WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg picked up an 11-1 win in their series opener in New Hampshire (TOR) last night...**C KEVIN BAZZELL** finished a triple shy of the cycle at the plate, going 4-for-5 with his first Double-A home run.

BACK ON TOP: On a sunny Labor Day afternoon at ESL Ballpark, the Rochester Red Wings opened their final homestand of the season with a 3-1 victory over the Scranton/WB RailRiders...LF **SAM PETERSEN** drove in the go-ahead run in the sixth and added insurance with his first triple of the season in the eighth, while CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** preserved an early tie with a home run-robby catch...the Red Wings took Tuesday off and are back in action for game two of the series tonight, sending RHP **JACK CEBERT** to the mound for his third Triple-A start...the RailRiders will counter with RHP Brendan Beck...

The Red Wings won both of their Monday games this season, picking up a victory on both Labor Day and Memorial Day (5/25).

SEA TO SHINING CE(BERT): RHP **JACK CEBERT** will take the mound tonight for Rochester in what will be his third start with the team, and second at ESL Ballpark...in his previous outing at Syracuse on 9/3, the 24-year-old Florida native took the loss after allowing two earned on six hits across 4.0 full innings, while striking out and walking four apiece...across nine starts with Rochester, Double-A Harrisburg, and Double-A Somerset (NYY) since the start of July, Cebert boasts a 2.39 ERA (10 ER/37.2 IP) with 43 strikeouts, 23 walks, a 1.38 WHIP and .203 BAA...

Tonight will mark the 27th appearance (20th GS) of his professional career...he holds a 3.04 ERA (23 ER/68.0 IP) in 14 games (11 GS) following a team win.

HOW'S THE VIEW FROM DOWN THERE?: With a victory over second-place Scranton/WB on Monday, the Red Wings have moved back into first place in the International League second-half race with a 38-26 record since 6/23...their 38 wins are two more than any other IL club, while their .594 winning percentage leads the 20-team circuit...Rochester has scored an IL-best 388 runs during the second half, 19 more than Columbus, and owns a league-leading +83 run differential, 26 runs better than second-place Scranton/WB...the Wings enter Wednesday one game ahead of the RailRiders, 2.5 games ahead of Syracuse and 3.0 games ahead of Worcester...

83 wins overall this season are the most by a Red Wings team since 1997 (83), and tied for the most since 1990 (89)...should Rochester win seven of their remaining 11 games, it would be their first 90-win season since 1953 (97-57).

SAM'S CLUB: SAM PETERSEN went 2-for-3 with a hit-by-pitch and drove in Rochester's final two runs in Monday's 3-1 win over Scranton/WB...his two-out RBI single in the sixth gave the Red Wings the lead before he added a two-out RBI triple in the eighth, the first three-bagger of his Triple-A career...Petersen has hit safely in five straight games since 9/4, batting .471 (8-for-17) with two doubles, a triple, a home run, six RBI, and a 1.432 OPS...in seven games against Scranton/WB, he is batting .360 (9-for-25) with a hit in all seven games, four extra-base hits, seven RBI, a .500 OBP, and a 1.140 OPS.

LEAN ON LEANDRO: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** extended his on-base streak to 26 consecutive games with a fourth-inning ground-rule double last night, and finished 2-for-4 with an RBI and a run scored...dating back to 8/7, Pineda is batting .337 (29-for-86) with nine home runs, 18 RBI, 25 runs scored and 14 walks, posting a .453 OBP and 1.151 OPS...his streak is the second-longest by a Red Wing this season, trailing only **TREY LIPSCOMB'S** 28-game run from 7/26-8/27...nine of Pineda's 10 Triple-A home runs have come during the streak...he has reached safely in 33 of his first 34 games as a Red Wing...

Pineda and Lipscomb are the first pair of Red Wings teammates to each log an on-base streak of at least 25 games since Chris Colabello (36 G) and Antoan Richardson (27 G) in 2013.

ANOTHER BRICK IN THE WALL(ACE): 3B **CAYDEN WALLACE** finished Monday afternoon's series opener 1-for-2 with a walk, extending his hit streak to 15 games, the longest active streak in the International League...among qualified IL hitters over the length of his streak, Wallace ranks first in batting average (.426), OBP (.508), SLG (.815), OPS (1.323), hits (23), and total bases (44)...against Scranton/WB this season the former Kansas City Royal farmhand is batting .367 (11-for-30) with a lone home run and six driven in...

When Wallace faces right handed starting pitchers this season, he's slashing .333/.397/.609 with 10 extra-base hits and 15 RBI.

PENNING A WIN: Rochester's bullpen covered the final 6.2 innings of Monday's 3-1 victory without allowing a run, as six relievers limited Scranton/WB to two hits and struck out 10...the group recorded half of its 20 outs via strikeout and stranded all three inherited runners...the Red Wings' bullpen owns a 4.29 ERA this season, third-best in the International League, while RHP **GUS VARLAND'S** four-out save was his seventh with Rochester and the team's 37th, second-most in the circuit...this is the fourth time this season that the Red Wings bullpen has turned in at least 6.2 scoreless innings (5/21, 8/8, 8/15).

Entering his 10th professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he was acquired from Houston in exchange for cash considerations on 7/3/2026...originally selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2017 MLB Draft, out of Manhattan University.

- Made his Red Wings debut on 7/5 vs. Lehigh Valley, striking out three and allowing no hits across a scoreless inning...appeared in 29 games in relief with Triple-A Sugar Land to begin the season, going 2-1 with a 4.30 ERA (14 ER/29.1 IP), 29 strikeouts and a .206 opponent batting average.
- Allowed just one earned run in 9.2 innings of work across 10 appearances in the month of April, with a 0.93 WHIP and .156 BAA.
- Began the 2025 season at the Triple-A El Paso (SD)...was traded to Chicago-NL on 4/10, spending the bulk of his season with Triple-A Iowa.
- Went a combined 5-1 with a 4.53 ERA (25ER/49.2IP), 57 strikeouts and a .246 opponent batting average in 44 appearances at the Triple-A level, including 40 with Iowa...also made two appearances over two stints at the Major League level with the Cubs, posting a 2.52 ERA (1ER/4IP) with three strikeouts.
- Played in parts of three Major League seasons (2023-25), spent with the Padres (2023-24) and Cubs (2025)...has gone 1-3 with a 3.86 ERA (30ER/70IP), 62 strikeouts, a .220 opponent batting average and a 1.19 WHIP in 74 Major League appearances.
