ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Paul Skenes struck out eight in 3.1 innings pitched, but the Toledo Mud Hens rallied late to hand the Indianapolis Indians a 4-3 defeat in 11 innings on Friday night at Fifth Third Field. Both teams were held scoreless until Indianapolis broke the seal in the fifth thanks to a bases-loaded sacrifice fly off the bat of Liover Peguero. One inning later, the Indians chipped in two more runs to make it 3-0. Grant Koch reached safely on a throwing error by shortstop Andrew Navigato that allowed Gilberto Celestino to score, and Sergio Alcántara greeted Bryce Tassin out of the bullpen with a run-scoring double. The Mud Hens responded in the bottom half of the sixth on a long home run by former Indian Bligh Madris and used Malloy's blast in the ensuing frame to pull even. After the Mud Hens tied the score at three in the bottom of the seventh on a two-run home run by Justyn-Henry Malloy, the game went to extras. The Indians failed to score in their two trips to the plate, and Toledo's Anthony Bemboom broke the deadlock with a line drive into center field with the bases loaded to plate former Indian Rvan Vilade.

SKKKKKKENES: Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in Minor League Baseball, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) punched out eight batters across 3.1 innings during his third career Triple-A start. All eyes were on the 21-year-old, who has racked up 19 strikeouts in just 9.1 innings pitched this season. His 19 strikeouts are tied with Nashville's Tobias Myers and Syracuse's Christian Scott for most in the International League. Skenes pitched around a leadoff single in the first with two strikeouts, struck out three while issuing one walk in the second and recorded three more punchouts in the third — two on overturned challenge calls that were initially ruled balls — while scattering two singles. For the first time as an Indian, he pitched into the fourth inning and induced a groundout to the catcher before exiting at the 55-pitch mark. He touched triple digits 15 times, with his fastball topping out at a season-high 101.6 mph.

GONZO ON BASE: Nick Gonzales went 1-for-5 last night to extend his on-base streak to 12 games, making him one of six players in the IL this season to have reached base safely in at least 12 consecutive contests. He ranks among IL leaders in doubles (1st, 7), hits (3rd, 19), runs (3rd, 14) and batting average (10th, .373) after tying for the league lead in '23 with eight triples. Seven of his 12 games have featured multi-hit performances. Gonzales' longest on-base streak with lndy in '23 was a 13-gamer from 4/6-19.

BAE'S REHAB: Utilityman Ji Hwan Bae collected two hits and a walk in four plate appearances last night and is batting .571 (4-for-7) with a home run, two RBI, run and two walks in two games with Indy. He was placed on the 10-day injured list with a strain of his left hip muscle on March 28 (retroactive to March 25) after undergoing an injury during spring training. Bae began his rehab assignment with Single-A Bradenton on April 7 and went 2-for-3 with a double and RBI before being transferred to Indianapolis. Since making his big-league debut in September 2022, Bae has made two return trips to Indy on rehab assignments and has fared well, hitting. 385 (15-for-39) with 10 runs, five extra-base hits and a 1.115 OPS in 11 games.

THOU SHALL NOT STEAL: The Indians are last in Triple-A with four stolen bases and have been caught stealing eight times, most in Triple-A. Gilberto Celestino, Joshua Palacios, Liover Peguero and Canaan Smith-Njigba, who led the Indians with 21 stolen bases in '23, each have one successful stolen base this season. Indy's catching duo of Grant Koch (33%, 3-for-9) and Carter Bins (14.3%, 1-for-7) have combined to throw out 25% of basestealers.

TODAY'S TWIN BILL: After losing last night's contest in extra innings, the Indians will look to tie the series and take an advantage with a doubleheader sweep today at 2:35 PM ET. Indianapolis saw success vs. the Mud Hens in 2023, finishing the season series with a 14-4 record while going 5-1 at Fifth Third Field. Taking the hill for Game 1 today for Indianapolis is RHP Quinn Priester (1-0, 2.79), who dominated the Mud Hens in 2023 (see below). Countering for Toledo is LHP Brant Hurter (0-1, 7.71), who made his Triple-A debut on 3/31. In Game 2, LHP Cam Alldred (0-1, 3.86) will look for his first win of the season against LHP Bryan Sammons (0-1, 7.71).

