## TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST GAME'S RESULT** - The St. Paul Saints returned home from a two-week roadtrip and lost to the Omaha Storm Chasers 11-2 on Tuesday night at CHS Field. Jake Cave went 2-3 with a double, home run, RBI, and a run scored. Roy Morales also collected two hits. The Saints allowed three home runs and hit into five double plays.

**DOUBLED UP:** The St. Paul Saints hit into five double plays on Tuesday night against the Omaha Storm Chasers. It was the most in franchise history. The Saints had hit into three double plays on six different occasions, three in 2021 and three this season. All three of the games in which they hit into three double plays this season came in May: 4, 5, and 10.

**STOP THE BLEEDING:** The St. Paul Saints used four pitchers on Tuesday night against the Omaha Storm Chasers and all four pitchers allowed at least one run. It's the third time this season that every pitcher the Saints used gave up a run (minimum four pitchers). The other two times came in the last two weeks on June 13 and 16 at Columbus. The game on Tuesday was just the second time in which each pitcher (minimum four) gave up an earned run, joining the game on the 16th.

**EARLY TO RISE:** The St. Paul Saints are playing their 23rd day game of the season and are 11-11 in the previous 22. This is a team that enjoys hitting in the daylight scoring the second most runs (146), tied for the second best slugging percentage (.463), third in on base percentage (.358), fourth in home runs (33) and OPS (.821).

**NO PLACE LIKE HOME (PLATE):** On April 19 the St. Paul Saints were blanked 11-0 at the Toledo Mud Hens. Since then, the Saints have scored at least one run in 60 consecutive games, tied for the longest streak in Triple-A with Worcester (also active), tied for the third longest active streak and fourth longest overall streak in Minor League Baseball. Streaks that are longer: Rome (70, active), Fort Myers (66), and Myrtle Beach (65, active).

**S-CAVE-NGING FOR BASES:** Jake Cave homered in his first at bat on Sunday to extend his streak of reaching base safely to 42 consecutive games. During the streak, which began on May 3, he has a hit in 33 of the 42 games and in the nine games he has failed to collect a hit, he has drawn at least one walk. It's the longest streak in franchise history, topping the 20 consecutive by Jimmy Kerrigan last season. It's the second longest streak in Minor League Baseball this season. The longest streak is 51 consecutive games by Luke Berryhill of Corpus Christi from April 14-June 21. The last time Cave didn't reach base was a five inning game on April 30 against the Nashville Sounds when he went 0-2.

**EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT:** The St. Paul Saints have played 72 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 64 consecutive games, third longest in all of Minor League Baseball. The other two are also active (El Paso-73 & Biloxi - 65). The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

**JUNE BOOM:** The St. Paul Saints continue to destroy the baseball in June. After hitting just 19 home runs in April, tied for 60th in Minor League Baseball and 29 home runs in the month of May, tied for 40th in all of Minor League Baseball, they have clobbered 45 home runs in 23 June games, second among the 150 teams in Minor League Baseball, behind Albuquerque's 53, and fifth best in all of baseball including the 30 Major League teams. The New York Yankees have hit 55, the Atlanta Braves have hit 51, and the Toronto Blue Jays have 47.

**AND THEN THERE WERE SIX:** The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final six, but not a final six they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only six Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Charlotte Knights in the International League, the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies and Delmarva Shorebirds in the Carolina League, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.31 ERA in the second lowest of the six teams. Chattanooga's ERA is 5.11.

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** Mario Sanchez pitched an outstanding game on Sunday throwing 6.0 innings allowing just two runs. It was the third quality start by Sanchez this season and just the fourth by a Saints pitcher this season. Sanchez had back-to-back quality starts on May 26 vs. Indianapolis and June 2 @ Iowa. Chi Chi Gonzalez tossed a quality start on May 11 @ Columbus. The Saints, however, are just 2-2 when a starter throws a quality start.

**START ME UP:** Aaron Sanchez worked 5.0 innings on June 25 at Buffalo allowing three runs. In the top of the sixth the Saints scored two runs to take the lead and Sanchez was lifted in the bottom of the sixth as the pitcher of record. The Saints went on to win and Sanchez earned the victory. It was just the sixth win by a Saints starter this season. Those six wins are the fewest among starters in Triple-A tied for 11th in all of Minor League Baseball among 120 teams. Three teams starters have four wins: Visalia Rawhide, Rancho Cucamonga Quakes and Great Lakes Loons and three teams starters have five wins: Columbia Fireflies, Daytona Tortugas, and Delmarva Shorebirds.

