EDWARDS HOMERS BUT JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 5-2 Xavier Edwards homered on Thursday, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp dropped a 5-2 affair to the Gwinnett Stripers in front of 5,597 fans at 121 Financial Ballpark, Gwinnett drew first blood with a walk by Luke Williams and a double from Braden Shewmake. Back-to-back sac flies by Vaughn Grissom and Jesus Aguilar put the Stripers in front 2-0. Shewmake's solo homer in the third gave Gwinnett a 3-0 lead. Edwards solo homer, his fourth of the season came in the bottom of the inning cut the deficit to 3-1. The Stripers added a run in the sixth and seventh to take a 5-1 lead before a sac fly from Jacob Amaya made it 5-2.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 41 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek. Fla., native is 65-for-173 at the plate. slashing .376/.421/.491/.912 with six doubles, one triple. four home runs, 26 RBIs and 37 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the International League in batting average (.354) and seventh in OBP (.425). Among the 292 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances. Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 50 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

NEED FOR SPEED

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Saturday, pushing his personal streak to 24 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84.6 percent stolen base success rate is second in Triple-A and third out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. Only two Jumbo Shrimp have been caught stealing since July 9, with the club swiping 17 bags in that span.

MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 29 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 42-for-121, hitting .347/.383/.471/.854 with 10 doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBIs and 21 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 11 multi-hit games in his last 17 games, batting 30-for-81 (.370/.400/.494/.894) with seven doubles, one homer, eight RBIs and 15 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 222 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (44.1 percent). His 30.5 percent line drive rate is sixth.

ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 18 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 7-11, with all but one of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 11 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 53 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -28 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester, Nashville & Gwinnett).

THE PENDULUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the first two games against Nashville, Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. Over the last four games, the bullpen has regained its footing, firing 15.0 innings of five-run ball, ceding seven hits and seven walks and picking up 18 strikeouts.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's victory Wednesday night was their first at home since July 1... The Jumbo Shrimp's last four home triumphs have all come by one run.

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildrenonhisdad'ssideandtheyoungestof18grandchildrenonhismom'sside.Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison II Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in the result of the solid first of th2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

 $-Montever decompleted his collegiate career by transferring to {\tt Texas Tech University for the}$ 2021 season. Hewent 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2023 SEASON

 $-Montever dewas promoted to Jackson ville on July 25 from Double-APensacola. \\ At the time the time$ of hiis promotion, heled the Southern League inwins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while the southern League inwing (8), the source of theranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a reliefrole. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15appearances were starts
