Richardson III was added from High-A Peoria ... RHP Nelfy Ynfante was added from Low-A Palm Beach ... OF Jose Cordoba was transferred to Peoria.
