**PAPILLION, NEBRASKA** - The Omaha Storm Chasers rallied from down four runs to tie the game and force extras, then walked off on a passed ball as the bullpen combined for 6.0 scoreless innings and Omaha topped Iowa, 5-4 on Opening Night at Werner Park.

- The I-Cubs steadily controlled the first half of the game, tagging Omaha starter **Daniel Lynch IV** for four runs on nine hits over the first five innings ... Lynch struck out three and threw 57 of 84 pitches for strikes ... an **Alexander Canario** home run put Iowa up 1-0 in the 3rd inning, then a stretch of five hits in six batters plated three runs in the top of the 5th inning, at the time giving the Cubs a 4-0 lead.
- Iowa starter **Thomas Pannone** held the Storm Chasers to a walk and two hits over five scoreless innings, but Omaha was able get things going at the plate as soon as the Cubs turned to the bullpen ... in the bottom of the 6th inning, **Nick Pratto** drew a one out walk, followed by a **Tyler Gentry** single to bring **CJ Alexander** to the plate ... Alexander proceeded to bring the Chasers within a run, as he blasted a three-run homer past the berm in right field to bring Omaha within one, 4-3.
- Alexander tied the game for the Chasers in the 8th inning, as three straight hits off former Omaha arm **Richard Lovelady** brought the teams even at 4-4 ... Pratto dropped his second bloop double of the game into the outfield, Gentry singled him over and Alexander singled in Pratto to eventually force extras.
- Behind Lynch, the Omaha bullpen was lights-out, as the arms of **Dan Altavilla**, **Walter Pennington**, **Will Klein**, **Sam Long** and **Steven Cruz** combined for 6.0 scoreless innings ... the five relievers only allowed two hits as a group, while walking one and striking out eight ... Altavilla struck out three, while Pennington added two punchouts and each Klein, Long and Cruz had one strikeout.
- After the Storm Chasers stranded the go-ahead run on third base in the eighth inning, neither team scored until the 11th, when Omaha placed runner **Cam Devanney** moved to third base on an **Austin Nola** sacrifice bunt to put the winning run 90 feet away ... the Chasers recorded two quick outs at the plate, before Devanney dashed home from third base on a passed ball to win the game for the Chasers, 5-4.
- The win improves Omaha's Opening Day winning streak to 4 straight seasons, while the club is 6-7 on Opening Day in the Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... the Chasers are now 7-6, however, in home openers at Werner Park.

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### EXTRAS, EXTRAS, READ ALL ABOUT IT

The 11-inning game Omaha and Iowa played last night was just the 8th game of 11 innings or longer the Storm Chasers have played since the start of the 2021 season.

- The last time Omaha played extras on Opening Day was April 9, 2015 @ New Orleans, a 10-6 win in 10 innings over the New Orleans Zephyrs.
- Since the start of the 2021 season, the Chasers have played 22 extra-inning games and Omaha has gone 16-6 in those contests (.727 winning percentage).
- The Storm Chasers played just one game of 11 innings or longer each of the last two seasons, after playing five such games in 2021.

#### HOME, SWEET HOME

Yesterday was the first walk-off win on an Opening Day in the Storm Chasers era and just the second extra-inning Opening Day game since 2011.

- Yesterday was the 13th walk-off win in extra innings since the start of the 2021 season ... there was one in 2023, five in 2022 and six in 2021.
- Yesterday was the first walk-off win in a Werner Park home opener ... a walk-off win in the first home game of the season is not something the Triple-A Omaha franchise has accomplished since at least 2005.
- A four-run deficit is the largest Omaha has overcome to win a home opener since at least 2005 ... three times, the team has overcome a 3-run deficit in the first home game, but never more than the 3 runs.

#### WELCOME TO THE DONUT SHOP

Last night, Omaha's relief pitchers combined for 6.0 scoreless innings ... it was just first time since September 2022 that Omaha's bullpen threw 6.0 or more scoreless innings.

- The last game where the Chasers' relievers combined for 6.0 or more scoreless innings was September 4, 2022 @ St. Paul, where five arms combined for 7.0 scoreless frames.
- In 2023, the Storm Chasers bullpen had 24 games where the relief corps combined to hold the opposition scoreless ... the first time it happened last year was the third game of the season, April 2 @ Indianapolis.
- Of the 424 games Omaha has played since the start of the 2021 season, the bullpen has combined for a scoreless effort in 98 of them (23.1%) ... of those 98 scoreless games, only 8 of them have totalled 6.0 innings or more (8.2%).

#### EVEN STEVENS

Yesterday's win was the 3,828th in the history of the Triple-A Omaha franchise ... the club now has an all-time record of 3,828-3,828, an exactly .500 winning percentage since 1969.

- It's worth noting, of the 7,656 games the franchise has ever played, 1,050 of them have come against the Triple-A Iowa franchise (13.7%) ... Omaha has the all-time series lead, 538-512 (.512 winning percentage).