**TWINS UPDATE** - The Minnesota Twins split a doubleheader against the Cleveland Guardians on Tuesday. They lost Game 1, 3-2 as Devin Smeltzer went 6.0 innings allowing one run and fanning nine. Carlos Correa hit his ninth home run of the season. The Twins bounced back in Game 2 with a blanking the Guardians 6-0. Josh Winder hurled 6.0 shutout innings and Jovani Moran tossed 2.0 perfect innings of relief. Jorge Polanco, Byron Buxton and Jose Miranda all homered.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** 6/24 @ BUF...tossed 5.0 innings allowing three unearned runs on three hits while striking out six...did not receive a decision in a 5-4, 10 inning Bisons victory.

**APPEARANCE PRIOR:** 6/18 @ COL...pitched 4.0 innings allowing one run on five hits while walking two and striking out three...did not receive a decision in a 4-3 Clippers victory.

**HEALING POWERS:** Was placed on the injured list with a left groin strain on May 13 and activated on May 24.

**WELCOME TO THE BRIGHT LIGHTS:** On May 1, 2022 Sands made his Major League debut in Tampa Bay. He went 2.0 innings of relief allowing two runs on three hits and fanning two.

**WHAT'S IN A NAME:** The pitching staff could be known as the "Middle Name Club." with more than a couple of guys going by their middle name. Bryson Cole Sands is his given name, but Bryson goes by his middle name of Cole.

**FAMILY AFFAIR:** The Sands Family are Seminole people. Dad, David, attended Florida State and set the stage for his sons. Cole's brother, Carson, was committed to Florida State before being selected in the fourth round of the 2014 draft by the Chicago Cubs. Carson played four seasons in the Cubs organization, reaching as high as Single-A South Bend, before injuries derailed his career.

**OMAHA BOUND:** Cole was part of the 2017 Florida State Seminoles team that made it to the College World Series in Omaha. It was the first time since 2012 that the Seminoles reached Omaha, the longest drought since they went in 2000 and not again since 2008. The Seminoles couldn't figure out LSU, however, losing the first game of the tournament to the Tigers, 5-4, then beat Cal State Fullerton, 6-4, before bowing out with their second loss to LSU, 7-4.

**RELAXING ON THE SANDS ON THE RIVERFRONT:** The city of Wichita had an Independent Professional Baseball team in the Wichita Wingnuts from 2008-2018. They played their games at historic Lawrence-Dumont Stadium, built in 1912 and held the national NBC Tournament. The city decided it wanted an affiliated team and built Riverfront Stadium. They were originally scheduled to be the Triple-A affiliate of the Miami Marlins in 2020, but the pandemic shut down the season. Minor League Baseball then reorganized everything in 2021 and Wichita now was home to the Twins Double-A team. They opened the ballpark on May 11, 2021, a game Cole Sands would get the start in. He went 4.0 innings allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out five. He left in a 2-2 game, but the Amarillo Sod Poodles (Arizona Diamondbacks) scored a run in the seventh to defeat Wichita 3-2 and ruin the ballparks opener. No worries, though, as Wichita went 34-26 at Riverfront Stadium in 2021.

**IT'S NOT EASY BEING GREEN:** Entering the 2022 season, Sands has only pitched in 37 games (36 starts). That's the fewest games pitched by anyone on the Saints pitching staff. That included Jordan Gore, who wasn't converted to a full-time pitcher until last season. Gore has pitched in 43 games, 39 in 2021 (he threw in one game as position player in 2018 and three in 2019).

**AN INCREMENTAL RISE:** At the 2021 midseason Cole was ranked 16th in the Twins organization according to Baseball America. To begin the 2022 season he has climbed smack dab in the middle of the Top 30, as he starts 2022 as the 15th ranked Twins prospect, 9th best pitching prospect, and 8th best right-handed pitching prospect in the organization.

**MONDAY, ONE DAY, TUESDAY, TWO DAY, WEDNESDAY, HUH, WHAT DAY?:** The third day of the week is one that Cole cared about in 2021. As a matter of fact, Cole LOVED pitching on Wednesday. In his four starts on Wednesday he didn't give up a run in 14.1 innings pitched while walking six and striking out 21 while opponents hit .106 against him. Of course, if you average that out it's about 3.5 innings per start, not long enough to earn a decision. Coincidentally, Sands' record on Wednesday last year was 0-0.

**3-0 NO NO:** Over the course of 334 batters faced in 2021, Sands only went 3-0 on a hitter seven times. He walked six of those hitters and retired the other batter. When Sands got ahead in the count hitters were hitting just .162 against him, .250 when he fell behind.
