YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 7-4, at FNB Field. **Brett Auerbach** started the scoring with a two-run homer in the top of the third inning, his fourth of the season. Harrisburg's Jake Alu hit an RBI single in the third and Wilson Garcia tied the game, 2-2, with an RBI single in the fifth. In the sixth, **Brandon Martorano** put Richmond back in the lead with a three-run homer in the sixth. Drew Millas hit a two-run double in the seventh to close the score to 5-4. **Simon Whiteman** worked a bases-loaded walk in the eighth. Martorano added a solo homer in the top of the ninth, his second of the game and his fifth of the season. Richmond starter **Kai-Wei Teng** worked 5.2 innings to pick up his first Double-A win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This series is the first meeting between the two clubs this year and the first of two series the Flying Squirrels will play at FNB Field in 2022. Richmond returns to Harrisburg for a six-game series from June 14-19. The Senators will play the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond in a six-game series from August 30-September 4.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four-of-five in this week's series at Harrisburg and have won 11-of-15 since April 28. After winning the first three games of last week's home series against Akron to extend their winning streak to seven games overall, the Flying Squirrels lost the final three games of the set for a series split. Richmond leads the Eastern League's Southwest Division by two games over second-place Erie and Akron.

THE SENATORS have lost six-of-seven since May 8 and 9-of-12 since April 30. Last week, they lost three of five at Bowie, including being swept in a double-header to close the series on Sunday afternoon. Harrisburg has lost its last three series, including this week's set against Richmond. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Washington Nationals' Top-30 prospects as rated by MLB.com, including RHP Cole Henry (3), LHP Matt Cronin (13), LHP Evan Lee (18) and SS Jackson Cluff (22). Justin Connell is tied for fourth in the league in homers (7), eighth in SLG (.517) and second in runs scored (24). Jake Alu is ninth in batting average (.295), tied for second in RBIs (22), tied for fourth in hits (33), tied for third in doubles (9), tied for eighth in extra-base hits (13) and seventh in total bases (54). Evan Lee is ninth in ERA (2.88) and seventh in BAA (.176). Ronald Herrera is tied for sixth in innings pitched (32.1). Matt Brill is leading the league in saves (8) and tied for third in games pitched (12).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Bryan Brickhouse** makes his seventh start of the season. Lat time out, he threw 6.2 scoreless innings, his longest start of the season, at Harrisburg on Tuesday with a season-high 10 strikeouts and no walks in a combined shutout. Brickhouse has not allowed a run over his last 7.0 innings pitched since May 4. Over his last two starts, Brickhouse is 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP) with 17 strikeouts and one walk. Brickhouse was signed as a free agent with a non-roster invitation to spring training by the Giants on December 15, 2021. Last year, Brickhouse signed with the Los Angeles Dodgers and spent the season with Double-A Tulsa, making 10 starts and nine relief outings. He was originally drafted by the Kansas City Royals in 2011 and retired in 2017 after battling injuries. He returned to the field in the 2018 season. **For more on Brickhouse, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Ronald Herrera makes his seventh start of the season. He started the series-opener on Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels and allowed one run over six innings with seven strikeouts in a loss. Herrera is pitching his fifth season at the Double-A level dating back to 2015 with San Antonio. He also pitched for Trenton from 2016-2017 and with Frisco in 2019. Last year, he made six starts for the independent New Jersey Jackals of the Frontier League, going 2-2 with a 4.68 ERA in six starts. In his career, Herrera has pitched for the Oakland, San Diego, New York (AL), Texas and Washington organizations. He signed as a free agent with the Nationals on February 9.

WINNING EARLY: The Flying Squirrels are sitting in first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, 2.5 games over second-place Akron. Richmond's 20-12 record is tied for the best start in franchise history through 32 games, ahead of the team's start in its inaugural season in 2010 and the start of the 2021 season. The franchise's best start through 33 games is 20-13, which was set in 2010 and 2021, a mark that can be surpassed with a win today.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (109,030) and average attendance (6,057). Richmond is eighth of the 120 MLB teams in total attendance and 10th in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 44 home runs this season, which is first in the Eastern League. **Sean Roby** is second in the league with nine homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 190 home runs. Since Tuesday, the Flying Squirrels have homered 10 times in five games, which leads the league.

STRONG ARMS: Since April 28, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 2.98 ERA (45 ER/136.0 IP) in 15 games, which is second-best in the Eastern League behind Somerset (2.60, 14 G). The Richmond pitching staff has held the Baysox, RubberDucks and Senators to a .220 batting average the last 15 games, but the Senators have hit .306 the last three games.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last three games played since Wednesday, **Brandon Martorano** has hit three homers and driven in nine runs. On Wednesday, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup on Friday and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On Saturday, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano is tied for sixth in the league with 20 RBIs this season. His nine RBIs since Wednesday are the most in the Eastern League in that span and tied for the third-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

SHANE TRAIN: On Thursday, **Shane Matheny** hit a pair of solo homers, the second two-homer game of the season for him and the third of his professional career. He hit two home runs against the Baysox at The Diamond on May 1. He also had a two-homer game on August 25, 2019 with High-A San Jose at Stockton, part of his career-best 10 homers that season. This year, Matheny has hit five home runs, already surpassing his season total of four from 2021 with the Flying Squirrels.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** is second in the Eastern League with nine home runs on the season. With his two-run homer on April 29, Roby tied the franchise record for the most home runs in a calendar month, evening **Jarret Parker's** record of eight from May 2013. Seven of Roby's home runs have come at The Diamond, which ties him for the fifth-most homers in a season at home in franchise history. He snapped an eight-game stretch without a homer with his solo shot on Friday night at Harrisburg. Roby has picked up at least one hit in six of his last eight games played since May 3, hitting .297 (11-for-37) with a double, a triple, a homer and four RBIs.

TOASTY: After hitting .263 (10-for-38) over his first 10 games of the year, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .368 (28-for-76) with three homers, four doubles and 12 RBIs over his last 19 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year. On Wednesday, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. Tostado is ranked first in the Eastern League in batting average (.333) and hits (38).

WINNING WITH WALKER: Reliever **Ryan Walker** is leading the Eastern League with six wins this season, picking them up across his first seven relief appearances of the season. In his first two outings of the year, Walker allowed five runs over 2.2 innings. Over his last eight outings since April 17, Walker has not allowed a run, holding opposing batters to a .040 (1-for-25) batting average with one hit and one walk while striking out 12 in 8.1 innings.

RASHI IS ROLLING: Relief pitcher **Taylor Rashi** has worked 10 appearances this season without allowing a run, spanning 12.1 innings. He has allowed just four hits, holding opposing batters to a .103 batting average, and has issued four walks with 18 strikeouts. For the season, Rashi has worked the most outings and innings of any reliever in the league who has not allowed a run. On Friday at Harrisburg, he worked 12 scoreless innings with two strikeouts.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is leading the league in batting average (.333) and hits (38) and ranks tied for fourth in total bases (57). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (9), second in SLG (.559) and tied for fourth in total bases (57). **Brandon Martorano** is tied for sixth in RBIs (20). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for seventh in stolen bases (8). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for second (4). **Kai-Wei Teng** is 10th in strikeouts (38) and tied for fourth in innings pitched (33.2). **Jake Dahlberg** is second in innings pitched (35.2). **Chris Wright** is tied for fourth in saves (4).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
