THE LAST TIME OUT: The Altoona bats were alive on Saturday night as the Curve outhit the RubberDucks 10-4, but a pair of costly errors and lack of timely hitting lifted Akron over Altoona, 3-2, at Peoples Natural Gas Field. Altoona stranded 13 runners on base in the contest with hits in every inning but the ninth. The Curve scored in the first inning when Mason Martin grounded into a bases loaded double play to score a run. Altoona would only manage the one run in the frame after Daniel Amaral was retired next to end the inning. Akron got on the board in the top of the sixth inning. With the bases loaded and one out, Brad Case entered the game in relief and got what seemed to be an inning-ending double play ball off the bat of Ike Freeman. However, second baseman Ji-Hwan Bae's throw to first was in the dirt and got past Martin, allowing two runs to cross to give the RubberDucks the lead. Altoona would tie the game 2-2 in the seventh when Bae scored on a wild pitch from Manuel Alvarez. Altoona was kept scoreless from that point forward, stranding five runners over the last three frames. Akron took the lead for good in the eighth inning. With two outs and runners on first and second, Martin misplayed a ball at first base that could have ended the inning, resulting in the go-ahead runner scoring on Altoona's second costly error of the night.

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look to salvage a split of their series with Akron tonight at PNG Field.

THE BABE: Mason Martin continued his torrid campaign at the plate with another home run in game two of the doubleheader. Martin's 16th home run of the season gave him sole possession of the league lead, he ranks third in slugging percentage (.616), first in extra base hits (32) and is second in the league in runs batted in (46).

BACK TO BAESICS: Ji-Hwan Bae made his triumphant return to the lineup on Thursday night after missing four weeks with a left knee injury suffered on June 9 against Akron. Bae went 2-for-4 with a stolen base in his first start after begin activated from the IL on Tuesday. In his final 7 games before hitting the IL Bae was hitting .444 (12-for-27) with 3 2B and 1 3B.

GRANDE CASTRO: The Pirates recalled INF Rodolfo Castro from Altoona prior to Tuesday's game and Castro promptly made an impact, drawing a walk in a pinch-hit appearance in the ninth inning and scoring the winning run as the Pirates defeated Atlanta 2-1. RHP Nick Kingham in 2018 was the most recent player to be recalled to Pittsburgh directly from the Altoona roster. Castro recorded his first major league hit on Friday night with a solo homer off Nick Tropeano of the New York Mets in a 13-2 defeat.

THE NEWS IS GOOD: Pirates Director of Sports Medicine Dr. Tom Tomczyk gave an update on Curve RHP Roansy Contreras and INF Oneil Cruz on Wednesday July 7 and stated that both players have "forearm muscle strains" and the team is hopeful that they will be able to resume throwing in 2-4 weeks. Both players were placed on the IL on July 6 (retroactive to July 5).

THE FUTURE: Curve RHP Roansy Contreras has been named to the National League roster for SiriusXM Futures Game taking place on Sunday, July 11 at 3:00 p.m. at Coors Field in Denver, CO. Contreras is the 20th player in franchise history to be selected from the active roster to the game, first since Ke'Bryan Hayes in 2018. Contreras along with Greensboro RHP Quinn Priester give the Pirates two participants in the game for the first time since 2012 when Gerrit Cole and Jameson Taillon both were selected.

LET'S PLAYOFF: Major League Baseball announced last Wednesday that all leagues at Double-A, High-A and Low-A will play postseason baseball. The top two teams in each league as determined by win percentage, regardless of division, will play a best-of-five series beginning on Tuesday, September 21 playing two games at the #2 seed with an off-day slated for Thursday, September 23 then the series finishing at the #1 seed.

THAT'S A FIRST! This season the Curve have featured seven players that were born after the team played the first game in franchise history on April 10, 1999. Ji-Hwan Bae (7/26/99), Rodolfo Castro (5/21/99), Roansy Contreras (11/7/99), Claudio Finol (4/13/00), Mason Martin (6/2/99), Canaan Smith-Njigba (4/30/99), and Noe Toribio (8/25/99) were each born after Altoona played the first game in franchise history.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: The 'Ducks enter the series after taking 4-of-6 in their series with Bowie. Oscar Gonzalez knocked his team-leading 13th home run of the season before earning a promotion to Triple-A Columbus. The 'Ducks hosted rehabs for RHP Zach Plesac, C Roberto Perez, and OF Franmil Reyes during the series. Manager Rouglas Odor led the club in 2019 and leads them again in 2021. Odor has twelve seasons of managerial experience where he has compiled a career record of 422-442 (.488). When Odor was Akron's hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad. He has three sons and is the uncle of New York Yankees infielder Rounked Odor.

FOR AKRON: LHP Logan T. Allen makes his debut with the 'Ducks after being selected in the 2nd round in 2020 out of Florida International University. A native of Deltona, Fla., Allen was the C-USA Pre-season Pitcher of the Year in 2020 and struck out 10 batters in a start three times before the COVID-19 pandemic cancelled the college season. His brother, Hunter, played baseball at Alabama State and is now a softball coach at FIU.
