### FRES-NOTES

**THURSDAY'S RECAP:** The Fresno Grizzlies (19-16) were throttled by the Stockton Ports (14-20) 13-1 Thursday evening from Banner Island Ballpark. Fresno saw their six-game winning streak come to an end against Stockton, as the Ports enjoyed their widest margin of victory all-time against the Grizzlies (10 runs prior to tonight, 14-4 in 2021). The Grizzlies fell to 68-25 all-time against the Ports (7-2 record this season) with a 37-8 all-time record (7-2 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. The 13 runs were the most allowed by Fresno's staff in a game this season. The Grizzlies offense supplied 10 hits in the setback. Caleb Hobson and the bottom of the Fresno lineup highlighted the night. Hobson smacked three hits, including a double and scored the only run on a wild pitch in the seventh inning. Tevin Tucker added two hits from the nine-hole and Ben McCabe roped a double from his seventh spot. Braylen Wimmer lined a double and EJ Andrews Jr. swatted his second triple in the series. Tyler Hoffman was electric, striking out two in a 1-2-3 inning after entering for Sam Weatherly in the eighth.

**STOCK-PILING SOME STATS:** The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the second of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the second set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 68-25 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 37-8 all-time record (8-4 last year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

**DEJÀ VU:** The Grizzlies are 19-16 over their first 35 games of the season, the same record they had last year after 35 games.

**JACK OF ALL TRADES:** Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney. Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #19 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney is from Illinois and grew up with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

**AN ACE IN JACE:** Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska has been lights out over six starts this season. Kaminska is 2-1 with a 1.52 ERA and 0.91 WHIP, with the latter two ranking first in the California League. In 29.2 innings, he has allowed five runs (all earned), on 21 hits, six walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 34. Kaminska has started consecutive shutouts, giving Fresno five shutouts this season. He has tossed 12 straight scoreless innings, allowing nine hits and three walks while striking out 13.

**HERRERA IS HIM:** Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has nine consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 14. Herrera has tossed 13 innings, allowing six hits, two walks and one hit-by-pitch while striking out 25.

**RISP IS A RISK:** In the month of May, the Grizzlies hold a 6-9 record with 40 total runs scored (2.67 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 15 games in the month, Fresno is 24-for-126 (.190) with four different instances where the team went 0-fer with runners in scoring position. They have also left 124 runners on base in May. Yesterday, the Grizzlies offense left nine runners on base and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position in the loss.

**JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R:** Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had a fantastic season (31 games), going 28-for-96 (.292 AVG/.485 OBP/.469 SLG/.954 OPS) with two homers, two triples, seven doubles, 18 RBI, 21 runs (one walk-off run), 31 walks, seven hit-by-pitches and seven stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked second in the California League with a .485 OBP and tied for first in walks (31). Snider's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

**A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ:** Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has also had an outstanding season (34 games), going 41-for-138 (.297 AVG/.450 OBP/.471 SLG/.816 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, six doubles, 21 RBI, 16 runs, 10 walks and two stolen bases. The Cuban native is ranked among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. He is ranked tied for second in hits (41), third in total bases (65), tied for third in triples (3), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (13), tied for eighth in homers (4), ninth in slugging percentage (.471), 10th in batting average (.297) and 10th in RBI (21). Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Like Snider, Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.