QUINN WINS: Indianapolis' Game 1 starter, RHP Quinn Priester, was dominant against the Mud Hens during the 2023 campaign in which he was named an International League postseason All-Star and Indy's Pitcher of the Year. Priester appeared in three games (two starts) against Toledo, going 3-0 with a 0.51 ERA (ler/17.2ip) and 20 strikeouts. He faced Toledo in his final Triple-A appearance of the '23 season and punched out 10 across 5.2 one-run innings in salid.

THE MIGHTY QUINN: Quinn Priester ranks among IL qualifying leaders in batting average against (6th, .147, 5-for-34) and WHIP (8th, 1.03). Last year he finished among league leaders in wins (T-3rd, 9) and strikeouts (5th, 116).

DOUBLEHEADERS: One week after sweeping a doubleheader vs. Memphis at Victory Field, the Indians will play their second twin bill of the 2024 season. Indianapolis emerged victorious 5-4 and 7-5, marking their first doubleheader sweep since 4/6/23 at Louisville (5-3, 1-0) and their first at Victory Field since 6/4/21 vs. Columbus (10-3, 5-2). In five doubleheaders during the 2023 campaign, Indy went 4-6 with a 3-1 record on the road.

THIS DATE IN 2019: After beginning the season 0-3, the Indians extended their winning streak to six games behind offensive contributions from every spot in the lineup. Each player nabbed at least one hit, with shortstop Cole Tucker and eventual Team MVP Jake Elmore leading the charge with three hits apiece. Indy trailed 3-0 after the top of the first but managed to put up nine runs on 16 hits to win its third game of the four-game series with Charlotte, 9-7.

GAME 1 PITCHER

Quinn Priester: Right-hander Quinn Priester is set to make his third start of the year in today's doubleheader opener at Toledo.

Last Outing: Priester took the no-decision in the first game of a doubleheader on Saturday in Indianapolis by punching out three over 4.0 innings.

Against the Mud Hens: Priester made three appearances (two starts) against Toledo in 2023, going 3-0 with a 0.51 ERA (1er/17.2ip) and 20 strikeouts. His final appearance against Toledo came on 9/7 at Victory Field when he fanned 10 over 5.2 one-run innings.

Quinning: Priester won a career-high seven consecutive decisions in Triple-A from 5/4-8/25/23, going 7-0 with a 3.04 ERA (26er/77.0ip) and 74 strikeouts over 15 games (14 starts). During that stretch, he ranked among league qualifiers in ERA (2nd), batting average against (3rd, .233), wins (T-4th) and WHIP (6th, 1.25).

IL Postseason All-Star: Priester was named to the International League postseason All-Star team following his 2023 Triple-A campaign. He went 9-4 with a 4.00 ERA (48er/108.0ip) in 22 games (22 starts) and ranked among league leaders in wins (T-3rd) and strikeouts (5th, 116). He was the sixth Indians starting pitcher to be named to the IL postseason All-Star team, joining Fritz Ackley (1963), Ben Hendrickson (2004), Zach Duke (2005), Steven Brault (2017) and Mitch Keller (2019).

Miscellaneous: Selected by PIT as the 18th overall pick of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft ... selected to the 2021 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game and struck out White Sox prospect Yoelqui Cespedes ... Was named the 2021 High-A East Pitcher of the Year. ... Had his contract selected by PIT on 7/17 and made his MLB debut that night vs. CLE.

GAME 2 PITCHER

Cam Alldred: Southpaw Cam Alldred is set to make his third start of the season in today's nightcap at Toledo.

Last Outing: Alldred took the bump in Indy's series finale against Memphis on 4/7 and allowed allowing one run in 4.0 innings.

Against the Mud Hens: Alldred has made eight career appearances (one start) against Toledo in 2022-23, going 2-1 with a 5.60 ERA (11er/17.2ip) and 15 strikeouts.

Cam is the Man: Cam Alldred spent the 2023 season as the Indians' ultimate go-to man, making 17 starts and 14 appearances out of the bullpen. He recorded his first career quality start on 6/16 at lowa (6.0ip, 2r) to kick off a stretch of three consecutive such starts and four total on the season. He went 3-7 with a 4.44 ERA (39er/79.0ip) and 74 strikeouts as a starter and 5-1 with a 7.43 ERA (22er/26.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in relief.
