### RHP Tommy Romero (3-1, 3.51) vs. LHP Juan Hillman (0-1, 4.76)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and River Cats meet for the first of three series on the year, including two at Sutter Health Park ... Albuquerque is coming off a series loss (5-1) against Oklahoma City ... The Isotopes have lost three-straight sets ... Oklahoma City ... The Isotopes have lost three-straight sets ... Juan Hillmann is slated to make his second Isotopes start while Tommy Romero is scheduled to toe the rubber for Sacramento.

ATTENDANCE: The Isotopes have tallied the highest total attendance in all of Minor League Baseball with 213, 534 fans over 33 openings.

JONESY: Nolan Jones played in his fourth rehab game Sunday (first since May 17 vs. Sugar Land) and went 0-for-2 with a strikeout and walk ... Over four games, he is hitting .091 (1x11) with one RBI, three walks and six punchuts.

**HOME**: The Isotopes extended a franchise-worst streak by losing their sixth consecutive home series, dating back to the start of the campaign, March 29-31 vs. El Paso.

**TWO OR FEWER:** The Isotopes were held to two or fewer runs for the 14th time this season Sunday, 10 coming in the last 27 contests dating back to May 3 vs. Round Rock. Additionally, 10 of their 14 games plating two or fewer tallies have come at home. However, Albuquerque has not been shut out in 2024.

**RISP**: Over the six contests last series against Oklahoma City, the Isotopes finished 6-for-52 with runners in scoring position.

**TWO HOMER GAME**: Trey Sweeney's two-homer game Sunday marked the 11th time an opposing player has hit multiple homers in a game in 2024, and third during the homestand. Sweeney clubbed a trio on Wednesday before Ryan Ward connected on a pair Saturday.

FIRST TO SCORE: Albuquerque has allowed their opponent to score first in seven consecutive ballgames, tying a season-high reached on two previous occassions (also: April 6-13, May 3-10).

BY WAY OF THE K: At the plate Sunday, the Isotopes struckout 14 times, the fifth time in 2024 with at least 14 punchouts. Three of the instances have come against Oklahoma City, including a season-worst 16 on April 2.

MARGIN: The Isotopes lost by double-digits for the seventh time Sunday and second in the last four days (also: 11-1).

TAKE YOUR BASE: James Outman became the second opposing player to take four walks in a game this season Sunday (also: Drew Avans, April 23 vs. Oklahoma City).

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes mashed his team-leading 24th multi-hit game of the year Sunday and seventh three-hit game (last: May 19 vs. Sugar Land) ... Has multi-hit outings in at least two-straight contests seven times this year ... Recorded his fourth triple of the year Sunday and first since May 17 vs. SUG.

**BIG MIKE**: Michael Toglia struckout three times Sunday, his fourth game with three-plus punchouts (last: May 31 vs. OKC) ... Connected on second multi-homer game this season Saturday (also: May 8 at El Paso, both sides of plate) and fourth as an Isotopes ... 17th Isotope to record four-plus multi-homer games.

WAY BACK: Greg Jones' fifth inning blast Saturday traveled 467 feet, the longest by any Albuquerque hitter in 2024 (previous: Hunter Goodman, April 20 at El Paso, 464). It is the ninth-longest home run for a Triple-A player this season.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo went 3-for-5 Saturday, his 17th multi-hit game of the season and first since May 18 vs. Sugar Land ... Seventh game with three-plus knocks in a contest.

COOLIN' OFF?: From April 21-May 18, Romo slashed .450/.459/.725 with eight doubles, four homers, 20 RBI ... Last 10 games, hitting .220 (9x41) with a double, triple, three homers.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk went hitless last night for the fourth time in his last seven games ... He draw a walk for the first time since May 21 at Salt Lake.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard is 3-for-25 in last six games (four hitless).

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall swatted second homer of year Sunday (other: May 17 vs. SUG) ... Has a hit in three-straight (4x13).

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 2nd in average (.343), 7th in slugging (.558), 10th in hits (59) and T-10th in OPS (.919) ... Aaron Schunk is T-4th in doubles (17) ... Coco Montes is 1st in average (.350), 2nd in hits (69), 3rd in OBP (.429), 4th in OPS (.987), T-5th in triples (4), 6th in total bases (110) and slugging (.558) ... Sam Hilliard is 2nd in runs (44), 4th in walks (33), 5th in total bases (112), T-6th in XBH (26) and homers (11), 8th in slugging (.549), hits (61) and OPS (.941), T-10th in triples (3) ... Julio Carreras is 5th in stolen bases (16).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in total bases (975) and triples (28), 2nd in hits (570), slugging (.482), average (.282), 3rd in OPS (.845) and doubles (124), 5th in runs (340).

#### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID:** Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
